Our Destinations

Nainital

Nainital is a beautiful hill station nestled in the Kumaon region of Uttarakhand, known for its cool climate, lush green hills, and breathtaking views. At the heart of the town lies the famous Naini Lake, where visitors can enjoy peaceful boat rides surrounded by pine-covered mountains. The pleasant weather throughout the year makes Nainital a perfect escape from the busy city life, attracting tourists, nature lovers, and photographers alike. The town also offers several popular attractions such as Naina Devi Temple, Snow View Point, Tiffin Top, and the lively Mall Road, which is ideal for shopping and evening walks. With its charming landscapes, colonial-era buildings, and welcoming atmosphere, Nainital provides a refreshing blend of natural beauty and cultural charm, making it a must-visit destination for travelers of all ages.

How to reach

By Train (From Delhi): BDTS LKU SF EXP (Fastest train), DOZ TPU EXP, KATHGODAM SHTBDI, UTR SAMPRK KRTI, PURANGIRI JANST, RANIKHET EXP

By Air (From Delhi): IndiGo: Offers daily nonstop flights on the DEL-PGH route with a flight duration of approximately 1 hour. Others like Air India and Vistara

By Road (From Delhi): Distance: Around 300-325 km via the most popular NH9 route. Primary Route: Delhi → Ghaziabad → Hapur → Moradabad → Rampur → Haldwani → Kathgodam → Nainital. This route is well-maintained, with tolls, and is the fastest and most commonly used. Alternative Route: Delhi → Meerut → Bijnor → Kashipur → Haldwani → Nainital. This route is slightly longer and less congested, offering scenic countryside views but can take more time.

Places To Visit

Naini Lake: A crescent-shaped lake at the center of town, ideal for boating, shopping at nearby Tibetan Market, and photography. It's the heart of Nainital's tourism

Shimla Lake: About 20 km from Nainital, this larger lake offers a peaceful boating experience amidst lush greenery

Sattal: A cluster of seven freshwater lakes located 22 km from Nainital, perfect for nature lovers and birdwatchers

Khurpa Tal: A serene and relatively unexplored lake surrounded by terraced fields, offering tranquility and scenic views

Snow View Point: At 2,270 meters, offers panoramic views of Nanda Devi, Trishul, and Nanda Kot Peaks, accessible via cable car

Tiffin Top (Dorothy's Seat): A hilltop picnic spot providing 360° views of Nainital town and surrounding mountains, suitable for families and couples

Nana Peak (China Peak): The highest point in Nainital, perfect for trekking and panoramic Himalayan views
