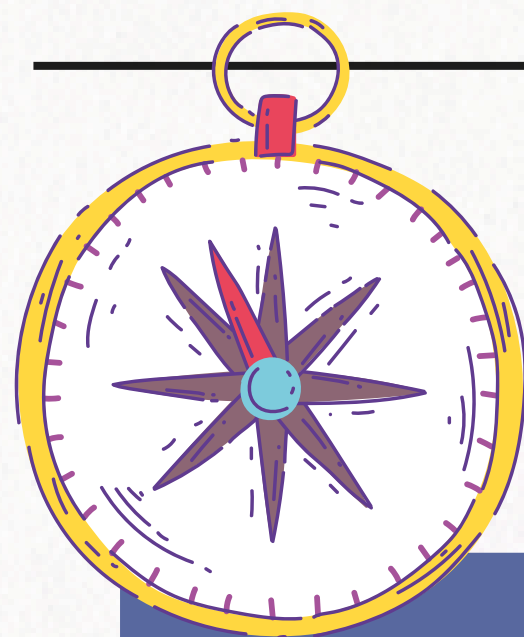
Indo-Russian Exchange Programme

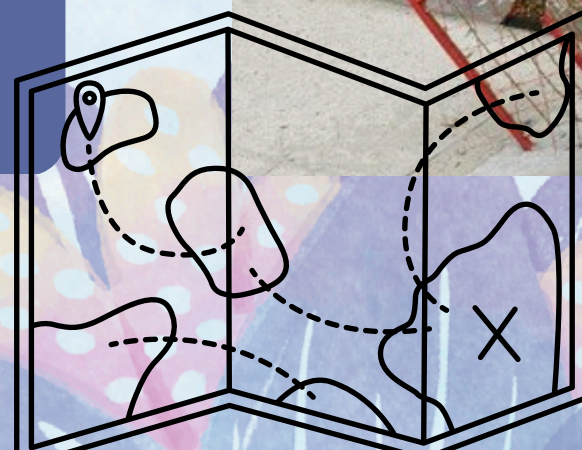


Xaverians Experience Moscow's Autumn Magic - Day 3

