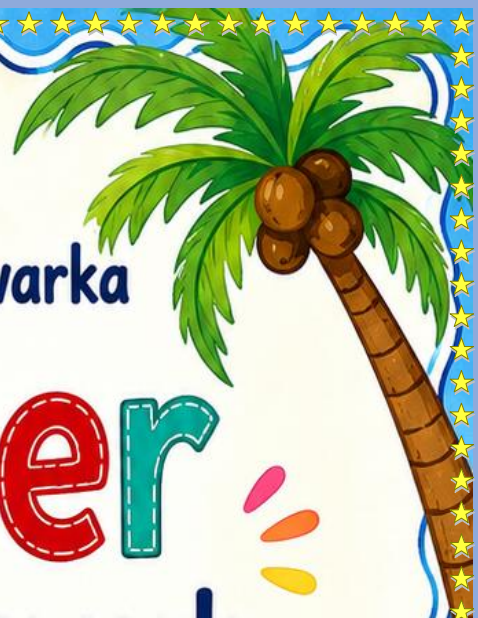


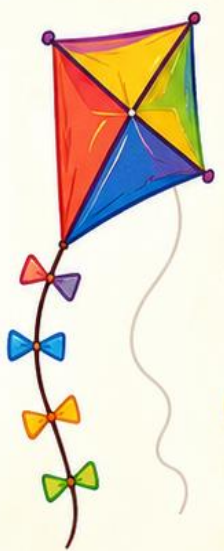

float- to move slowly through air or water

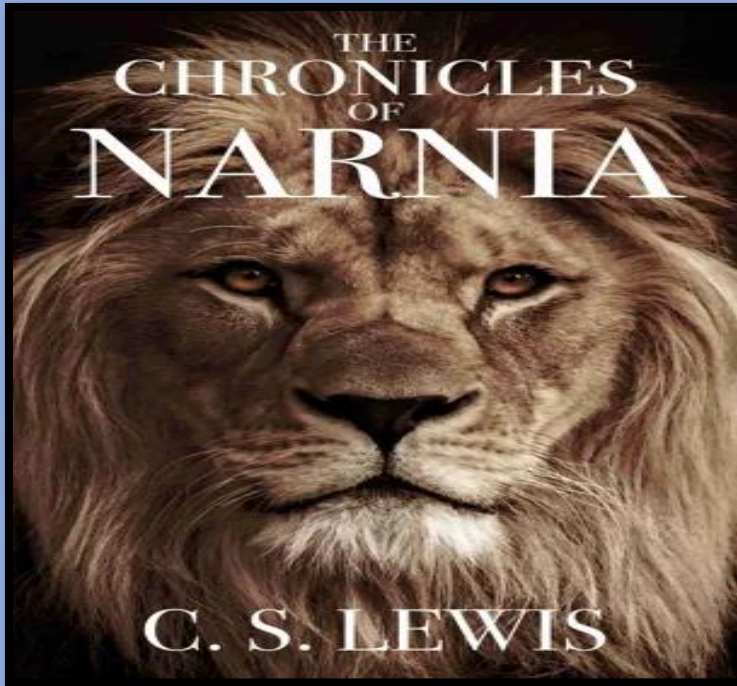


## 2. Movie Time

(To be done in the English notebook)

