- e) Emotional & Social Safety: Addressing bullying, promoting kindness, hygiene awareness.
- f) Transportation Safety: Following traffic rules, using helmets, avoiding strangers.
- g) Security Measures: CCTV, ID cards, visitor check-ins, communication systems.

Activities Conducted: -

- Demonstration for fire and earthquake safety.
- Demonstration of first aid and CPR techniques.
- Role-play sessions on handling bullying and cyber safety.
- Group discussions on community safety responsibilities.

Outcome of the Workshop: -

- Students became more aware of personal, digital, and environmental safety.
- They understood the importance of teamwork and vigilance in emergencies.
- The workshop fostered a culture of responsibility and preparedness.