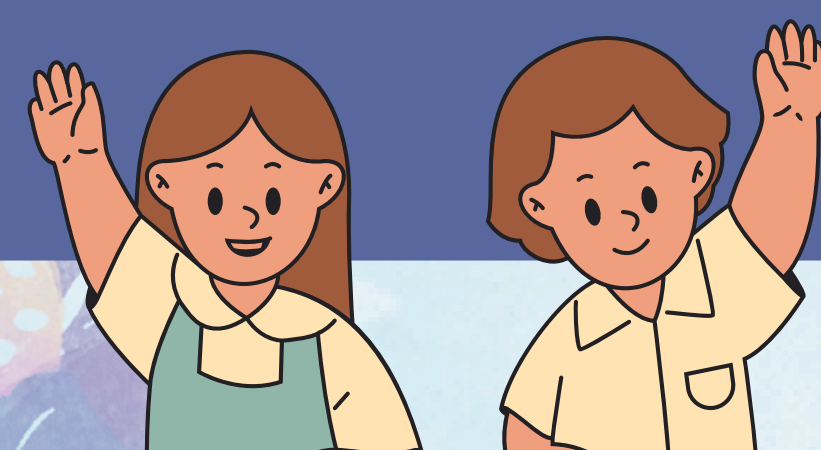


Hearts Across Continents: A Tearful Farewell to Indo-Russian Bonds - Day 6

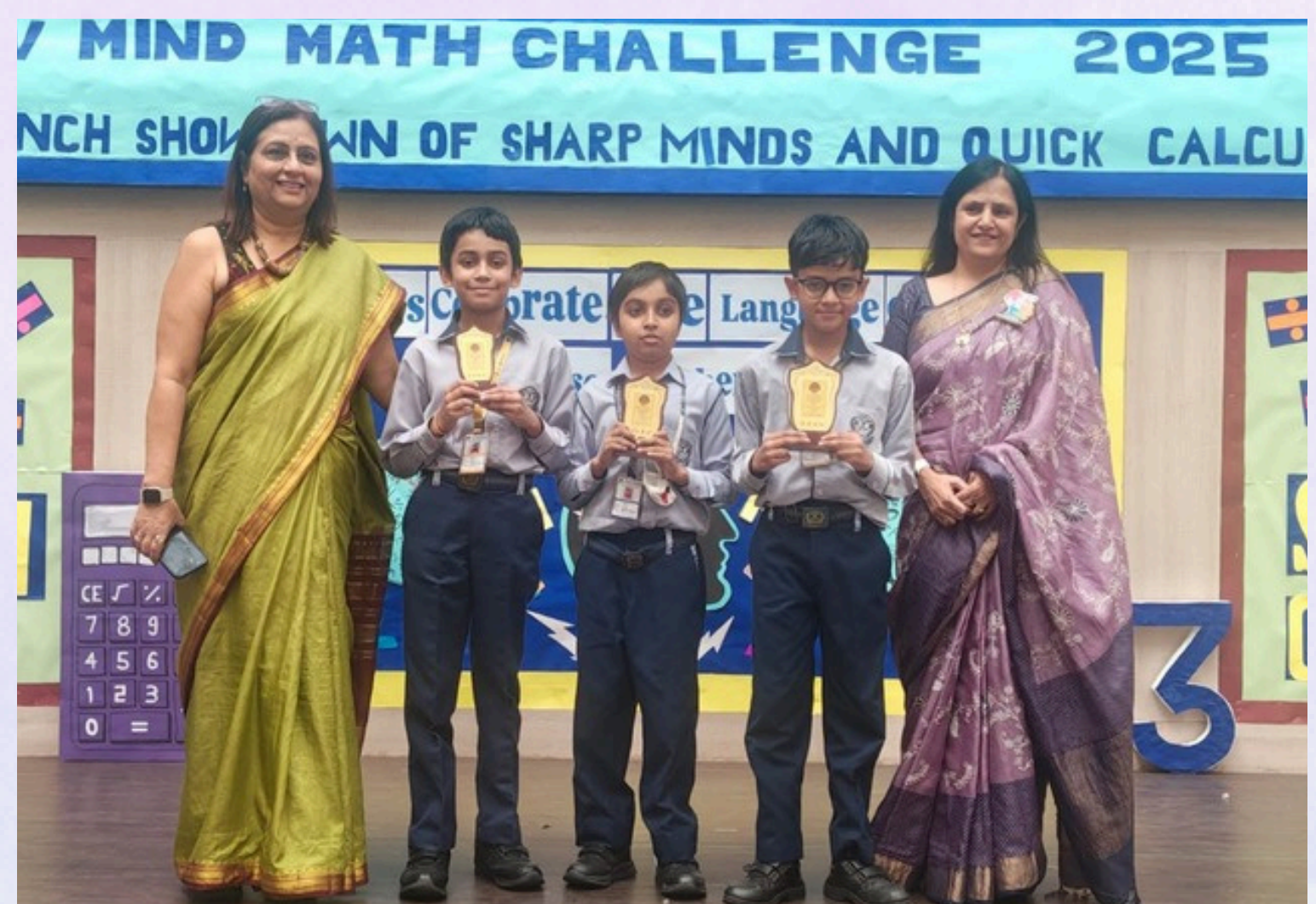

