Student Wellbeing Survey Report - November 2025

At Credence High School, the emotional wellbeing and mental health of our students remain at the heart of everything we do. As part of our commitment to creating a safe, caring and inclusive learning environment under the **Credence Cares initiative** and our journey towards the **Wellbeing Award for Schools (WAS)**, we conducted a **Student Wellbeing Survey** in November 2025.

Key Highlights from the Student Wellbeing Survey:

- **92% of students** (61% *Strongly Agree* and 31% *Agree*) shared that they are ***aware of the Wellbeing Award for Schools***, while **5%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*, indicating scope for further awareness-building.
- **96% of students** (65% *Strongly Agree* and 31% *Agree*) feel that they ***learn at school about the importance of talking about their feelings and emotions***; **1%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.
- **89% of students** (55% *Strongly Agree* and 34% *Agree*) believe that they can ***make a difference if someone else is feeling worried or unhappy***, while **8%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.
- **91% of students** (59% *Strongly Agree* and 32% *Agree*) feel that the ***school really cares about them and how they are feeling***; **6%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.
- **89% of students** (55% *Strongly Agree* and 34% *Agree*) feel that the ***school cares about all its students and their wellbeing***, while **8%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.
- **94% of students** (64% *Strongly Agree* and 30% *Agree*) stated that ***they would feel comfortable talking about how they are feeling at school if needed***; **3%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.
- **93% of students** (64% *Strongly Agree* and 29% *Agree*) feel that ***their teachers notice when they are worried or unhappy***; **4%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.
- **89% of students** (58% *Strongly Agree* and 31% *Agree*) reported that ***they can get help at school when they feel worried or unhappy***; **8%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.
- **95% of students** (61% *Strongly Agree* and 34% *Agree*) believe that the ***school listens to their views and cares about what they have to say***; **2%** were *Neutral* and **3%** expressed *Disagreement*.

Overall Reflection:

The survey responses highlight a strong sense of care, trust and emotional safety among students at Credence High School. Students feel listened to, supported and encouraged to

speak openly about their emotions, reflecting a positive wellbeing culture embedded across the school.

We remain committed to strengthening these practices and ensuring that every student feels valued, confident and supported to thrive—academically, socially and emotionally.
