National Voters' Day: Cultivating Democratic Engagement

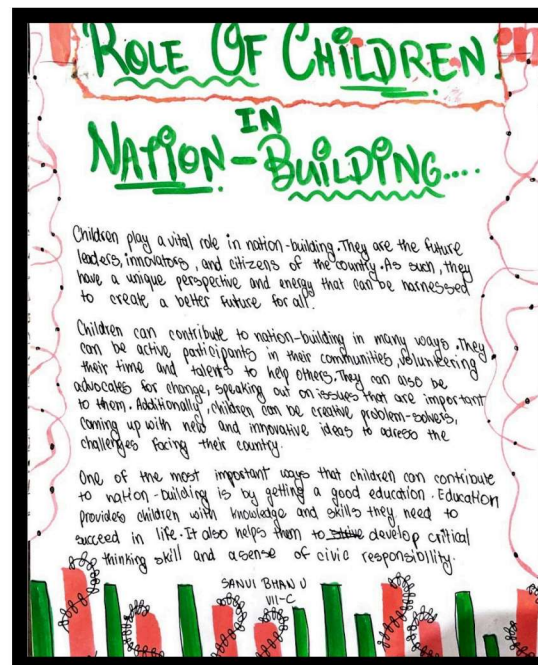
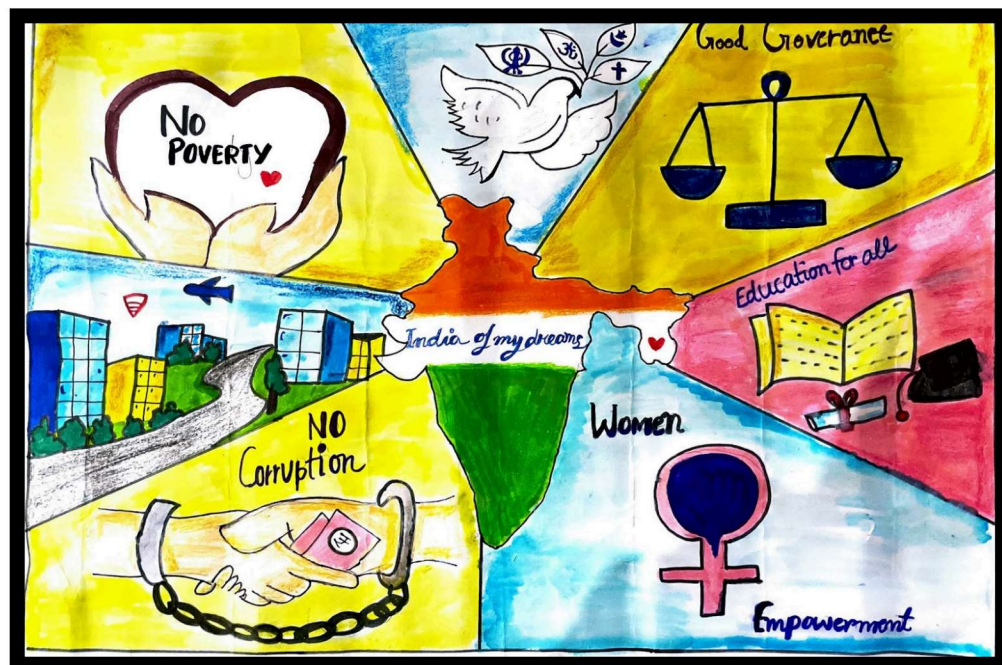
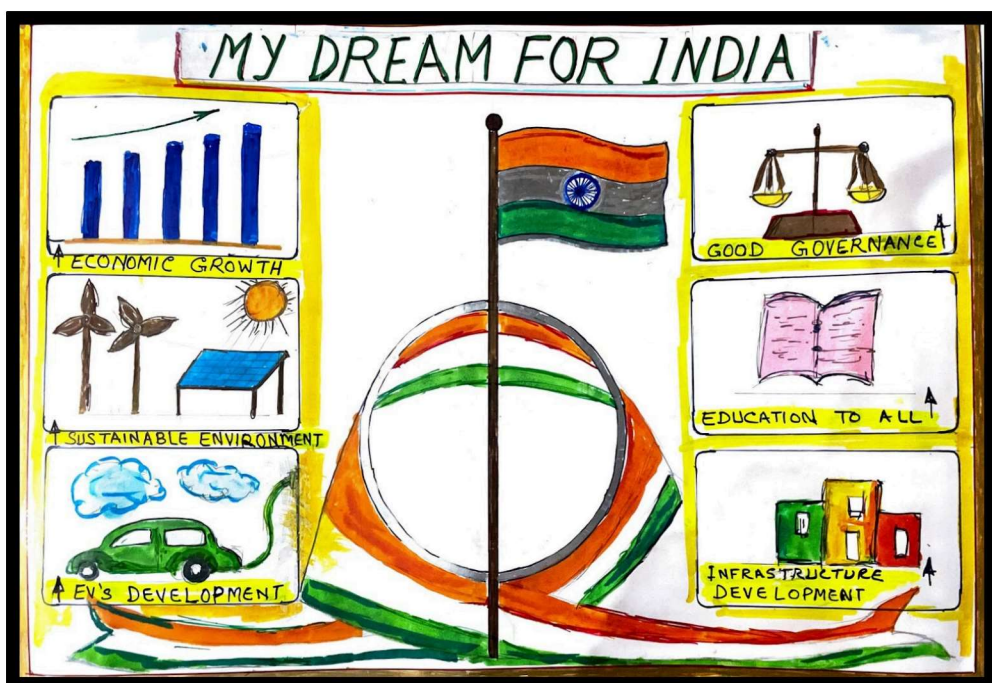

