

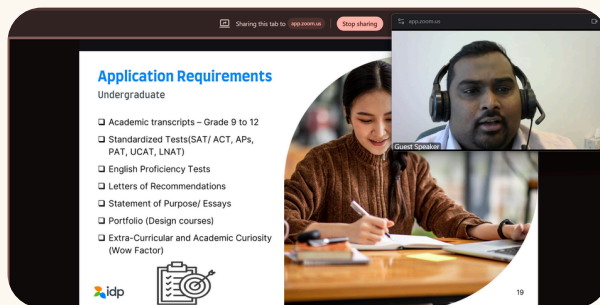
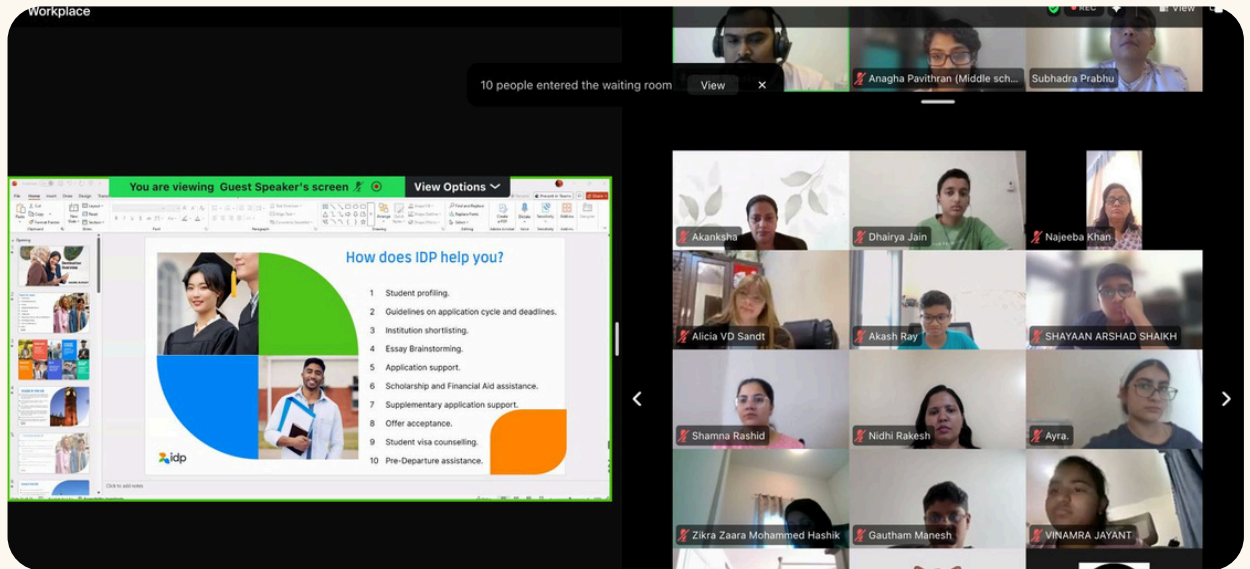

INTENT

A Virtual Career Guidance session titled 'Navigating the University Application Process Across Destinations' was hosted by the Wellbeing Team in collaboration with an external resource person from IDP Study Consultancy.

The main aim of this session was to enlighten students from Grades 9–12 on potential study destinations and key application timelines. The session also highlighted the opportunities and benefits of pursuing higher education abroad, along with brief guidance on preparing strong college applications.

EXPERIENCE

The session was conducted virtually, beginning with a brief welcome by the Wellbeing Team, followed by an engaging presentation led by Mr Shamil Buhary. The presentation introduced students to key international study destinations and provided an overview of application roadmaps for various universities. Students were guided through the general expectations and processes involved in applying to higher education institutions abroad.

This event provided students with an opportunity to reflect on the range of higher education pathways available to them and encouraged them to begin thinking proactively about their future career choices.
