The programme was attended by students of Classes IX to XI.

The live interaction was telecast from Combinator, Raipur, Chhattisgarh, where the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India engaged in an insightful question-answer session with students. The prime focus of the interaction was “Yuva Soch for Viksit Bharat 2047”, highlighting the pivotal role of youth in shaping a developed India.

During the session, the Hon'ble Prime Minister shared effective strategies to overcome examination anxiety, advising students to remain calm, confident, and focused. The Prime Minister highlighted that teaching others enhances clarity of concepts and builds confidence, discipline, and leadership qualities. Through simple daily-life examples from Indian farmers, he beautifully explained how both inspiration and discipline are essential for achieving success.

Following the live telecast, the School Principal, Respected Dr. Atul Wadhawan, addressed the students and shared important academic insights. He guided students on effective study habits, time management, consistency in preparation, and maintaining discipline to achieve better academic results. His motivating address encouraged students to remain focused, dedicated, and goal-oriented in their academic journey.

The session proved to be highly enriching and impactful, helping students develop a positive outlook towards examinations, while nurturing responsibility, perseverance, and a growth mindset. The live telecast generated enthusiasm and thoughtful reflection among students, making the event a meaningful learning experience.