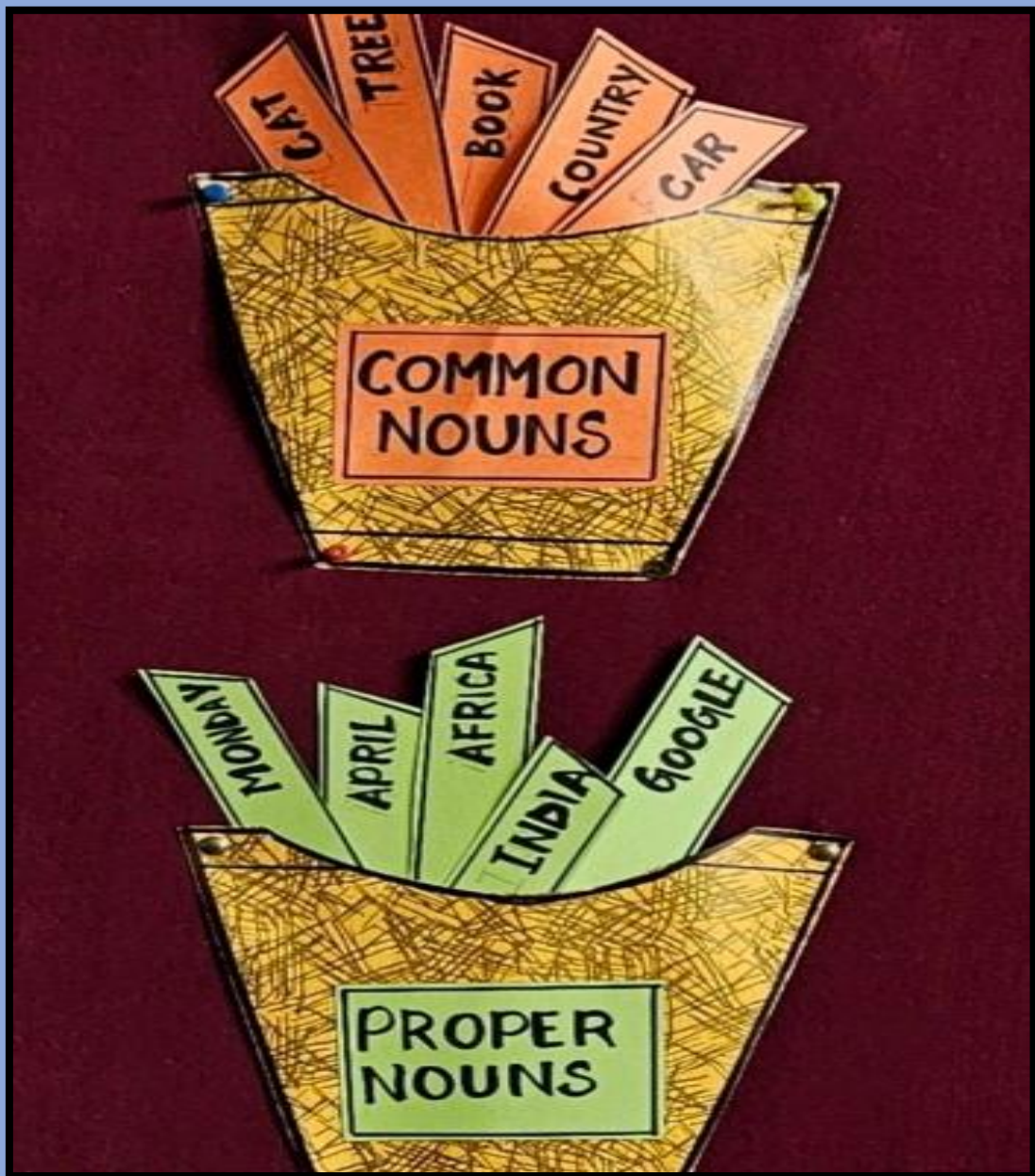


### 3. Noun Treasure Baskets

