# **Orientation Programme for SAFAL KSA 2025-2026**

Subject: Workshop on Orientation Programme for SAFAL KSA 2025–2026

Date: 4th & 5th November, 2025

**Description:** 

An orientation programme on SAFAL (Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning)—an initiative introduced by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) under the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020—was conducted for the students of Classes VI and IX of Delhi Public School, Knowledge Park V. The SAFAL assessment for the academic session 2025–2026 is scheduled to be held in November 2025 for the current batches of Classes VI and IX.

The orientation for Class IX was conducted by Ms. Pooja Garg in online mode on 4 November 2025 (Wednesday) and 5 November 2025 (Thursday).

For Class VI, the orientation was held on 21 November 2025 (Friday) in Physical mode in MPH Fourth Floor.

The sessions were conducted to familiarize students with the objectives, structure, and procedures of the SAFAL assessment.

During the orientation, the following key points were covered:

## • Introduction and Purpose of SAFAL:

To provide a competency-based assessment framework aimed at evaluating students' foundational learning levels as advocated by NEP 2020.

### • Subjects to be Assessed:

English, Science, and Mathematics.

### • Criteria of Assessment:

Emphasis on critical thinking, analytical thinking, and problem-solving skills, aligning with competency-based learning outcomes.

#### Schedule of Assessment:

Timeline and sequence for the conduct of the examination in November 2025

### • Mode and Duration of Assessment:

Details regarding the online examination format, time allocation, and logistical requirements.

## • Important Credentials for the Examination:

Students were informed about the requirement of Username, Password, and Test PIN, which will be essential on the day of the examination.

Towards the end of the session, a demonstration video was shown to the students, illustrating the step-by-step procedure for accessing and attempting the SAFAL assessment on the examination day.

The orientation was attended by Ms. Richa Bhardwaj (Headmistress), all Class HRTs of Classes VI and IX, and the Class Representatives, Ms. Richa Palni and Ms. Himani Deep. Their presence added value to the session and ensured that students received comprehensive guidance.
