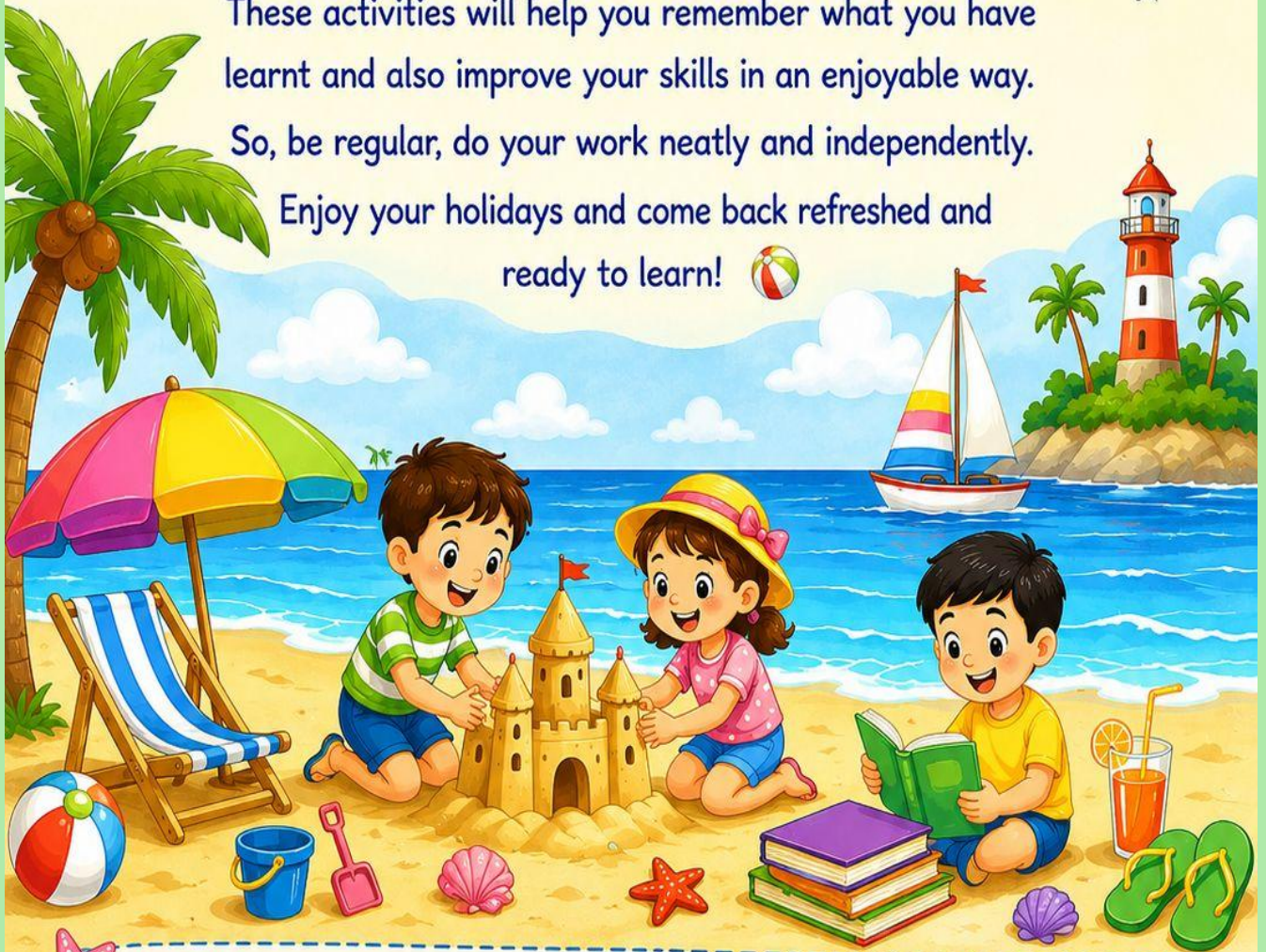
# Hello Dear Students!

