Answer: 3

Running duo

Paul and Danny are runners. One day, they decide to race from Point A to Point B, a distance of 10 km. Paul runs half the time and walks the second half. Danny runs half the distance and walks the remaining 5 km. Assuming both of them run and walk at the same speed, who will reach Point B first?



Both of them start running at the same speed. After Danny has run for 5 km, he reaches the halfway mark and starts walking. However, Paul still keeps running (remember, he runs half the time and Danny cannot catch up with him. Even when Paul starts walking after half the time, he will still be ahead of Danny. In simple words, you cover more distance when you run half the time than half the distance!

Answer: Paul.

Figure it out

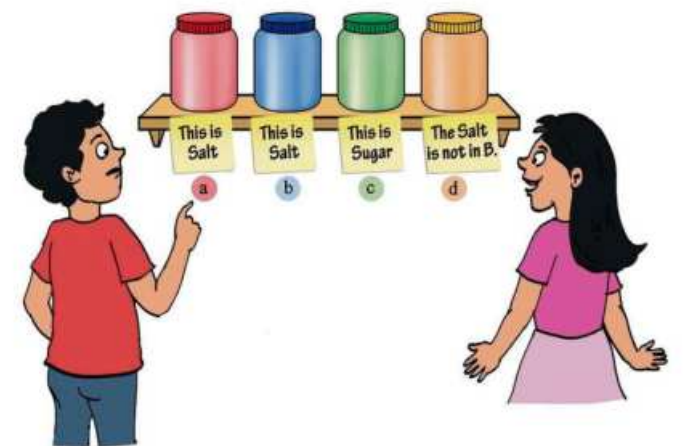
Jim is a part-time attendant at a cake shop in London. As his annual salary, he was promised £100 and an online shopping voucher worth a certain amount. After 7 months, Jim quit the job. He received £20 and the shopping voucher as wages. How much was the voucher worth?



Answer: The voucher is worth £92. Let the yearly salary promised = $100 + x$. Hence the salary for a month = $\frac{(100+x)}{12}$. In 7 months the expected salary = $7 \times \frac{(100+x)}{12} = \frac{700 + 7x}{12}$. Salary received for 7 months = $20 + x$. Therefore, $20 + x = \frac{700 + 7x}{12}$. Solving the above equation, we get $240 + 12x = 700 + 7x$. $5x = 460$. $x = 92$.

Salt and sugar

Bani is playing a prank on her brother. She has put sugar in three of the four jars and left only one with salt in it. She has stuck chits below each jar. She tells her brother, "Only one of these four messages is true." Can you figure out which of the four jars contains salt?



Answer: The salt is in jar c.