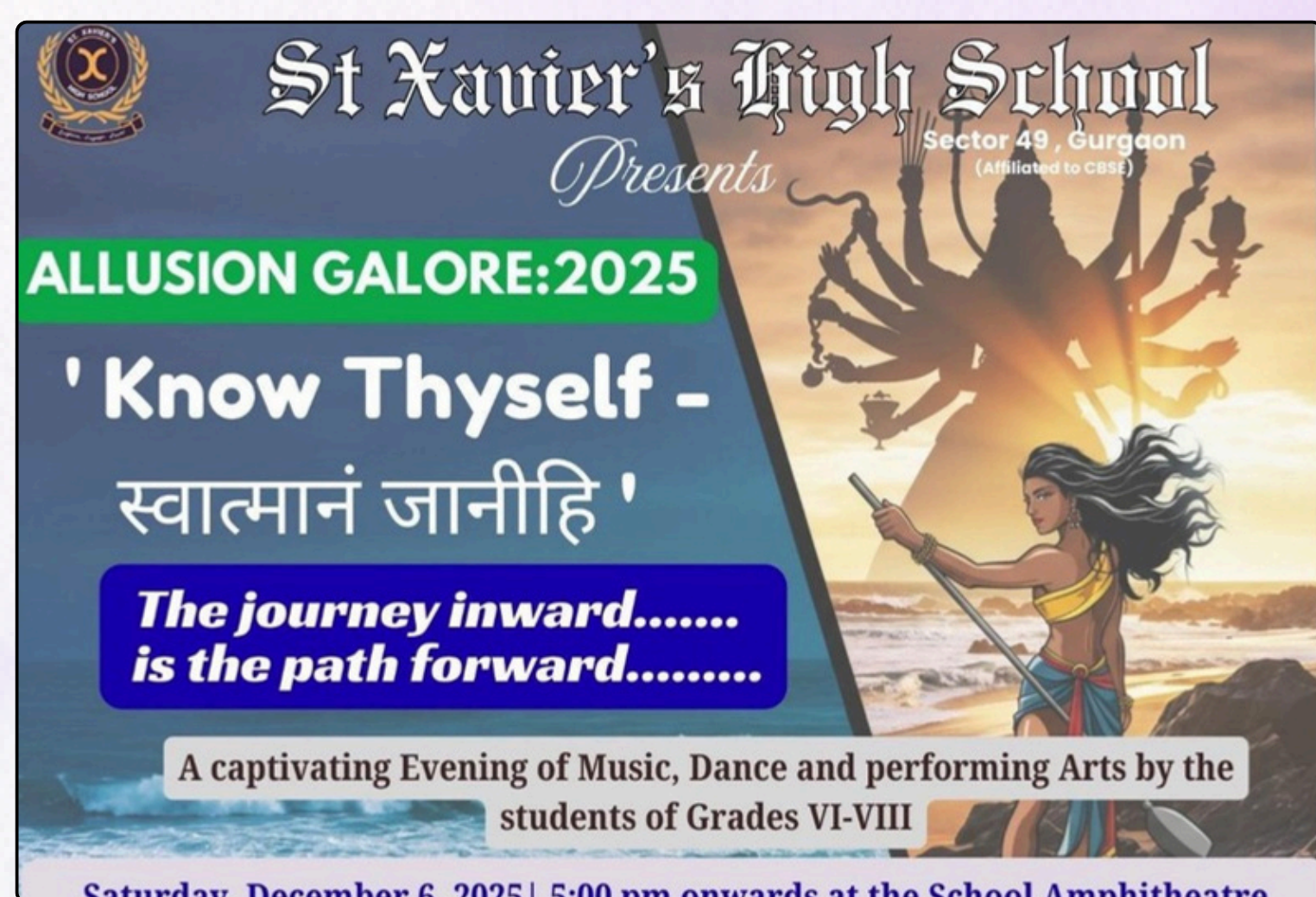

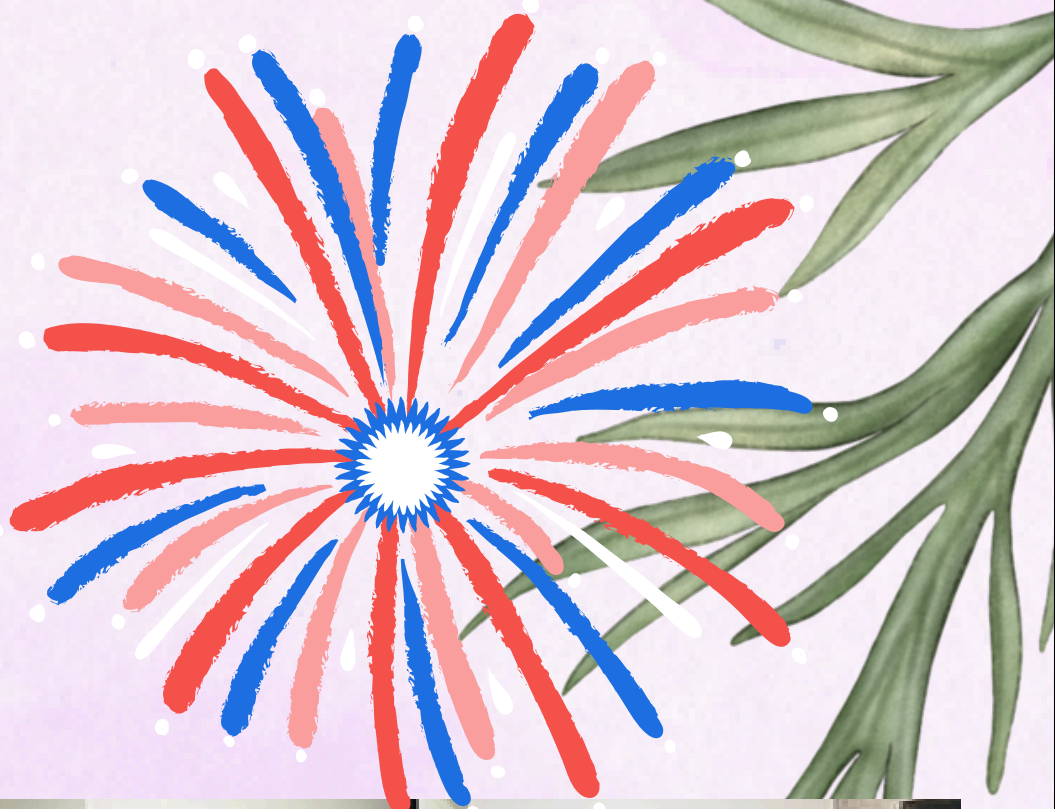

Day 1: Diplomacy Kicks Off

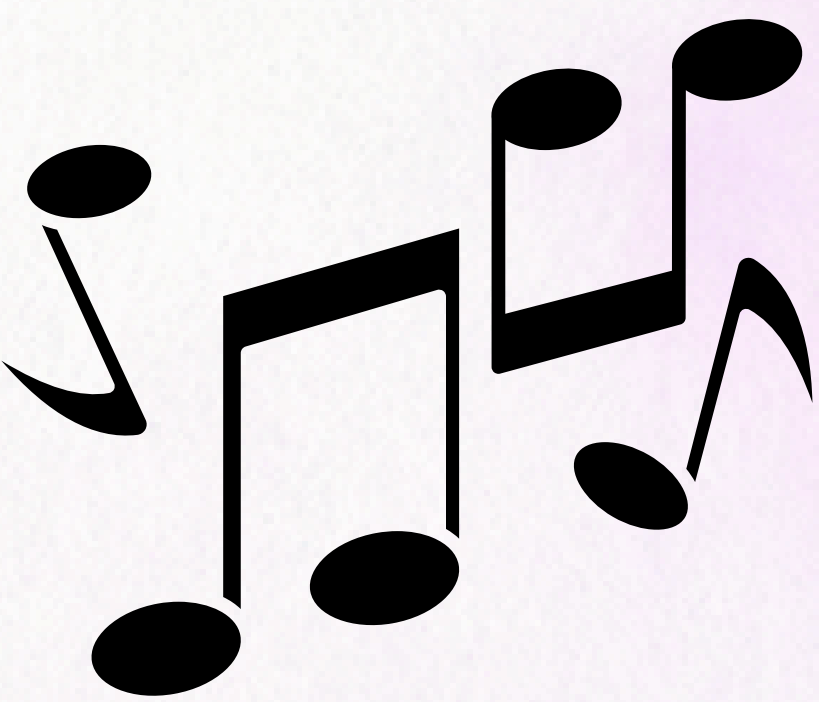

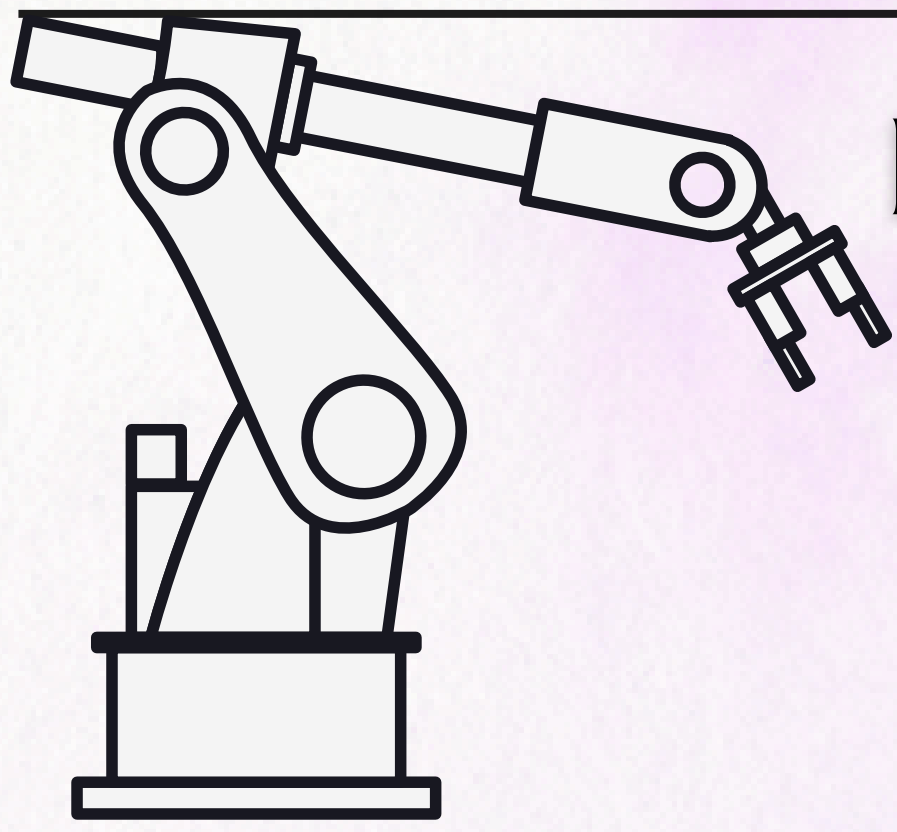

Through interactive discussions, case studies, and real-life scenarios, teachers enhanced their skills to safeguard children's rights and wellbeing.

