Joining the Indian Army is a highly respected and challenging career choice that offers a chance to serve the nation. It provides a structured career path, job security, and a wide range of opportunities for personal and professional growth. Shiksha Bharati Global School, Sector 8, Dwarka conducted a Career Counselling Session on 27th August 2025. The resource person was **Lieutenant Colonel Pramod Dadhich**. The session was conducted exclusively for class XI and XII students.

Mr. Dadhich encouraged the students to join Indian Army as an excellent career option. He told them the complete procedure how to join Indian Army through CDS, NDA and other sources.

Career Pathways in the Indian Army in nutshell:

Officer Level (through exams like NDA/CDS/Technical Entry):

- **National Defence Academy (NDA):** For 10+2 students, entry after UPSC exam + SSB interview.
- **Combined Defence Services (CDS):** For graduates, entry after UPSC exam + SSB interview.
- **Technical Entry Scheme (TES):** For science students (PCM) after 10+2.
- **University Entry Scheme (UES):** For engineering students.
- **NCC Special Entry:** For NCC certificate holders.

He told them all pros and cons of Defence Services pay scales and other facilities. He shared his own experiences being an Army official which definitely added a sense of patriotism in students. Mr. Dadhich showed excellent potential for a career in the Indian Army. With dedicated preparation, discipline, and consistent effort in both academics and physical fitness, the chances of selection are promising. The students were encouraged to start early, set clear timelines, and pursue this path with commitment. In the beginning of the session, when he asked only three students raised hands to join Indian Army but after counselling, the number was multiple that set a seal to the success of this counselling session.
