Q1. Read the passage and answer the following questions.

Last winter, a thick layer of fog covered many parts of North India. The fog was so dense that people could not see clearly even a few metres ahead. This caused delays in trains and flights, and children had to leave home earlier for school. Doctors said that pollution from vehicles and factories mixes with the cold air, forming harmful smog.

Because of this, many people complained of coughing, burning eyes, and difficulty in breathing. Schools and offices advised everyone to wear masks and avoid outdoor activities early in the morning. The government started checking vehicles for pollution levels and encouraged people to use public transport. Experts say that planting more trees, reducing waste, and keeping our surroundings clean can help improve air quality. Clean air is important for a healthy life.

- a) State the reason for delays in trains and flights during winter.
- b) Mention the advice given by schools and offices to people.
- c) Identify what forms when pollution mixes with cold air.
- d) Suggest one long-term step citizens and the government can take together to reduce winter smog, and explain why it would be effective.

These forests protect the land from storms and floods while providing shelter to birds, reptiles, and fish. Villagers have started planting new trees and following rules to avoid cutting old trees. Forest officials monitor the area carefully and rescue animals that wander too close to human settlements. Awareness programs are held to teach children and adults the importance of protecting these forests. People now realise that saving the mangroves not only helps animals but also keeps their own villages safe from natural disasters.

- b) Describe the steps villagers are taking to protect the forests.
- c) Identify a threat mentioned in the passage that affects wildlife.
- d) Pick a word from the passage that means “cutting down trees.”
