At St. Xavier's, we continue to nurture not just achievers, but responsible, resilient individuals—ready to lead lives of purpose and integrity.

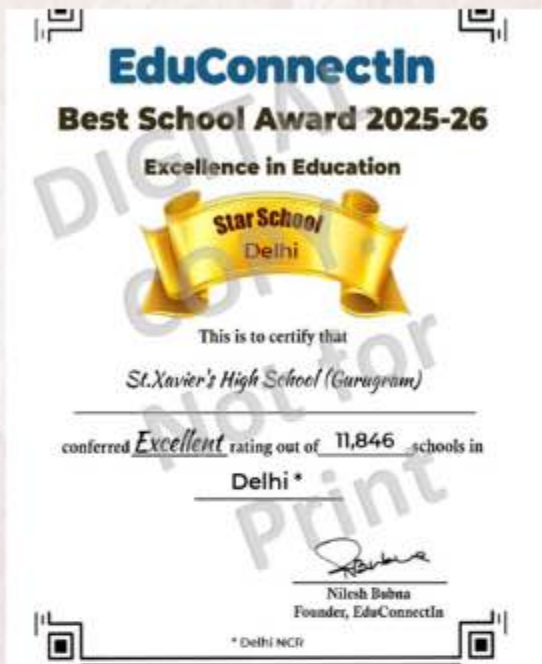

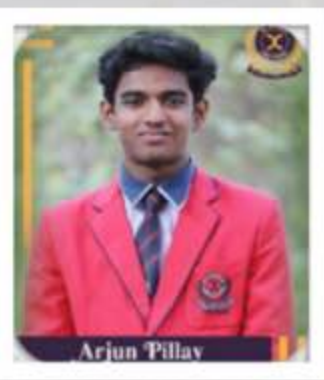

The presence of Mr. Keshav Sachdeva and Ms. Sanya Sachdeva from the management lent profound prestige to the occasion.



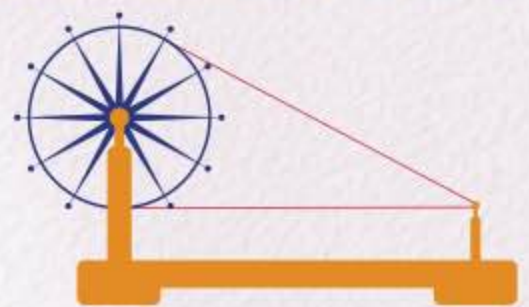

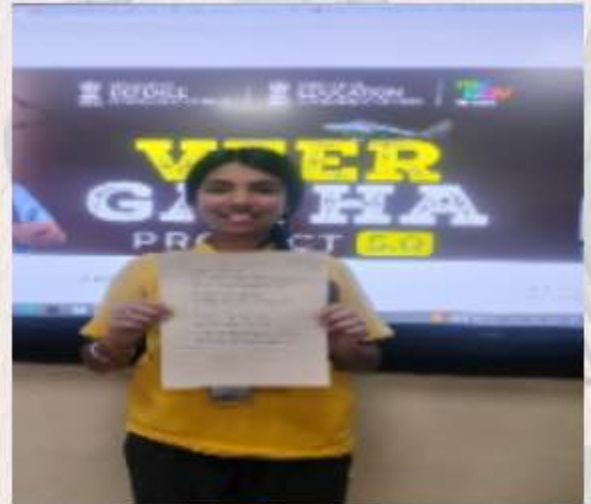

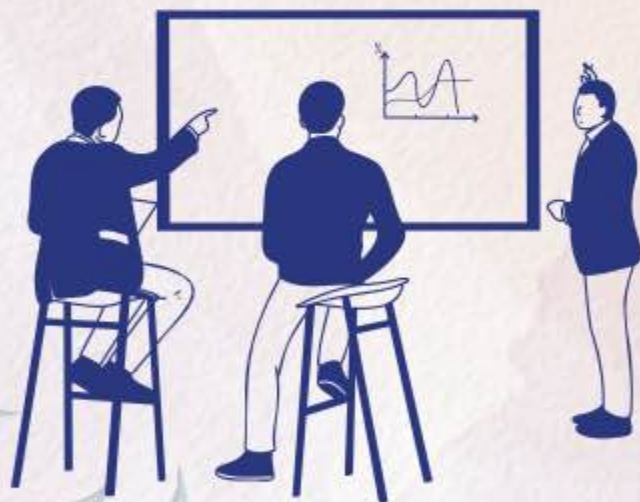
CBSE INITIATIVES: SHAPING CONFIDENT LEARNERS
