- learn personal safety rules through interactive discussions, stories, and classroom activities.
- promote emotional awareness and self-protection skills among young learners.

The Good Touch, Bad Touch Awareness Session was conducted for Nursery and KG students by the class teachers to create awareness about personal safety.