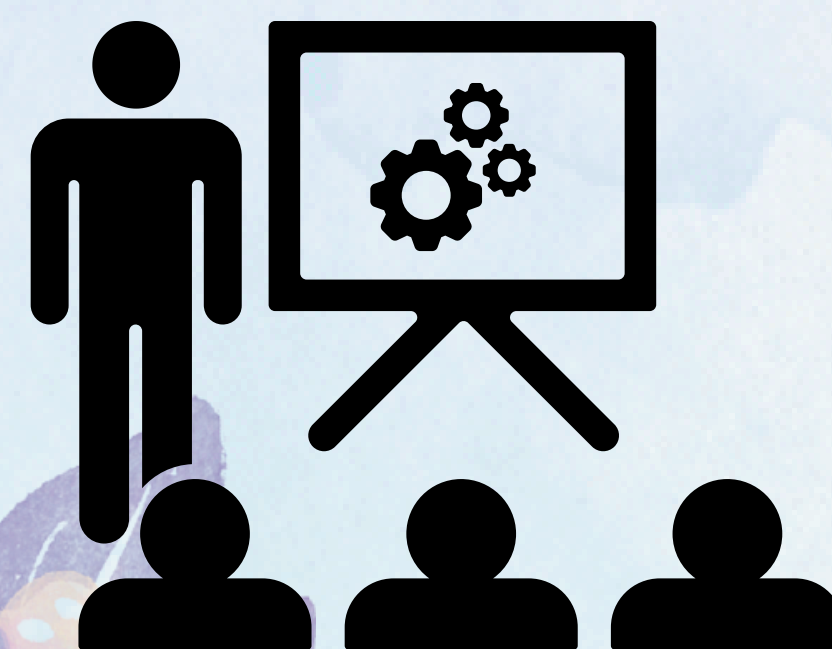

A Triumph of Talent: Inter-House Football Competition

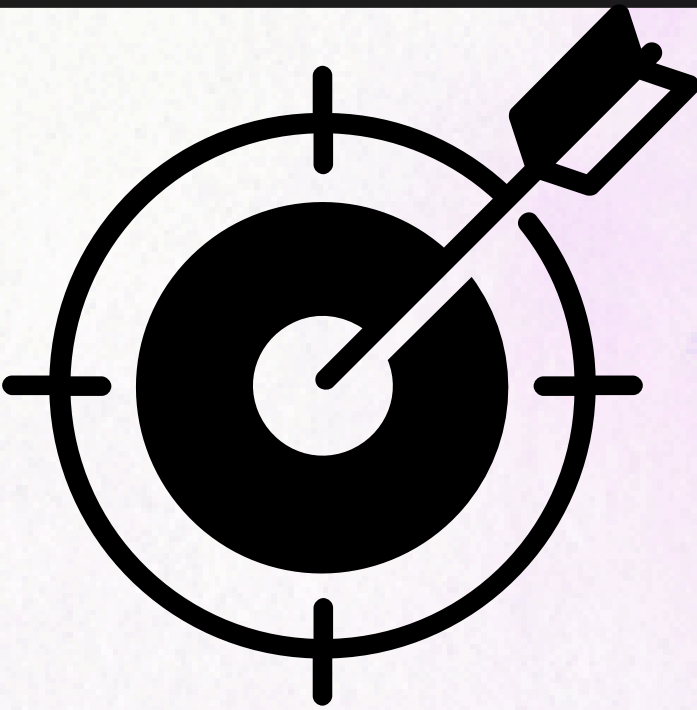

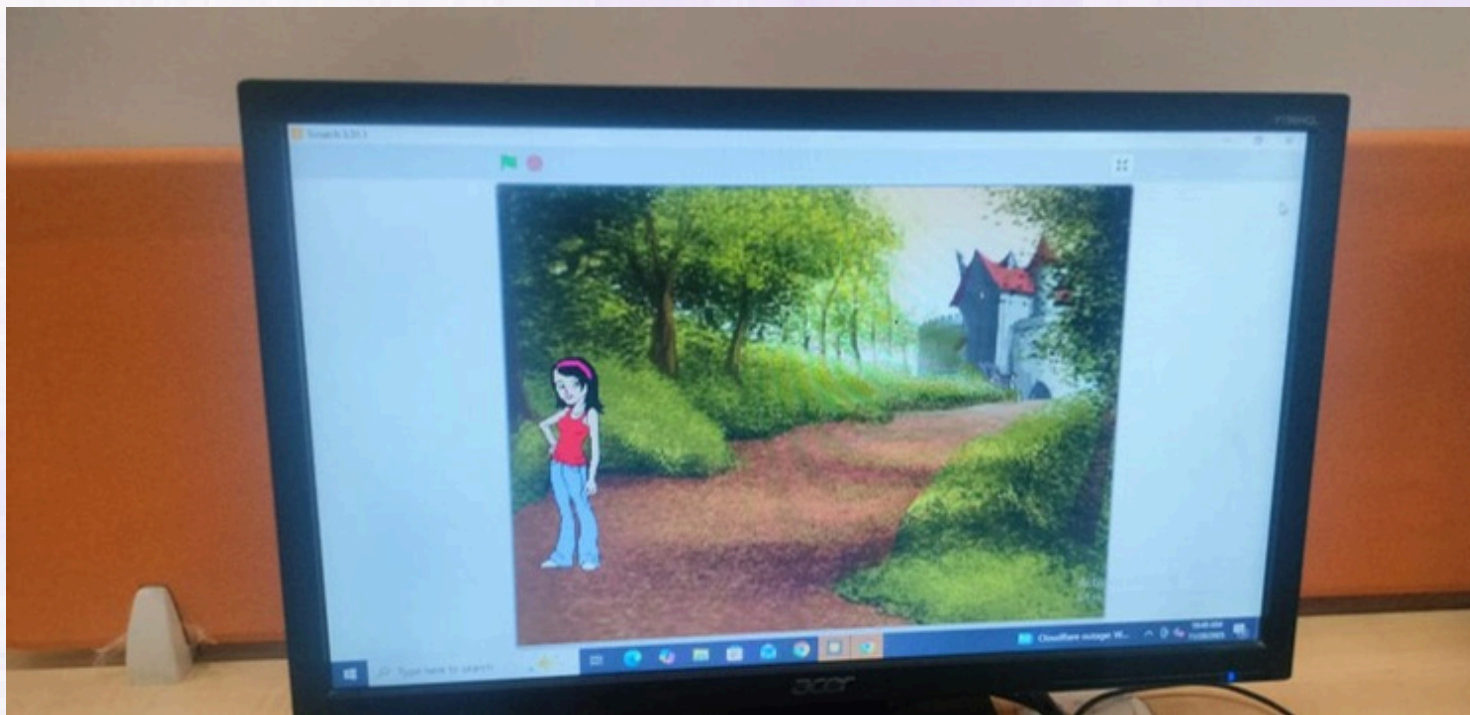


