- ❖ If your ward has not been able to complete the home work due to some valid reason then please send a note to the subject teacher.

- ❖ Always remember that home assignments other than written work & oral learning are equally important. So equal importance & weightage must be given to activities, practicals, research work etc. as they lead to different forms of learning.

- ❖ Encourage and support your child's interests. Never pressurize your ward to do the work of your interest. Observe your child's interests and try to enhance his/her latent talent.
