With clean hands and habits so smart, healthy summer, happy heart!



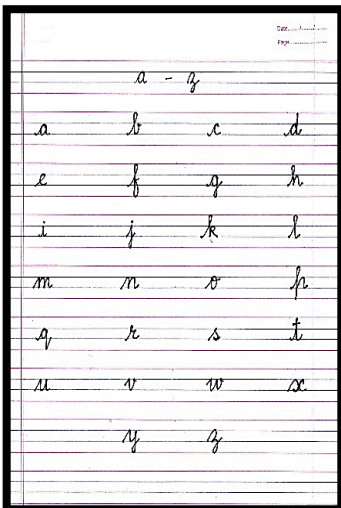
Dear students

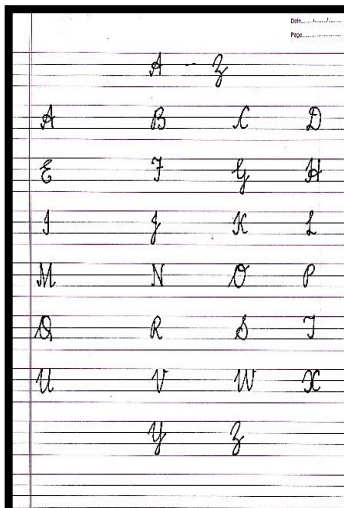
A few guidelines to make the summer break fruitful:

Brush them everyday.

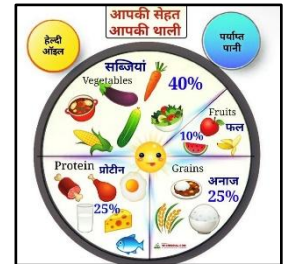

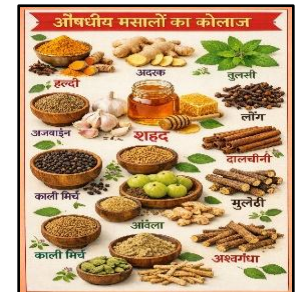
● "स्वाद और सेहत का संगम" (अनुक्रमांक 1-20)

गतिविधि-2 "सेहत का पासपोर्ट"

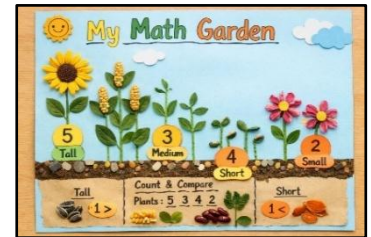

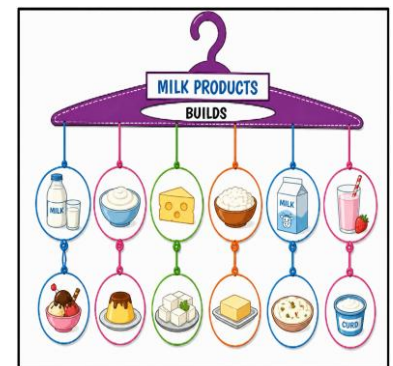
➤ EVS

Food Groups (as per roll numbers):

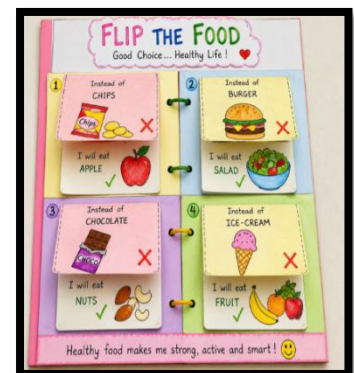
- Group I – Fruits (Roll No. 1-15)

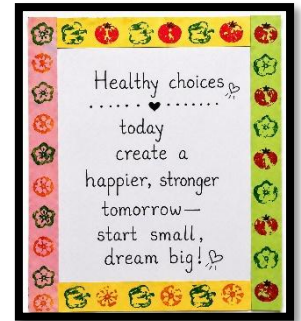
• **My Healthy Platter (Roll No. 1-20)**

On each planet, write one space word and its meaning. For example, Orbit- to move around something, Gravity- the force that keeps our feet on the ground, Astronaut- a person who travels in space, etc.

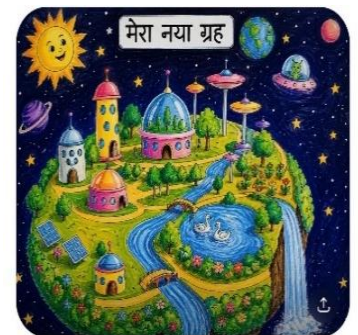
● अंतरिक्ष यात्री डायरी (अनुक्रमांक 1–20)

Task-1

• Planets Adventure (Roll No. 1-20)

Learn number order while exploring the solar system.

Draw the 8 planets of our solar system on an A3 sheet. Arrange them in the correct order from the Sun. Write the names using:

- Cardinal numbers (1, 2, 3, 4...) and
- Ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th...)

Make your work colourful and attractive by:

Drawing the Sun and showing the planets in order, using different colours for each planet, and adding stars, rockets, or other space elements. Decorate it beautifully.



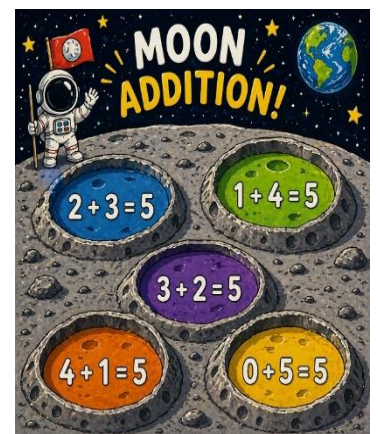
• Moon Crater Addition (Roll No. 21 Onwards)

Create a fun Moon Crater Addition Activity on an A3-sized sheet. Decorate it beautifully.

Draw a large moon surface and make 5-6 circles to represent moon craters. Inside each crater, write a 3-digit addition sum and solve it neatly.

You may also write the numbers in column form for better understanding. Colour the craters in shades of grey and white. Add stars, rockets, or an astronaut around the moon.

Give your task a space theme decoration with 3-D effect by using rope, wool etc.



Task 2: Shape Hunt in Space

Create a colourful space-themed Math poster using a variety of shapes on an A3-sized sheet. Use different shapes such as circles (planets), triangles (rockets), and rectangles (spaceships) to design your scene. Once your artwork is complete, carefully identify and count the number of each shape.

Mention your findings clearly.

Example: 3 circles, 2 triangles, 4 rectangles