Inter House Comic Strip on Scratch Competition

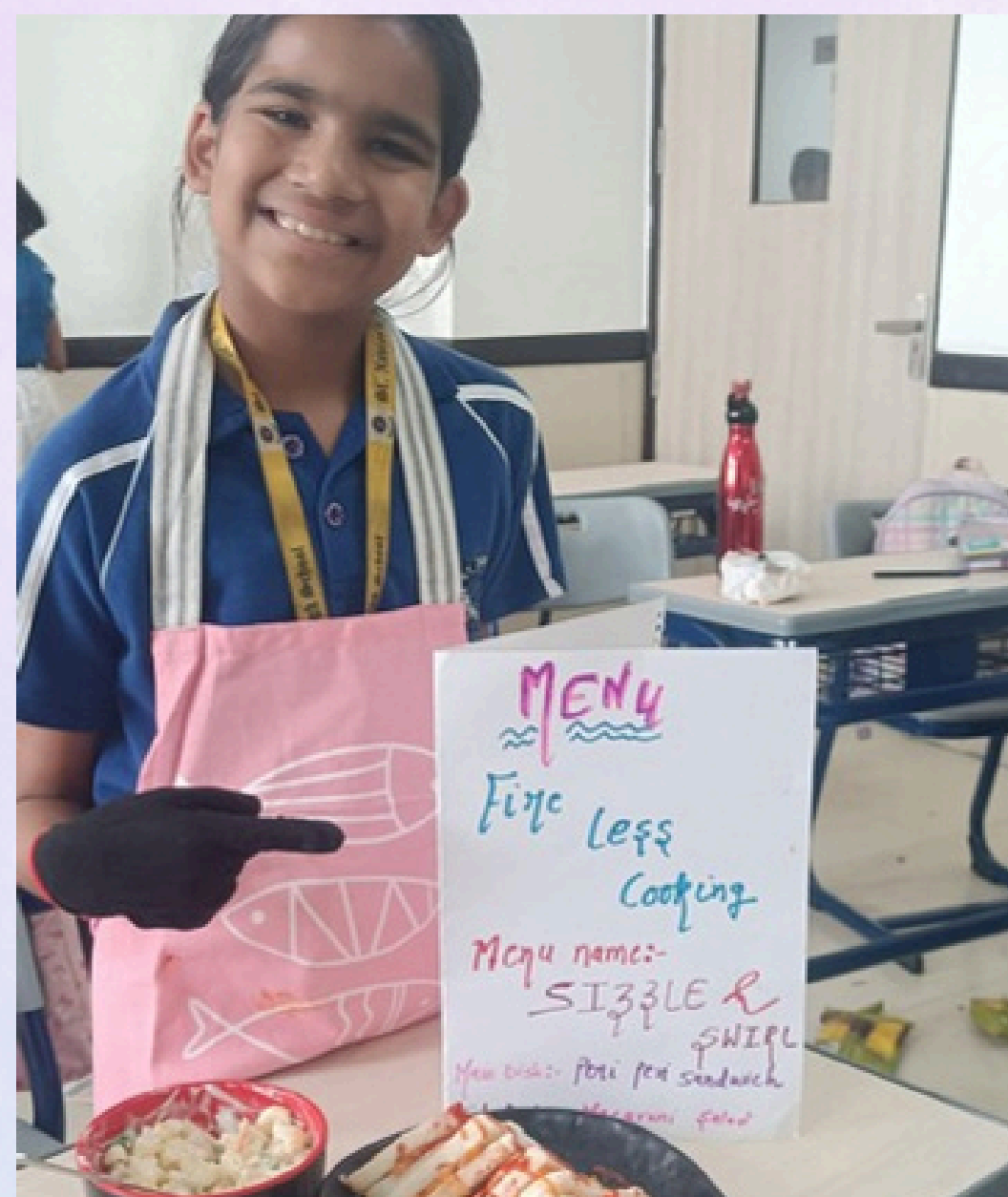



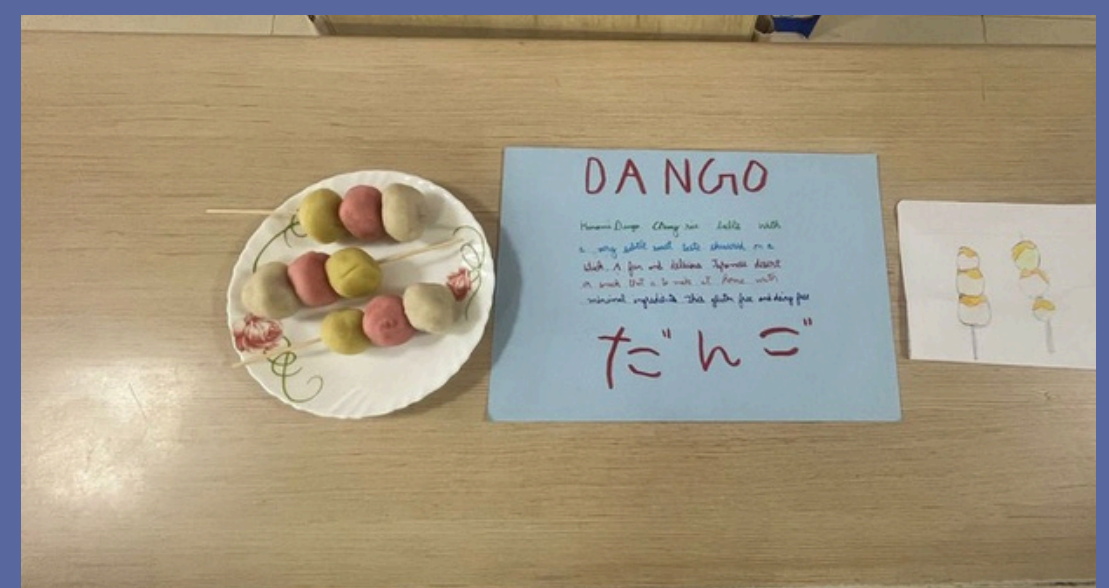
Japanese Language: Food and Art Day Presentation

