Dear Parents and Students

We are pleased to inform that CMPPR (Council for Media Public Policy Research) and in Collaboration with Department of Tourism, Government of NCT of Delhi is organising an Article writing competition at National level.

The aim of this special competition is to convey the "*Mann Ki Baat*" of youth and students to our Hon'ble Prime Minister. For this, students are invited to email one article/essay of up to **1000 words**. The editors will select the **best 75 articles/essays**, which will be compiled and published as a book. This book will be released during the two-day **NAMO Book Festival**, and subsequently, this collection of youth "*Mann Ki Baat*" will be presented to the Hon'ble Prime Minister. From the 75 published articles, the editorial team will further select the 10 best articles, and special awards will be given to these selected students.

Kindly read and understand the submission process and rules carefully:

1. Articles/essays should be on one of the following two themes:

A) What did I learn from the Prime Minister's "Pariksha Pe Charcha"? or how has "Pariksha Pe Charcha" brought changes in my life?

B) 2047: How will my India become developed? or My role in making India a developed nation.

2. Articles/essays may be written in **Hindi or English**.

3. Articles/essays must be within a limit of **1000 words**.

4. Participation will be only from Classes **10th, 11th and 12th**

5. The last date for submission of articles is **22 December 2025**.

6. At the end of the article/essay, the student must clearly mention the following details: Name, School (or former school) name, complete school address, class, and age.

7. Articles/essays must be submitted only via Google form:

8. Students submitting articles must also send one publishable photograph along with their Article.

9. Articles/essays should be typed and not handwritten.

10. Participants must ensure that the article is entirely original and not created using AI tools. We have tools in place to detect AI-generated content, and such submissions will be rejected.

11. The decision of the CMPPR Editorial Board will be final and binding.