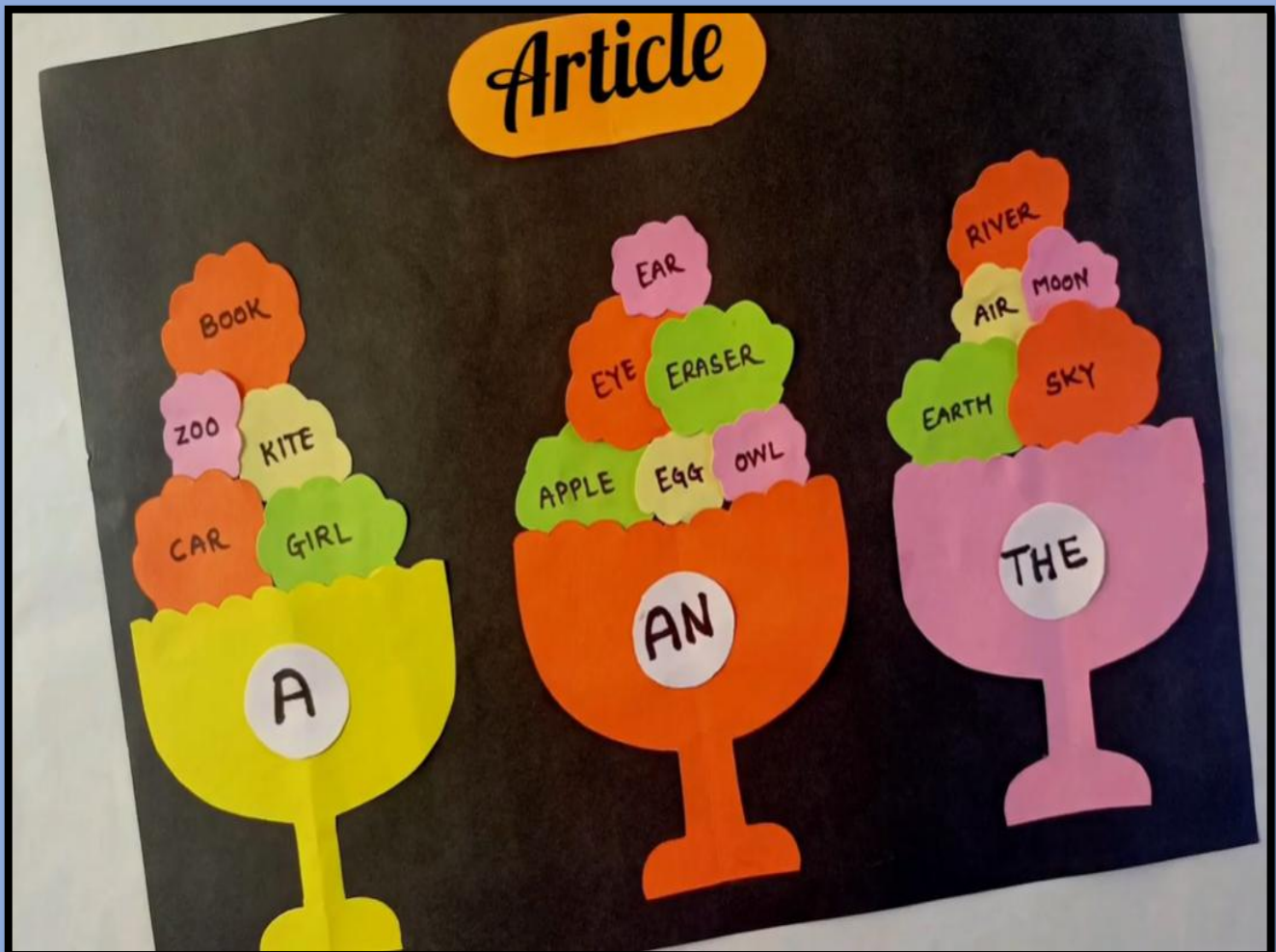


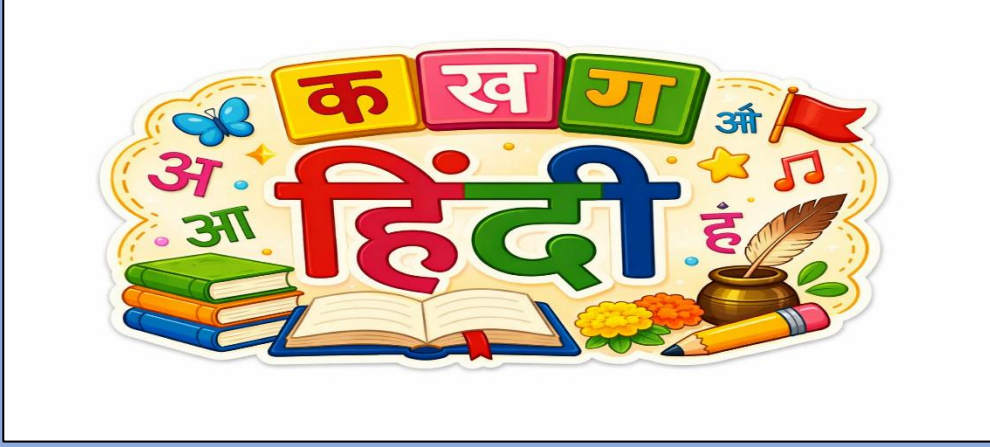
#### 4. “A, An, The Sundae”

