



ROUND SQUARE: DIGITAL KINDNESS

INTENT:

Credence High School students actively participated in the Round Square Zoom Postcard on the theme Digital Kindness. The intent of this session was to foster awareness among students about responsible and empathetic engagement. It aimed to help participants understand the importance of maintaining balance, safety, and kindness in their online interactions while promoting a culture of respect, mindfulness, and positive digital citizenship. The event encouraged delegates to reflect on the positive impact of kindness in the digital space and to share personal experiences of promoting safe, respectful, and supportive online interactions.

EXPERIENCE:

In preparation for the session, our students Shivangi (Grade 9A), Rajvir (Grade 9B) and Divyang (Grade 9C) documented and shared acts of digital kindness they had observed during the week. A presentation slide was created, highlighting the digital kindness activities carried at Credence. During the Zoom session, Credence delegates engaged in meaningful discussions with peers from other Round Square schools. They exchanged views on how small acts like helping a friend online, raising awareness, or spreading positivity can create a culture of kindness in the digital world.

INSIGHT:

The event highlighted that kindness extends beyond physical spaces and plays an equally vital role in online communities. Our students realized the importance of being responsible digital citizens, where empathy, respect, and care can help combat negativity in virtual platforms. The interactive exchange with other schools broadened their perspective on the global significance of digital kindness.
