4) House System


The entire school from **Class III to XII** is divided into four houses for sports and co-curricular activities:

8) School Transport System

GPS Tracking: All school buses are equipped with GPS technology, enabling real-time tracking of the vehicle's location for improved safety and timely updates.

CCTV Surveillance: Each bus is fitted with CCTV cameras, both inside and outside, to ensure continuous monitoring and to maintain discipline and security during transit.

Automatic Attendance System: An advanced attendance system has been implemented in the buses to automatically record student boarding and dispersal, ensuring accuracy and accountability.

Air-Conditioned Buses: To provide a comfortable travel experience, especially during extreme weather conditions, all buses are equipped with air-conditioning systems.

These initiatives reflect our commitment to prioritizing student safety, transparency, and comfort in every aspect of school life.

General Instructions

- All circulars, homework, activity calendars, syllabus, and date sheets will be available on the ERP Portal.
- A nutritious breakfast along with snacks and fruits will be provided by the school. The monthly menu will be shared in advance on the ERP Portal for your reference.
- **Stationery:**
Pre-Primary to Class V: All stationery and notebooks will be provided by the school.
Class VI onwards: Stationery must be purchased from the school tuck shop.
- During the first two days, students should carry a handbook/diary/rough notebook, a water bottle, and textbooks. All items should be properly labelled.

- Entry and dispersal will take place from Gate No. 3. Late comers will not be allowed entry and will be sent back home.
- Kindly ensure that your ward attends school regularly. In case of illness, a leave application must be submitted in a timely manner through the ERP.
- Parents are requested to ensure that children maintain good hygiene and come to school in a neat and tidy uniform. Students must carry a clean handkerchief and wear polished shoes.
- Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTM – Learning Feedback Day) will be held regularly to discuss the progress of students. Parents are requested to attend all PTMs.
- **Birthday Celebrations:**
Students may distribute toffees (maximum ₹10 each) to classmates and teachers. No chocolates or other items are allowed. Students may come in a decent colourful dress on their birthday. Jewellery and footwear with heels are not permitted.