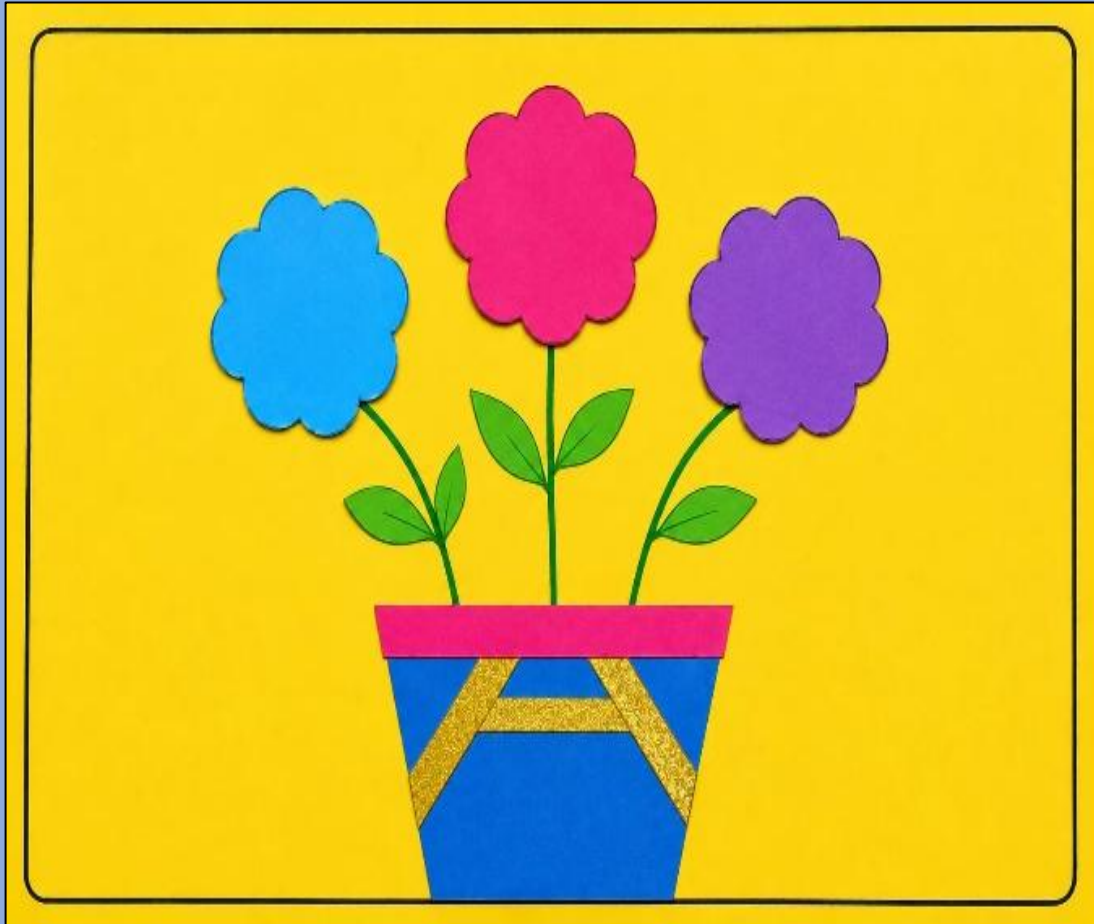
Sort the scoops as follows.

