This achievement reflects the school's commitment to nurturing leadership, creativity, and real-world skills among students.





One Method, One Goal: Phonics at School and Home







GURU NANAK JAYANTI







EMPOWERING WOMEN THROUGH HEALTH AWARENESS





The pre-primary teachers participated in two enriching professional development workshops organized through ECA-APER.


PHONICS INSTRUCTION CERTIFICATION WITH KALEIDO EDUCATION:
