Devanagari is the official script used for Hindi, which is the primary language of the state. The region has a strong oral and written tradition in regional dialects including Bundeli, Bagheli, Malwi, and Nimari. Prehistoric rock paintings (e.g., Adamgarh) and ancient rock inscriptions indicate early human communication. Sanskrit dominated the literary scene during ancient and medieval eras.

Madhya Pradesh was a hub of Sanskrit literature. The legendary poet Kalidasa, known as the 'Shakespeare of India', flourished here (likely in Ujjain), creating masterpieces like *Malavikagnimitram* and *Meghadutam*. Other significant ancient scholars included Banabhatta, Bhavbhuti, and Bhartrihari. The region was enriched by devotional poetry and court literature. The Parmar ruler Raja Bhoj was a renowned scholar. The era also saw the development of various folk styles.

Writers like Makhanlal Chaturvedi and Subhadra Kumari Chauhan captured the spirit of nationalism, while Harishankar Parsai used humour to critique society. The state's literary heritage is enriched by the works of poets like Nida Fazli and Balkavi Bairagi, whose poetry resonates with readers for their profound simplicity and universal themes.