NATIONAL SPACE DAY: ILLUMINATING LUNAR TRIUMPHS

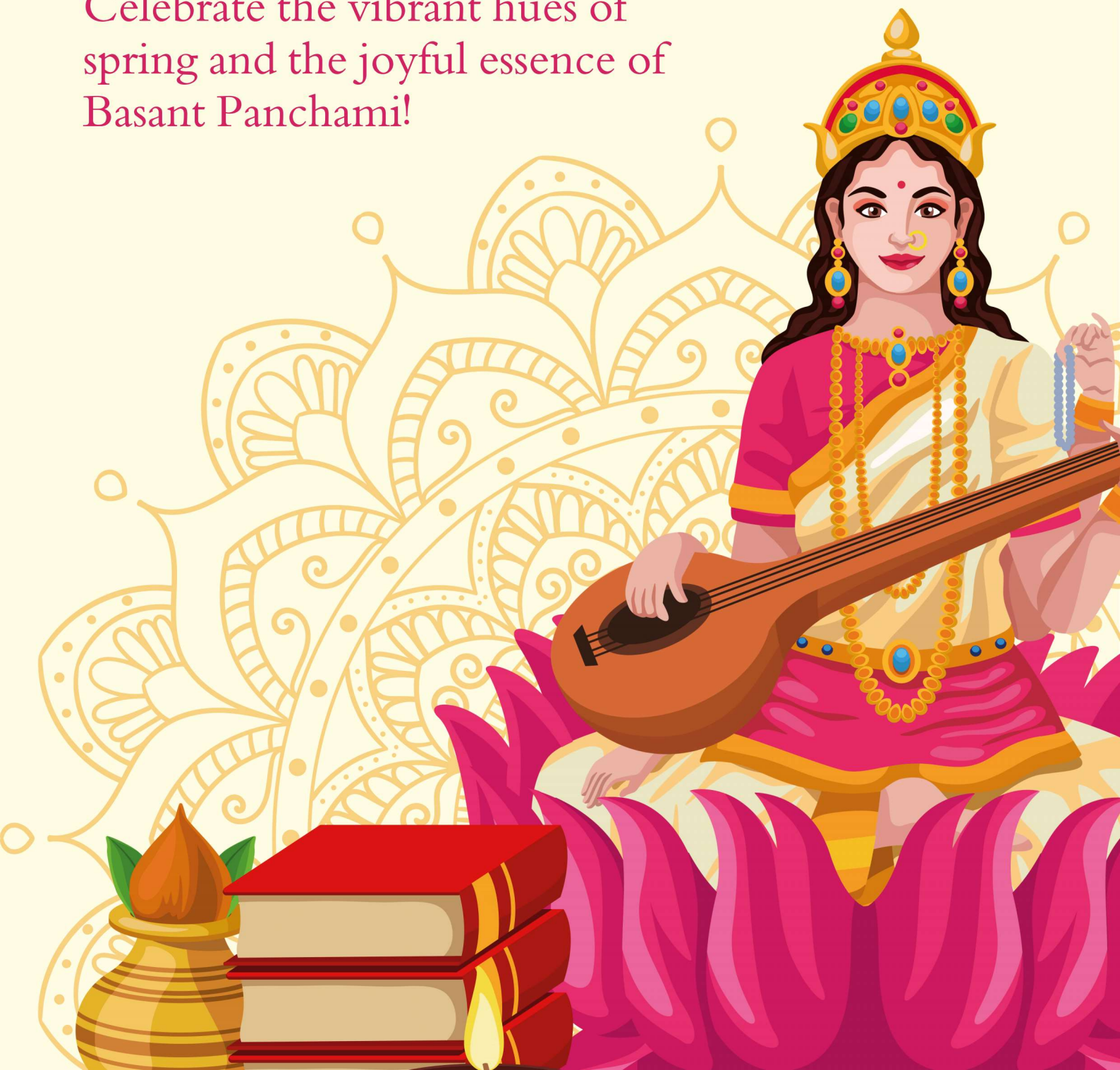

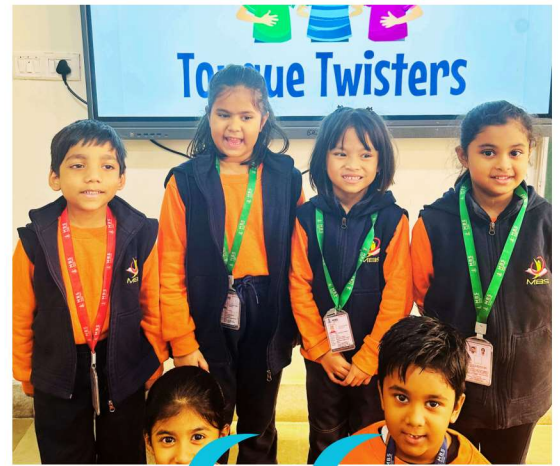


TINY STEPS, GIANT LEAPS:

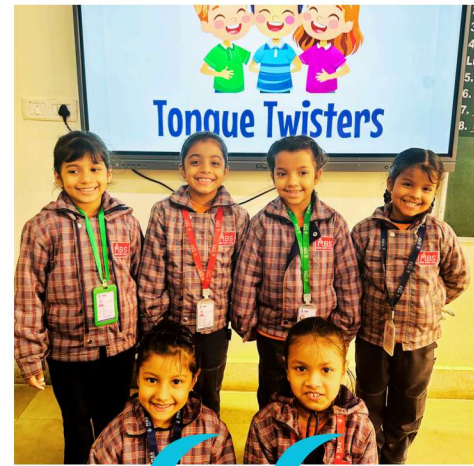




Welcoming and Settling In

MOTHER: A DIVINE EMBODIMENT OF LOVE



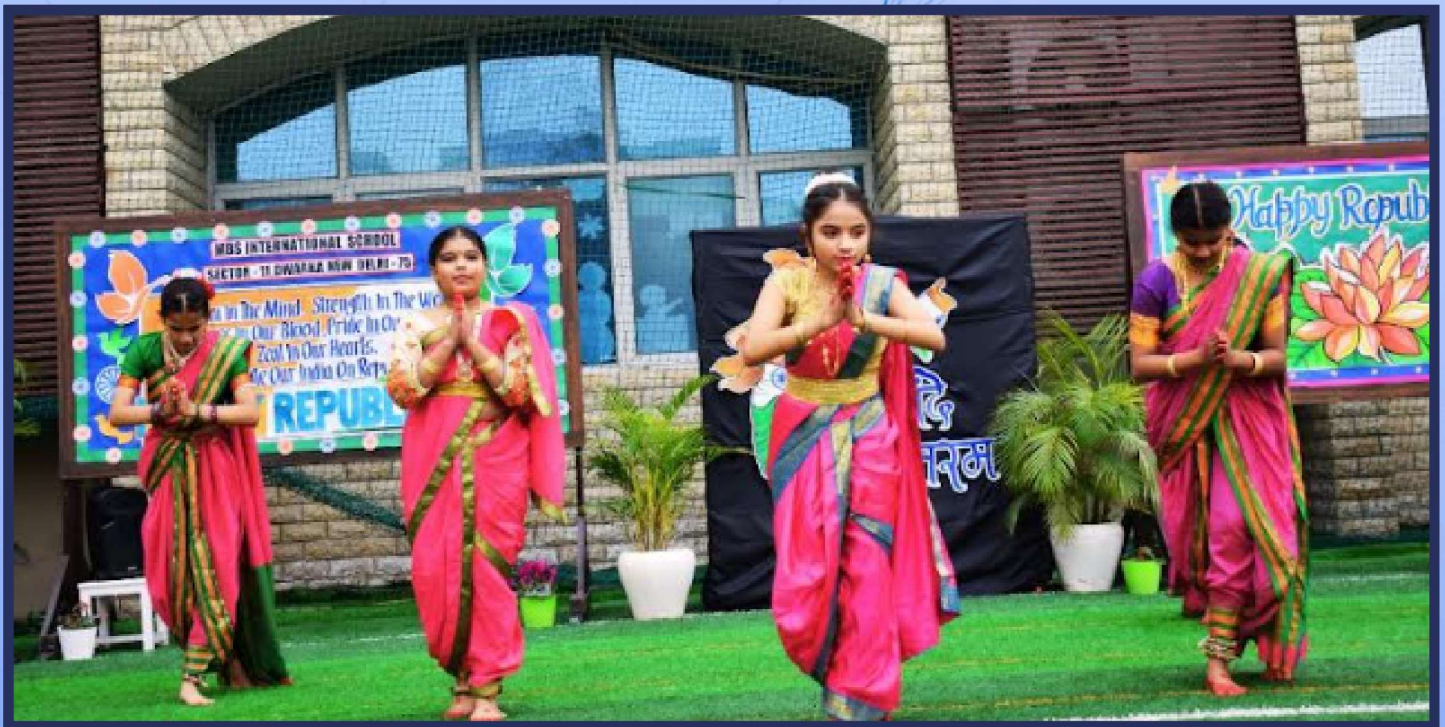

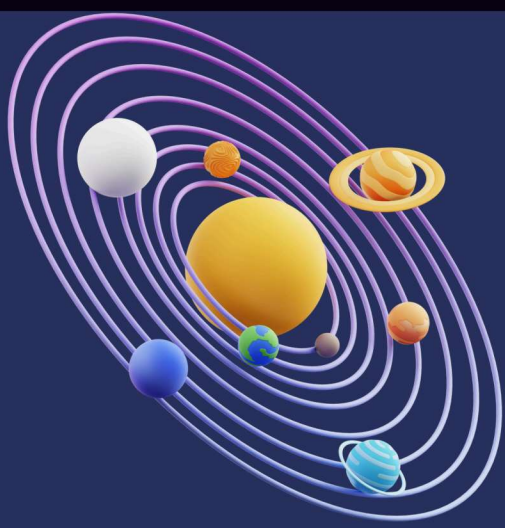


Baisakhi Celebration

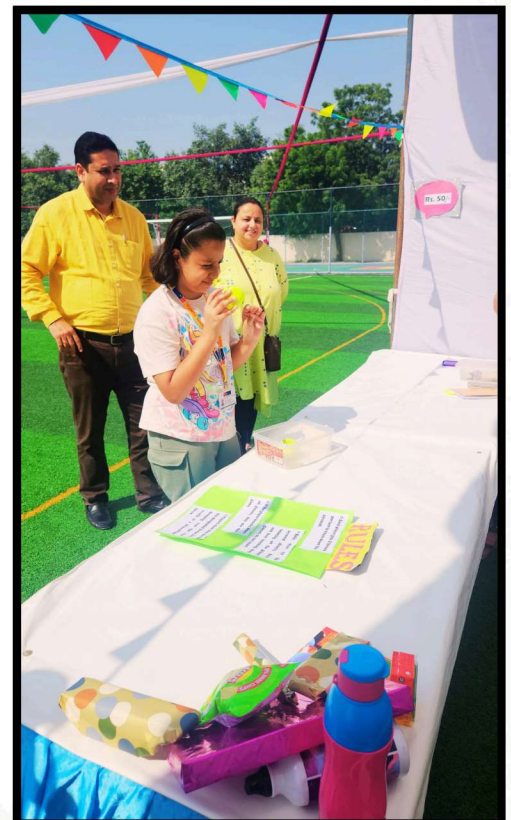

IMPORTANCE OF MENTAL HEALTH

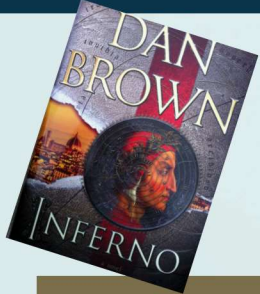

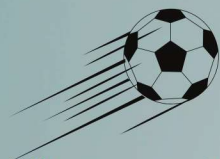

- (7) Battery charging, maintaining and testing.

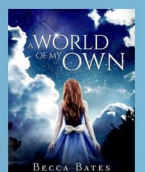

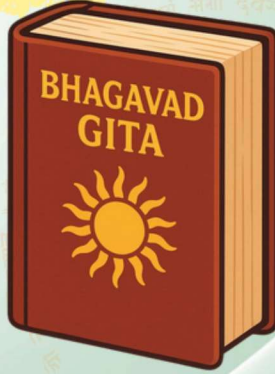

हिंदी साहित्य: एक संक्षिप्त परिचय

हिंदी साहित्य की शुरुआत

हिंदी साहित्य का आरंभ 10वीं शताब्दी से माना जाता है, जो प्राचीन भारतीय संस्कृति का हिस्सा है। संस्कृत और प्राकृत भाषाओं से विकसित होकर यह साहित्यिक यात्रा विभिन्न युगों से गुजरी है।

हिंदी साहित्य के प्रमुख कालखंड

1. आदिकाल (10वीं - 14वीं शताब्दी): वीर रस और राजाओं की गाथाओं से भरा यह काल, जिसमें चंदबरदाई जैसे कवि प्रसिद्ध हैं।

4. आधुनिक काल (19वीं शताब्दी से वर्तमान): यह सामाजिक और राजनीतिक चेतना का युग है, जिसमें भारतेन्दु हरिश्चंद्र, प्रेमचंद, निराला, और अज्ञेय जैसे महान लेखकों का योगदान रहा। आधुनिक काल में कई उपविभाग रहे:
 - भारतेन्दु युग (19वीं शताब्दी): भारतेन्दु हरिश्चंद्र ने गद्य साहित्य की नींव रखी।
 - द्विवेदी युग: महावीर प्रसाद द्विवेदी के नेतृत्व में साहित्य सामाजिक मूल्य लेकर आया।
 - छायावाद: निराला, महादेवी वर्मा, सुमित्रानंदन पंत ने भावनाओं को प्रमुखता दी।
 - प्रगतिवाद और नई कविता: अज्ञेय और नागार्जुन ने जन समस्याओं और समाज पर ध्यान केंद्रित किया।