3. Practice your **Hindi writing** by completing five pages from 'Snehri Dhoop' in the Hindi notebook.

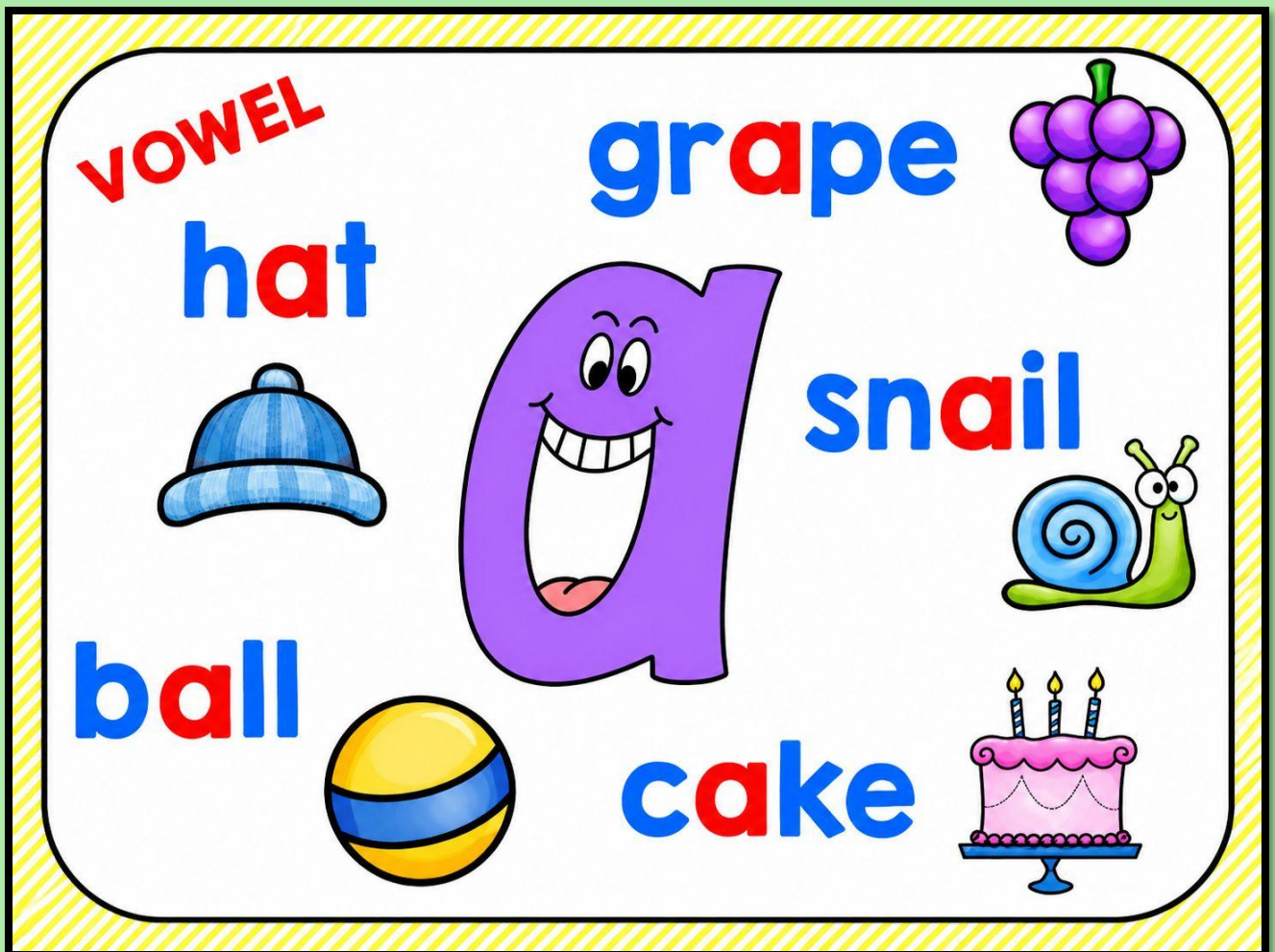

👂 Ears to hear the music.

