

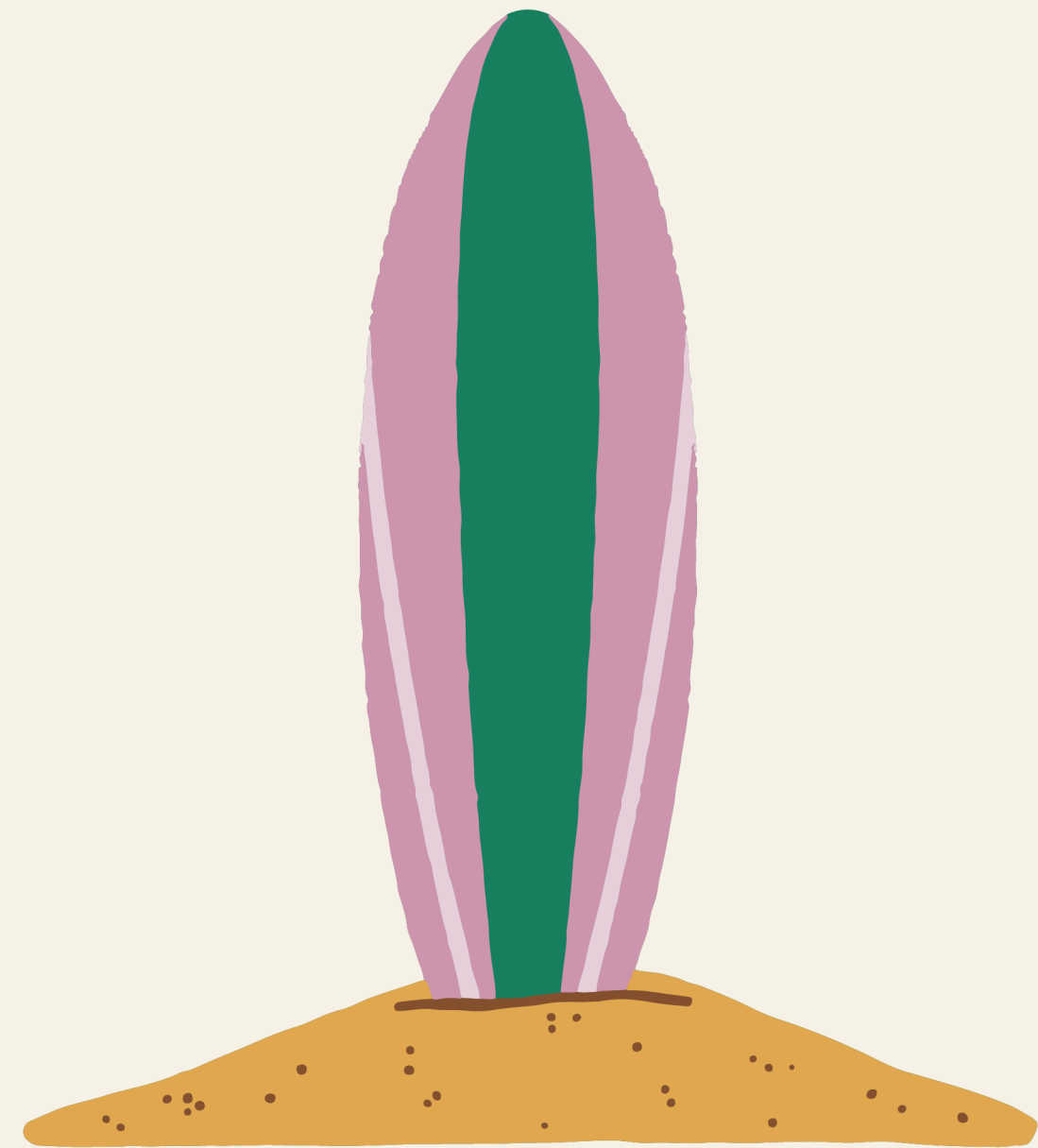

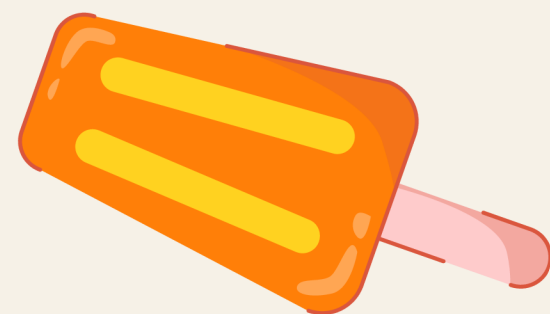
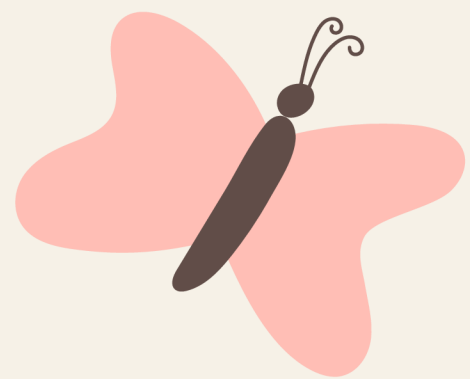


With sparkling eyes, curious hearts, and endless imagination, our Tiny Dreamers are ready