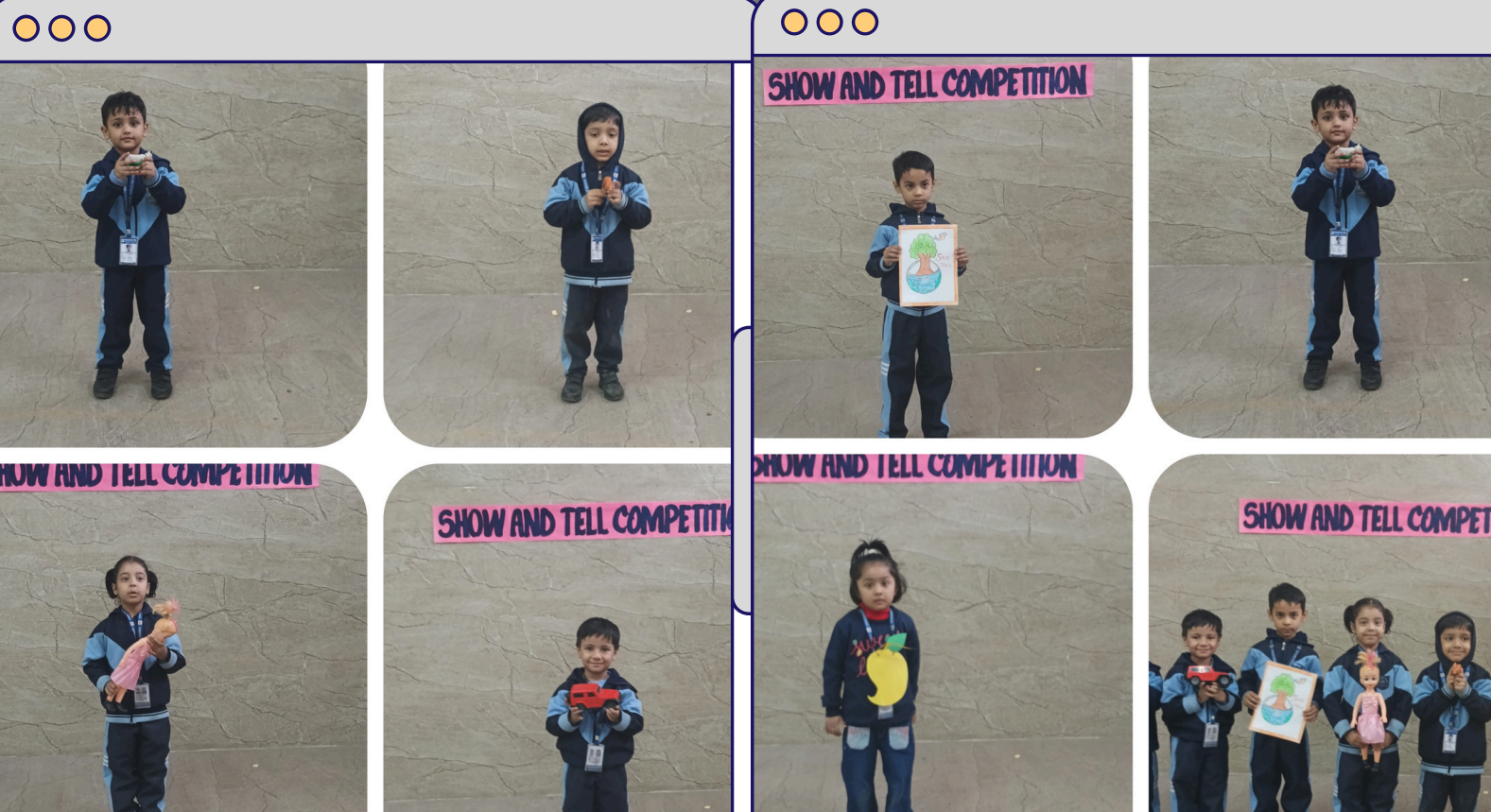

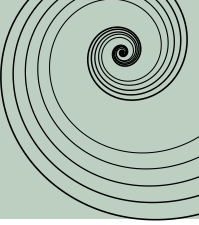
# TRIP TO MOJOLAND

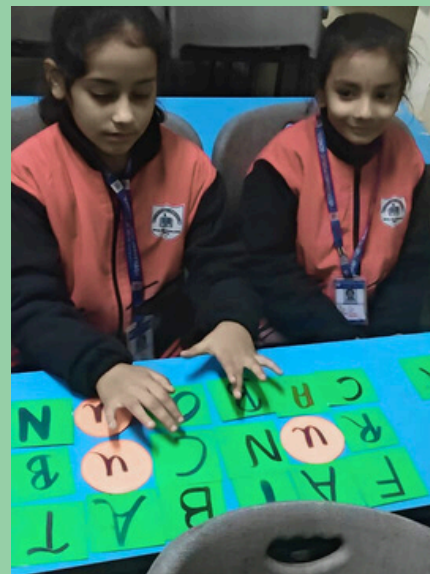