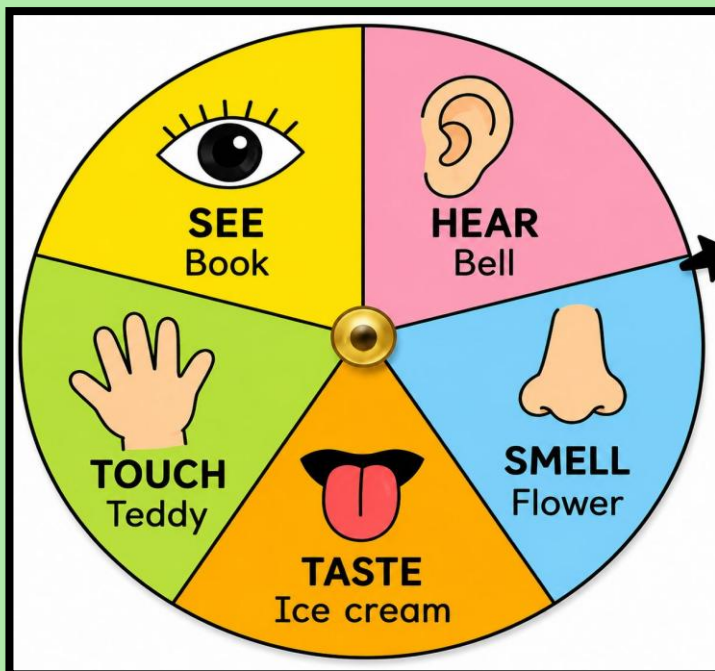
👃 Nose to smell the flowers.

Colour and decorate the wheel with glitter, stickers, or bright patterns.

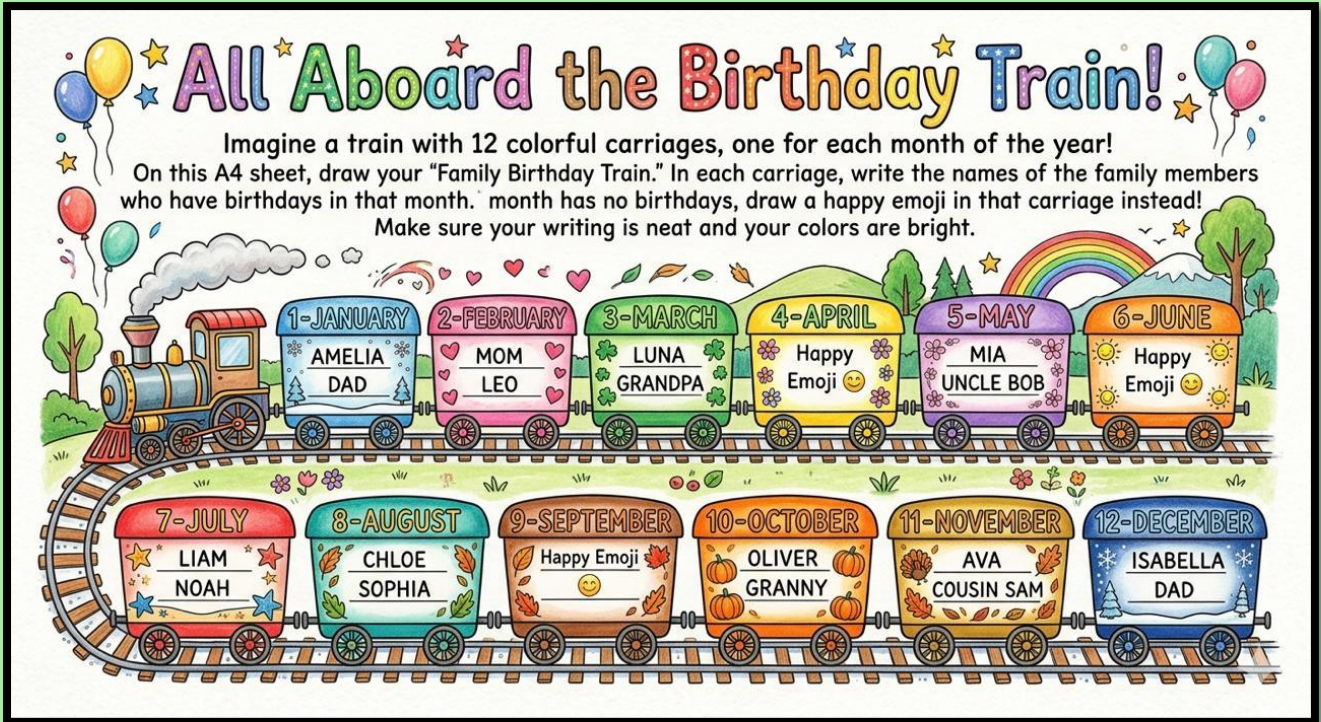
Make it look beautiful! Cut out your circle carefully and paste it onto a piece of cardboard to make it nice and sturdy.
