2. The important dates of events and the eligibility criteria for the olympiad is as below: -

Training Camp + Indian National Earth Science Olympiad (INESO)	3-week residential Training Camp during May/June 2026, followed by INESO exam at the end of camp.
Pre-departure Training Camp (for selected students)	After INESO 2026
International Earth Science Olympiad (IESO) 2026	Date to be announced (host country- Italy)

**Eligibility Criteria :-**

- Students currently studying in **Classes IX, X, XI, or XII** (as of August 2026).
- Age: The candidate should **not be older than 18 years** as on **1st July of the Olympiad year**. They should **not be a university/college student** at the time of participation.
- Students who have already participated (or won a medal) in a previous IESO may be ineligible (as per general IESO eligibility norms).



I sincerely thank you for your support last year, which increased awareness amongst schools and students about the Earth Science Olympiad. It resulted in significant increased number of participants in the Olympiad.

The International Earth Science Olympiad (IESO) founded as one of the major activities of the International Geosciences Education Organization (IGEO) is an annual competition for secondary school students across the World. The main aim of the IESO is to encourage student's interest and awareness of Earth Sciences (ES) and to enhance teaching/learning of ES (atmospheric science, ocean science, geosciences, and polar sciences) at the school level given its increasing importance and relevance to the society. The IESO aims further to foster friendly relationships among young learners from different countries and promote international cooperation in exchanging ideas and materials on Earth Sciences. About 45 countries (including U.S., Germany, Russia, Japan, UK, France, Spain, South Korea, Italy, China, etc.) participate in IESO.

The Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES) supports the National Earth Science Olympiad (NESO) and IESO in coordination with the Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE). Initially, 25 students are selected based on an all-India entrance test. These students undergo advanced training for a period of about four weeks. Finally, four students are selected to represent India in the IESO based on their performance during the training period. It is my pleasure to mention that students of our country have been bringing laurels to the nation by winning medals in IESO. This year, a team of four students won 7 medals (1 Gold, 4 Silver, 2 Bronze) in different competitions among teams from countries worldwide in the 18<sup>th</sup> IESO-2025, held in Jining, China, from 8 to 16 August 2025.

MoES will be supporting country's students' team for the forthcoming 19<sup>th</sup> IESO-2025, to be held in Italy, in August 2026. Geological Society of India (GSI) Bangalore will be facilitating the conduct of an all-India level Entrance Test (NESO) of ninety minutes on 24<sup>th</sup> January 2026 to select students to represent the country in the IESO. 

### ENTRANCE TEST:

An entrance test has been scheduled on Saturday **24<sup>th</sup> Jan 2026** for 90 minutes at 10.30 am in English & Comprising objective type of questions spanning Geology, Geophysics, Meteorology, Oceanography, Terrestrial Astronomy and Environmental Science. **Four-stages of IESO:** i. National Level Entrance Test (ET), ii. Training camp & Indian National Earth Science Olympiad (INESO). (Selection of the four-member team after 3-week training programme), iii. Pre-departure Training Camp (1 week). iv. Participation in the IESO.

**TRAINING CAMP:** The 3-week Training Camp will be held during May/June 2026 and will comprise lectures, discussions, data mining and poster presentation. The INESO will be held at the end of the Camp. The top four students will be declared as winners of 19th INESO. The four winners of INESO will participate in the IESO (2026) to be held in Italy.

In the recently concluded IESO-2025 organized at Jining, China between 8th to 16th August 2025, 31 countries participated. Team India represented by four students: Rayansh Gupta, Charuvrat Bains, Apam Nidhi Pandey, Priyanshi Ghangas.