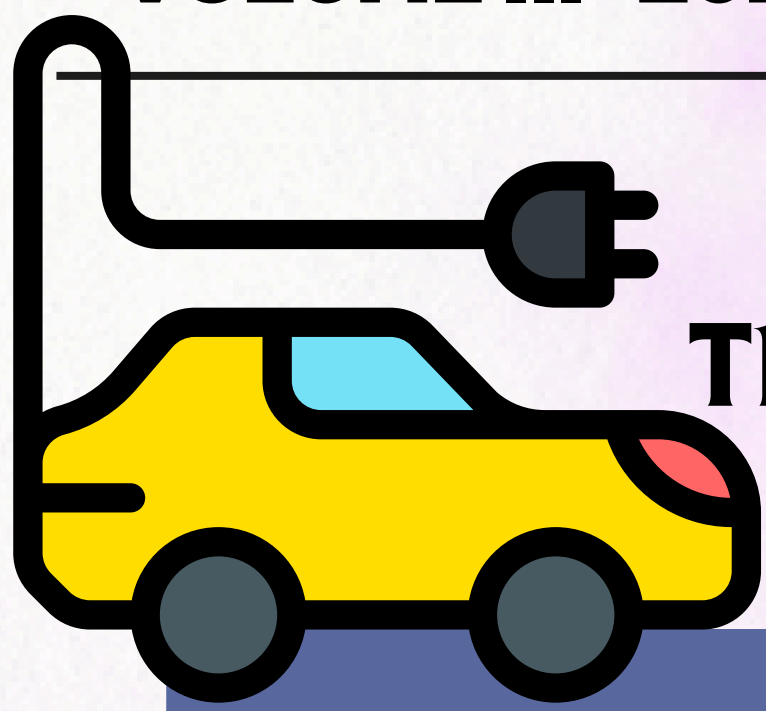
Students participated in an enriching and immersive Japanese Language, Food and Art Day presentation, which provided a meaningful hands-on learning experience.

Overall, the presentation was a vibrant and successful learning experience, reinforcing language skills while fostering cultural awareness and confidence among students.





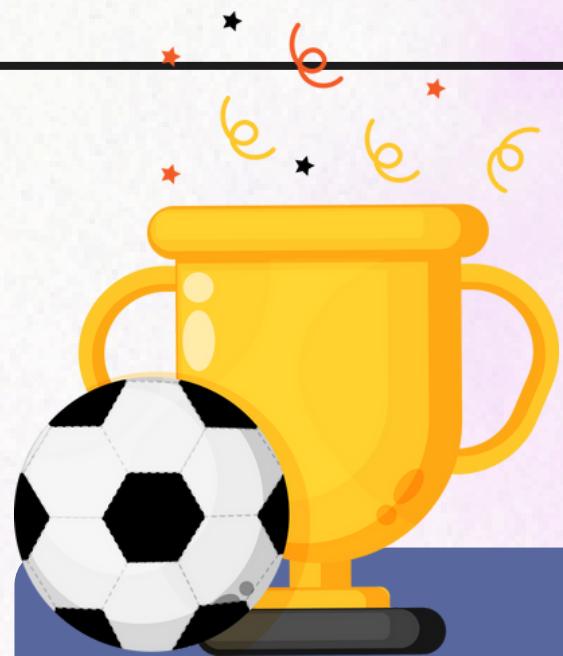
VII B ASSEMBLY: The Life and Journey of Elon Musk

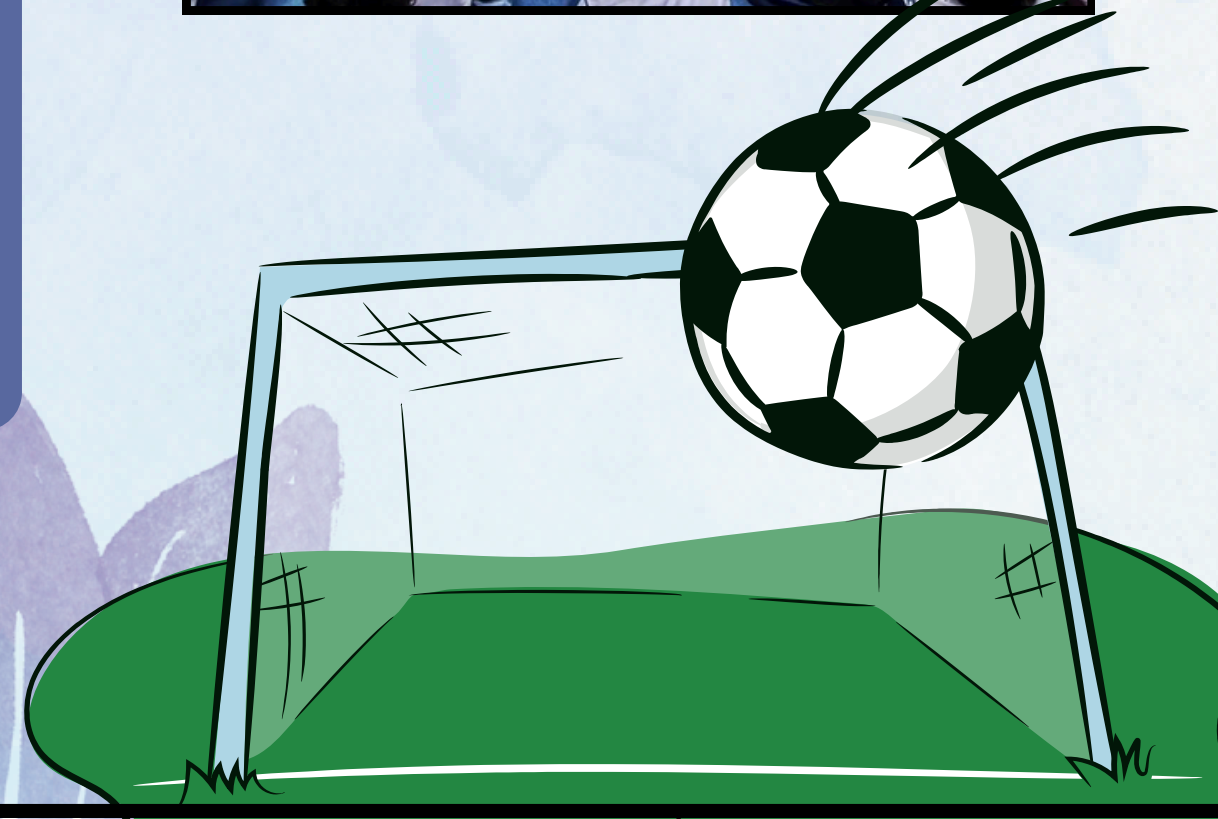
VII C ASSEMBLY: A TRIBUTE TO CRISTIANO RONALDO

