

## ASSESSMENT PATTERN AND EVALUATION SCHEME CLASSES IV TO VIII

**Academic Session is divided into two terms:-**

a)	I Term	April to September
b)	II Term	October to March

### CLASSES IV & V

- English, Social Sciences and Hindi to be conducted as Project Based Assessments (PT1 & 3)
- Math and Science assessments to be conducted through Open Door Assessments (PT1 & 3)
- PT 2, PT 4, Half Yearly and Annual Exams will be pen and paper tests for all the subjects.
- Computers - Practical / Project - 20 marks; Summative Assessment - 30 marks per term.
- Foreign Language - ASL / Project - 20 marks; Summative Assessment - 30 marks per term.

### CLASSES VI TO VIII

- Written exams will be conducted in all the subjects.
- For Computer Science, two out of four Periodic Tests will be skill based.
- For Social Science and Languages, one out of four Periodic Tests will be skill based.
- For Mathematics and Science, two out of four Periodic Tests will be thought-provoking Open Door Assessment.
- Assessment of speaking and listening skills will be conducted in all languages.
- Skill education will be graded in report card.

### NORMS OF PROMOTION FOR ALL CLASSES

- A minimum of 40% must be secured in every subject for promotion.
- A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory.
