	IV	Workshop on 'We care, We create, We sustain'	Erudite workshop by STEM on recycling and eco-friendly practices.
	V	Visit to Aravali Biodiversity	Initiative to provide students with an opportunity to learn about the unique ecosystem of the Aravali landscape and the importance of environmental conservation.
	VII	Visit to Yamuna Biodiversity	Initiative to understand biodiversity conservation, studying native flora and fauna and exploring the Yamuna river basin's ecological restoration.
22.04.2026 (Wednesday)	VI	Voices of Earth's Protectors (Intra Class Competition)	Students will dress up as famous environmentalists like Greta Thunberg, Sunderlal Bahuguna, Vandana Shiva or Jane Goodall and speak about their significant contributions towards environment.
	VIII	Go Green Ad Making (Inter Class Competition)	One group (4-6 students) from each section will create and perform a short advertisement (1-2 minutes) promoting an eco-friendly product. Students must creatively enact problem, solutions and benefits of the product.
	IX	Pot Painting (Inter Class Competition)	Students will paint and decorate clay pots with environmental themes such as nature, trees, flowers, birds or messages related to protecting the Earth using eco-friendly material.
	X-XII	Plantation Drive	An awareness drive to save Mother Earth.