VII D ASSEMBLY: The Journey of Mahashay Dharampal Gulati



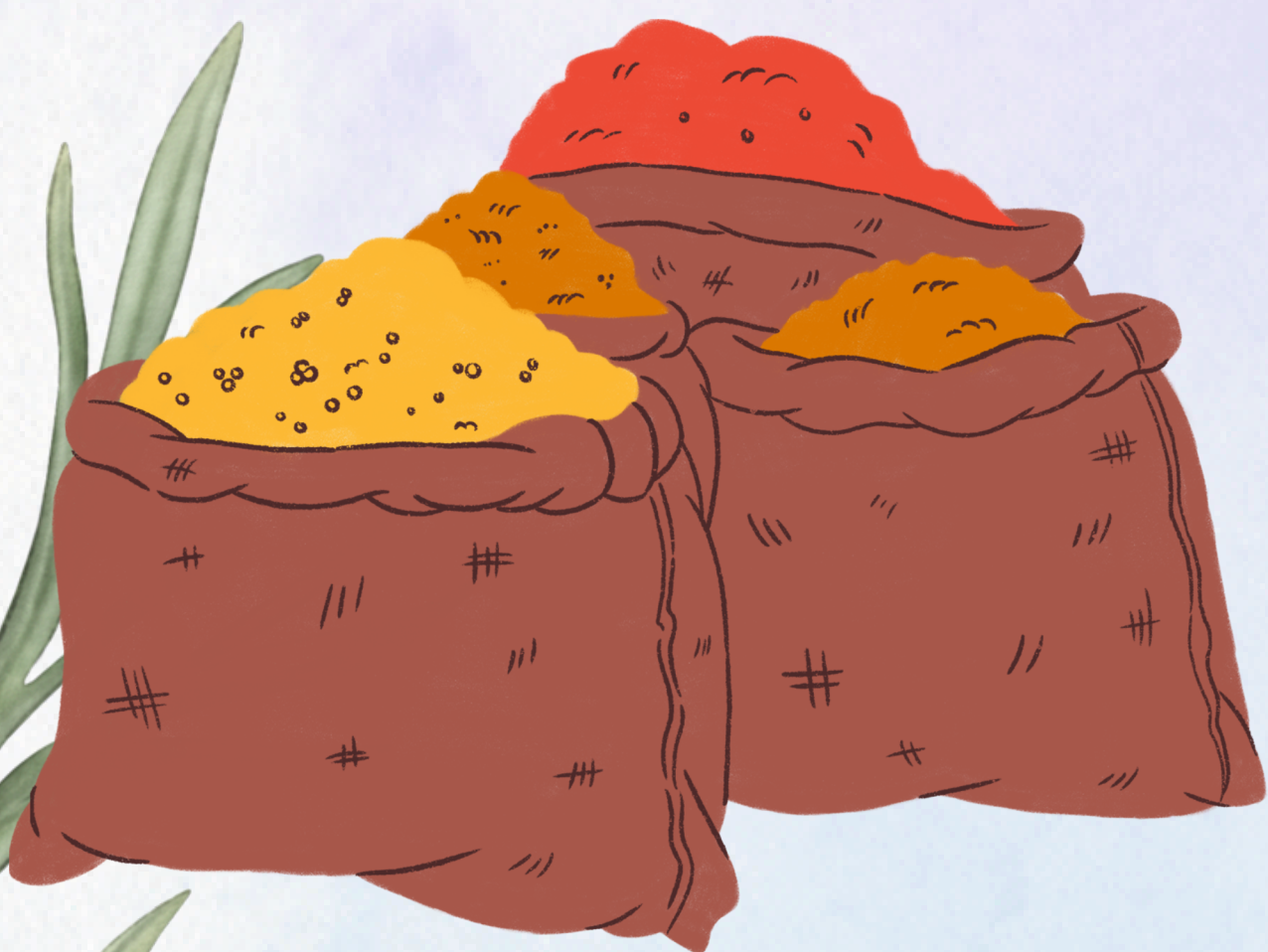
