We are pleased to inform you that our school will conduct the **digital PSAT 8/9**, a standardized assessment developed by the **College Board**. The test is administered on a digital device (Windows laptop, MacBook, or iPad) during school hours.

The **PSAT 8/9** is designed to measure college readiness, help students access scholarships, and prepare for the SAT and other competitive exams.

- It offers students an excellent and cost-effective way to practice for the SAT; the PSAT assesses the same skills as the SAT but in a grade-appropriate way.
- The detailed score reports help students and educators gain a deep understanding of the students' strengths and weaknesses, so they are better prepared for the SAT.
- Even if students do not plan to take the SAT, the PSAT offers meaningful insights into their skills and helps them prepare for other similar standardised/competitive exams in India and abroad.
- Students can send their PSAT score report to their free Khan Academy SAT practice account and get free, customised recommendations on how they should prepare for the SAT, based on their section-wise / question-wise performance on the PSAT.
- Educators and Parents receive highly detailed and meaningful data and reports on how their students performed in the PSAT, at the individual student, grade, and school level, which can help drive instruction and focus on skills that most need attention.

The **PSAT 8/9 for 2026** will be held on the school campus on **29.04.26, Wednesday** during school hours.

All interested parents are requested to enroll their wards at the earliest, as seats are limited. The examination fee of USD 14 will be remitted to the College Board. The equivalent amount in INR, including currency fluctuation and conversion charges, will be added to the monthly fee bill for the **month of May**.

The total fee is subject to change **depending on the USD-INR exchange rate** close to the date of the examination. It is expected to be approximately between ₹2,000 and ₹2,500.

It is mandatory for all registered students to appear for the examination, as the amount paid will **not be refunded under any circumstances**.