to begin another exciting adventure of learning this summer!

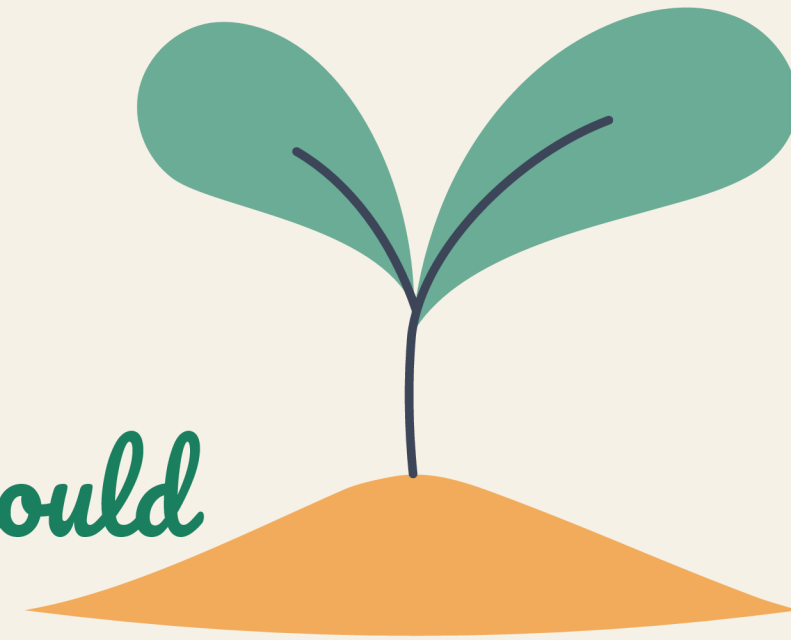
Holiday Homework Guidelines - Session 2026-27

Roll number 19 to 38

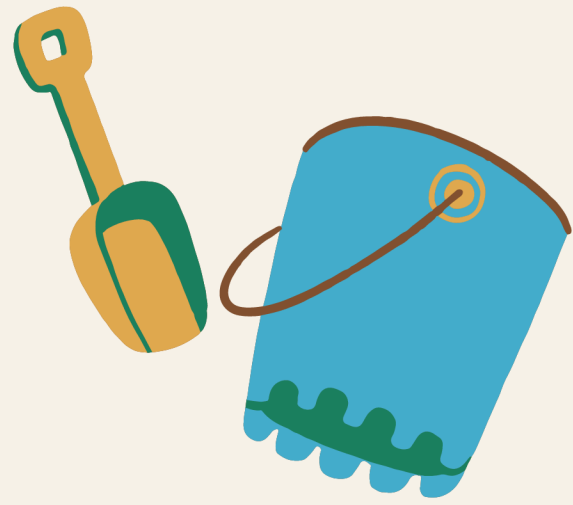
