Land pollution is one of the biggest problems on Earth today. It occurs when people throw garbage on the ground instead of using dustbins. Waste such as plastic bags, bottles, paper, food waste, and chemicals make the land dirty and unsafe. Factories also cause land pollution by dumping harmful waste on open land. When land is polluted, plants cannot grow well and animals lose their homes. It also spreads diseases and makes the environment unhealthy for humans. **(Para-1)**

Land pollution affects farmers because polluted soil cannot grow healthy crops. It also harms animals that eat plastic or live near garbage dumps. Burning waste on land causes a bad smell and releases harmful smoke into the air. This pollution can make people sick and cause breathing problems. **(Para-2)**

We can reduce land pollution by keeping our surroundings clean. We should always throw waste in dustbins and recycle paper, glass, and plastic. Using cloth bags instead of plastic bags is helpful. Planting more trees and reducing waste can protect our land. If everyone works together, we can keep our land clean and make our Earth a better place to live. **(Para-3)**
