Report: Career Clarity & Direction (CCD) Workshop

The Career Clarity & Direction (CCD) Workshop, conducted by Jitin Chawla's team on 29 April, was designed for grade X students to support informed decision-making regarding stream selection and future career paths. The session began with an interactive icebreaker aimed at addressing common misconceptions about “ideal” streams and encouraging students to think beyond societal expectations. A self-discovery segment followed this where participants engaged in activities to assess their interests, aptitudes, and personality traits. The core segment of the workshop provided an overview of the three primary streams—Science, Commerce, and Humanities. Students were introduced to various career opportunities within each stream, including emerging fields, emphasizing that no stream is restrictive when aligned with individual strengths and interests. Key discussions also covered future-ready skills, the impact of technology, and the importance of adaptability. A structured decision-making toolkit was shared to help students avoid common mistakes such as peer pressure or marks-based choices.

The session concluded with an interactive Q&A for students and parents. Participants were provided with resources such as career mapping worksheets and stream selection checklists. Overall, the workshop aimed to equip students with clarity, confidence, and direction at a crucial academic stage.
