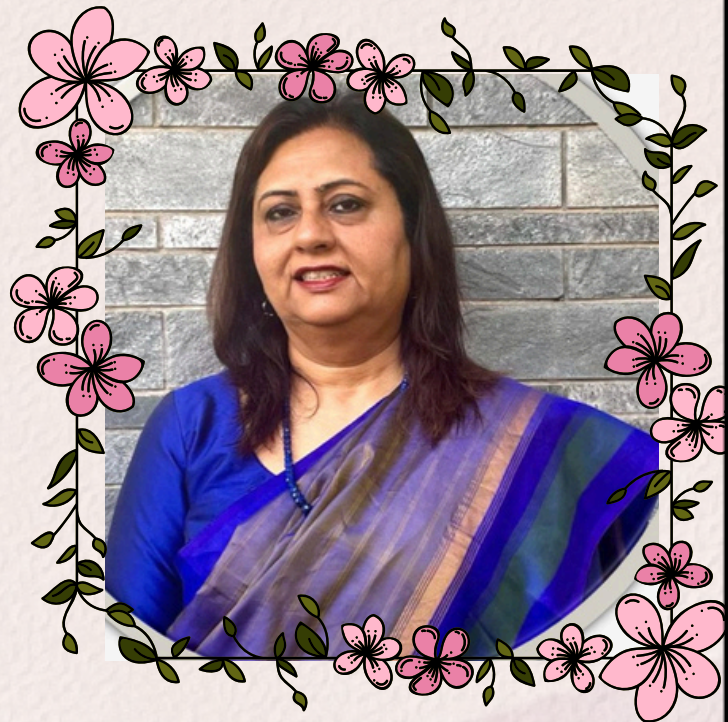
FROM DIRECTOR PRINCIPAL'S DESK

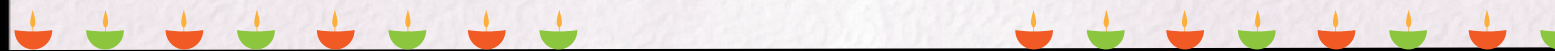
SPECIAL ASSEMBLY ON ECO GREEN DIWALI BY GRADE-3A

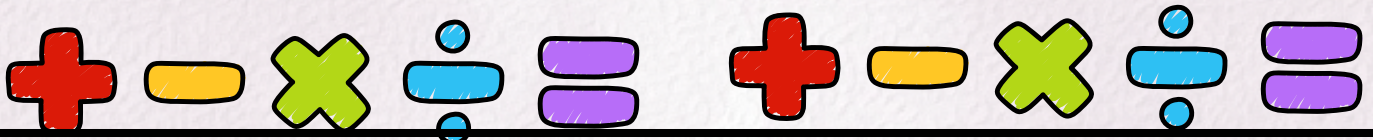


"A THRILLING TEST OF BRAINPOWER AND SPEED!"

The event was thoroughly enjoyed by everyone and spread the message of love, joy and peace.

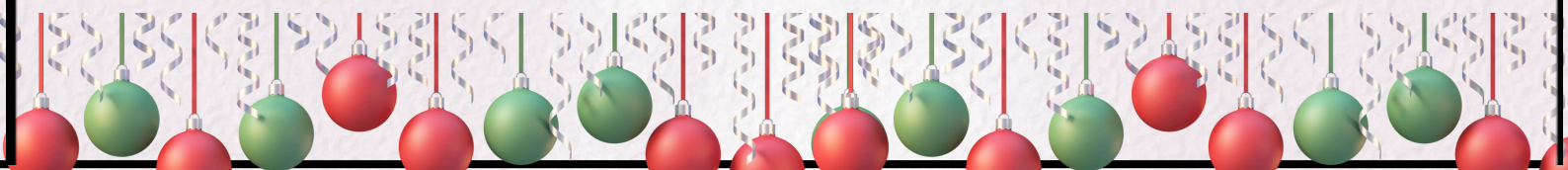
MAGIC SHOW

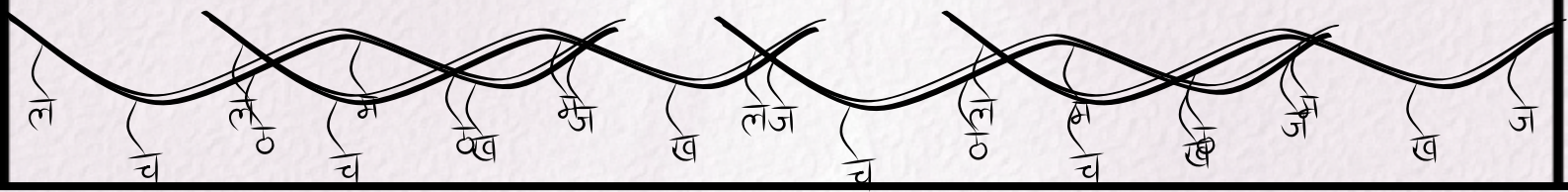

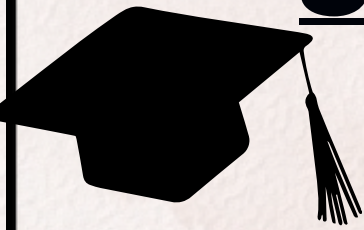
सुलेख लेखन प्रतियोगिता