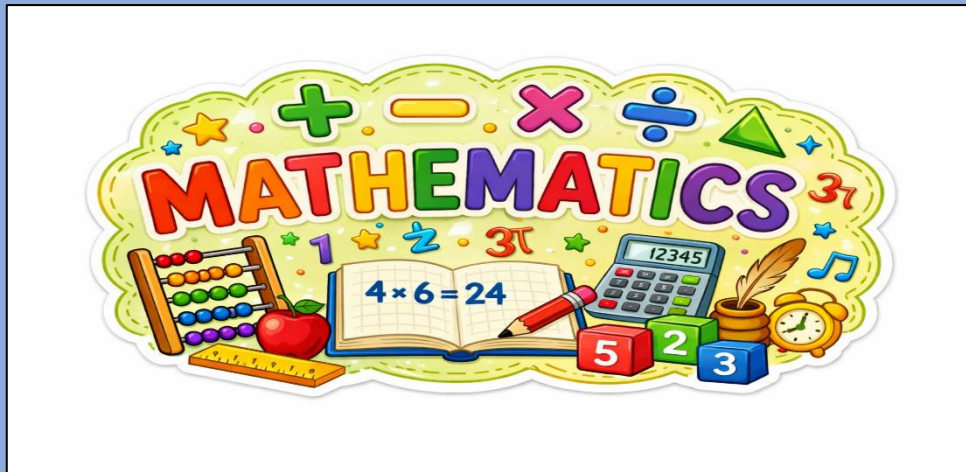

## 1. Number flower

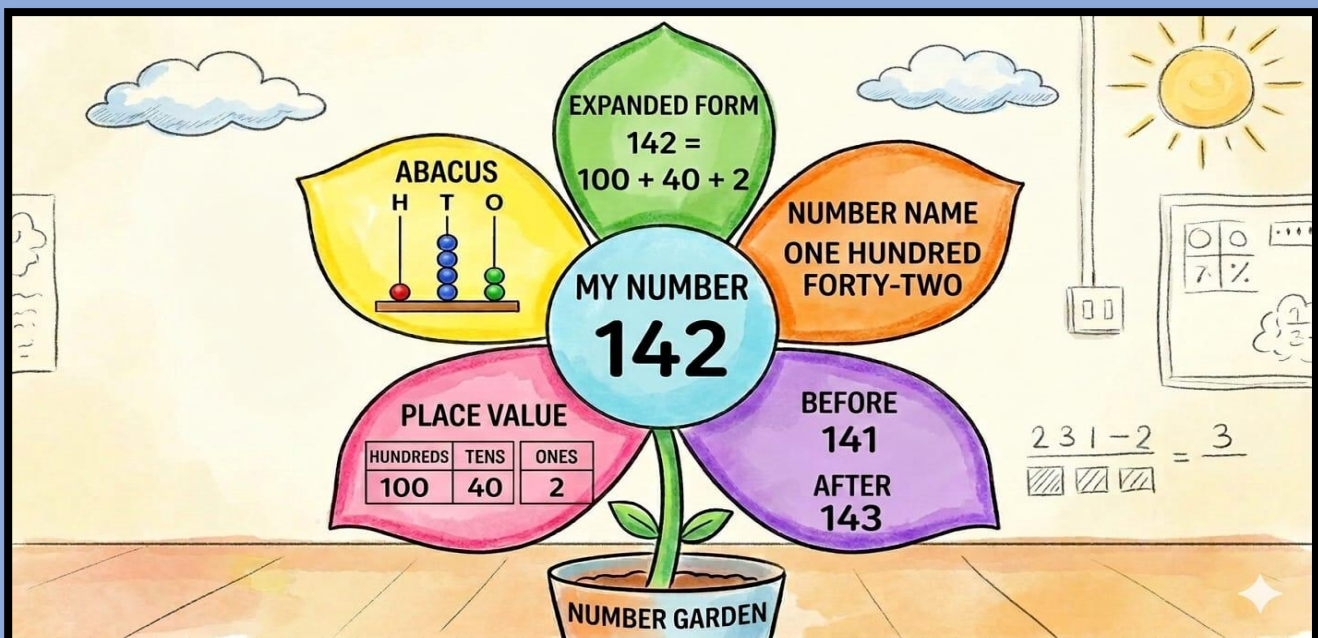
Create two beautiful Place Value Flowers using the numbers given below.