देश के विभिन्न भागों की यात्रा करने से विभिन्न क्षेत्रों, विभिन्न पंथों, विभिन्न भाषाओं, विभिन्न सांस्कृतिक आदतों आदि के लोगों के साथ विचारों का आदान-प्रदान होता है। शिक्षा केवल पुस्तकों के बोझ वाली एक छोटी दुनिया नहीं है, बल्कि यह एक बड़ी दुनिया है जहाँ हम स्वतंत्रतापूर्वक घूम सकते हैं, हम बिना किसी बोझ या प्रतिबंध के स्वतंत्रतापूर्वक खोज और सीख सकते हैं। यात्रा ज्ञान से भरी दुनिया है। जब हम यात्रा करते हैं तो हमें प्रकृति के बारे में ज्ञान प्राप्त होता है, हम विभिन्न स्थानों और स्मारकों के इतिहास के बारे में सीखते हैं, हम नई चीजें करना सीखते हैं, हम दूसरों के जीवन के प्रति करुणा सीखते हैं, हम अपने बारे में सीखते हैं और स्वतंत्र होना सीखते हैं। भ्रमण के बिना विद्यार्थी की शिक्षा अधूरी रहती है। साथ ही हमें अपनी संकीर्णता और अंधविश्वासों को दूर करने के लिए भी भ्रमण करना चाहिए। यात्रा करने से बच्चा बुद्धिमान और आत्मविश्वासी बनता है।

कई बार लोग यह नहीं सोचते कि यात्रा करना शिक्षा का एक हिस्सा है। लेकिन वास्तविक अर्थ में यह आपको दुनिया के बारे में अधिक जानकारी देता है। हम किसी बच्चे से यह नहीं कह सकते कि वह एक जगह बैठकर दुनिया को देखे बिना पूरी दुनिया का भ्रमण करे। जैसा कि महान व्यक्ति फ्रांसिस बेकन ने एक बार कहा था कि “युवाओं में यात्रा करना शिक्षा का एक हिस्सा है; बड़े में, अनुभव का एक हिस्सा?”

