<b>Class</b>	<b>Activity</b>	<b>Description</b>
Nursery	<b>Colouring a Bookmark</b>	Students will design and colour their own bookmarks, fostering imagination and love for reading.
K.G.	<b>Tell a Tale</b>	An engaging storytelling session where teachers will bring stories to life, sparking imagination and a love for reading among students.
I	<b>Read with a Buddy</b>	Students will pair in two and read any story book of their choice in collaboration to enhance their reading skills.
II	<b>Character Champion Battle (Intra Class Competition)</b>	Students will come dressed up as their favourite book character and share a few lines inspired by it. They can also use props of their choice.
III	<b>Bookmark Making Competition (Intra Class Competition)</b>	Students will design a colourful bookmark with quotes or illustrations inspired by famous books and authors.
IV	<b>Character Mask Craft (Intra Class Competition)</b>	Students will design a mask of any book character and portray the same in the class illustrating about their creation.
V	<b>Workshop on importance of reading</b>	Workshop by Scholastic India.
VI	<b>Design/ Create Storybook Cover (Intra Class Competition)</b>	Students will design and create an innovative storybook cover using their own creativity and imagination.
VII	<b>Quiz (Inter Class Competition)</b>	Quiz on Shakespeare and his creations.
VIII	<b>Author Unplugged</b>	An interactive session with a famous author co-organised by Times NIE.
IX-XII	<b>Book Donation Drive</b>	A meaningful book donation drive encouraging students to share the joy of reading by contributing at least one book for those in need.