b) 731

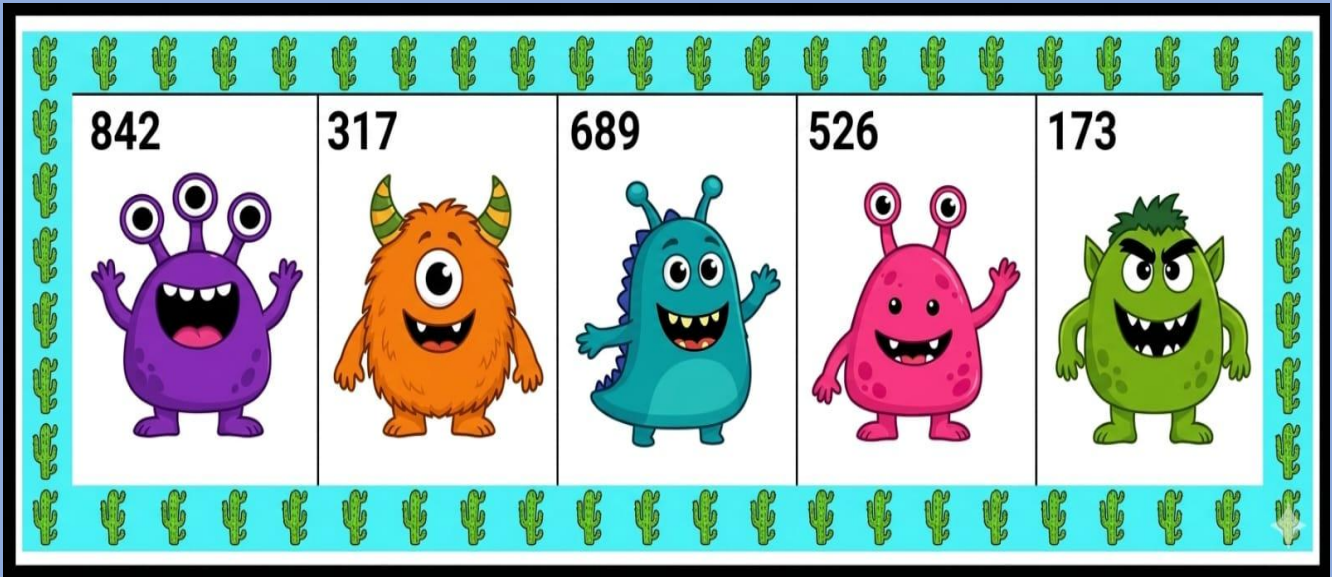
In each flower, write the following details in different petals:

-  Petal 5: Write the place value of each digit. (on A4 sheet)

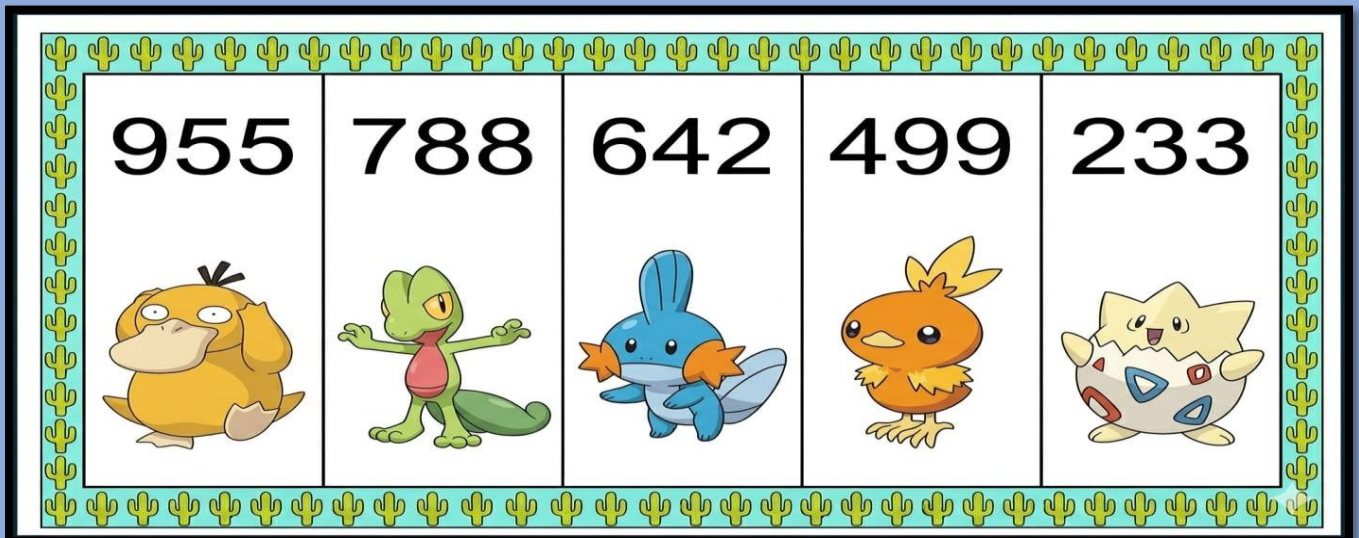


**2. Arrange the following numbers.**