कल्पना शक्ति: सुनीता विलियम्स का आशावाद

कल्पना करने की मानवीय क्षमता एक उल्लेखनीय विशेषता है, जो मानसिक छवियों, विचारों और संभावनाओं के निर्माण की अनुमति देती है जो तत्काल वास्तविकता से परे हैं। यह संज्ञानात्मक क्षमता केवल पलायनवाद का एक रूप नहीं है, बल्कि एक शक्तिशाली उपकरण है जो किसी के दृष्टिकोण को महत्वपूर्ण रूप से प्रभावित कर सकता है, विशेष रूप से आशावाद को बढ़ावा देने में। जब व्यक्ति अपनी कल्पना को शामिल करते हैं, तो वे वांछित परिणामों और सकारात्मक परिदृश्यों की कल्पना कर सकते हैं। सफलता और खुशी का यह मानसिक अभ्यास भावनात्मक स्थितियों पर सीधा प्रभाव डालता है, जिससे आशा और प्रत्याशा की भावनाएँ पैदा होती हैं। अनुकूल भविष्य की कल्पना करके, कल्पना नकारात्मकता का मुकाबला करने और सकारात्मक संभावनाओं में विश्वास पैदा करने में मदद करती है, जो आशावाद का सार है। चुनौतीपूर्ण परिस्थितियों में कल्पना का महत्व विशेष रूप से स्पष्ट हो जाता है। एक उल्लेखनीय उदाहरण अंतरिक्ष यात्री सुनीता विलियम्स का है, जिन्हें एक अनिश्चित स्थिति का सामना करना पड़ा जब वह अंतरिक्ष में टहलने के दौरान अंतर्राष्ट्रीय अंतरिक्ष स्टेशन के बाहर फंस गई थीं। ऐसे उच्च दबाव वाले वातावरण में, मानसिक रूप से समाधानों की कल्पना करने और शांत व्यवहार बनाए रखने की क्षमता महत्वपूर्ण है। यह संभव है कि विलियम्स की कल्पना करने की क्षमता ने उन्हें समस्या-समाधान पर ध्यान केंद्रित करने और प्रतिकूल परिस्थितियों के बीच आशा की भावना बनाए रखने में सक्षम बनाकर उनके अस्तित्व में भूमिका निभाई हो। निष्कर्ष में, कल्पना एक शक्तिशाली संज्ञानात्मक कार्य है जो रचनात्मक गतिविधियों से परे है। यह व्यक्तियों को सकारात्मक भविष्य की कल्पना करने और चुनौतीपूर्ण परिस्थितियों को लचीलेपन के साथ नेविगेट करने की अनुमति देकर आशावाद को बढ़ावा देने के लिए एक महत्वपूर्ण तंत्र के रूप में कार्य करता है। संभावनाओं की कल्पना करने की क्षमता केवल बचपन का शगल नहीं है बल्कि मानव संज्ञान का एक मूलभूत पहलू है जो हमारी भावनात्मक भलाई और अनुकूल क्षमताओं में महत्वपूर्ण योगदान देता है।

लेख : कहानियों की शक्ति: कैसे कल्पना, सहानुभूति और बदलाव को प्रेरित करती हैं

कहानियाँ केवल मनोरंजन का साधन नहीं होतीं; वे हमारी दुनिया को समझने, दूसरों के दृष्टिकोण को देखने और सामाजिक बदलाव लाने का एक महत्वपूर्ण माध्यम हैं। किताबों, फिल्मों और मीडिया के माध्यम से सुनाई जाने वाली कहानियाँ हमें नई दुनिया से परिचित कराती हैं और अक्सर सहानुभूति, करुणा और बदलाव के बीज बोती हैं।

जब हम किसी किरदार की यात्रा में डूबते हैं, तो हम उनकी समस्याओं, संघर्षों और खुशियों को महसूस करते हैं। उदाहरण के लिए, मलाला यूसुफज़ई की जीवनी पढ़ने से हम शिक्षा के अधिकार और महिलाओं की स्वतंत्रता की आवश्यकता को बेहतर समझ पाते हैं। उनकी कहानी ने लाखों लोगों को प्रेरित किया और शिक्षा के अधिकार के लिए वैश्विक स्तर पर आंदोलन छेड़ा। इसी तरह, हॉलीवुड की फिल्म "स्लमडॉग मिलियनेयर" ने गरीबी में पले-बढ़े एक भारतीय बच्चे की कहानी के माध्यम से दुनिया का ध्यान गरीबी और सामाजिक असमानताओं की ओर खींचा।

कहानियाँ सामाजिक बदलाव लाने में भी सक्षम होती हैं। उपन्यास "अनकही कहानियाँ" जैसे साहित्यिक कृतियाँ महिलाओं के अधिकारों और उनकी चुनौतियों को सामने लाती हैं, जिससे समाज में सकारात्मक बदलाव के लिए प्रेरणा मिलती है। कहानियाँ हमें सहानुभूति सिखाती हैं—चाहे वह किसी दूरदराज़ के देश के बच्चे की कठिनाई हो या अपने आस-पास के किसी व्यक्ति की पीड़ा। यही सहानुभूति हमें दूसरों की मदद करने और उनके प्रति संवेदनशील बनने के लिए प्रेरित करती है।
