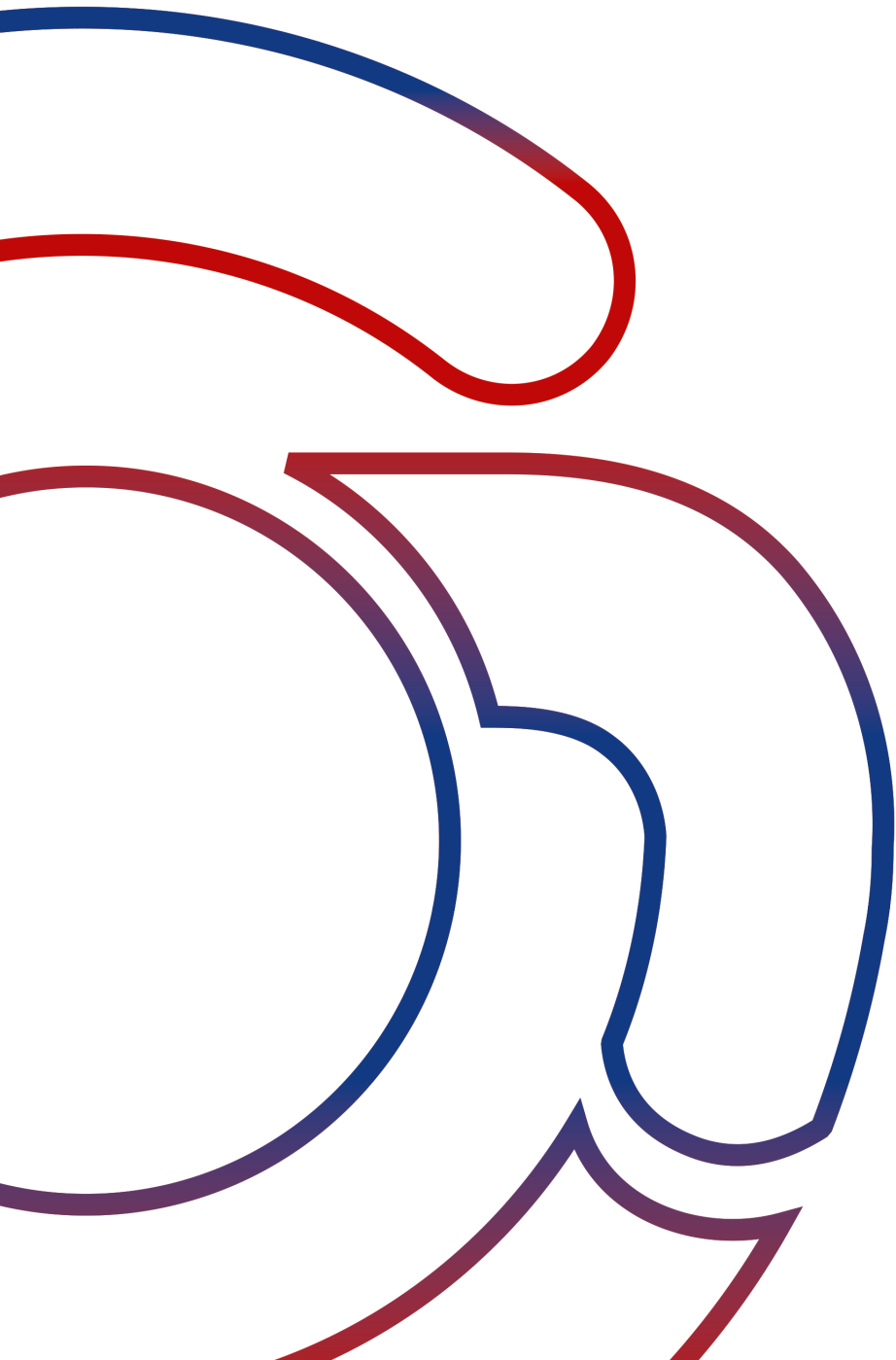

Inception

Parents as Partners

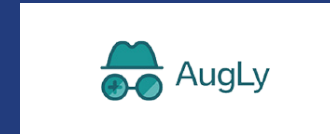

Admission

Becoming a member of the Gurukul family begins with a shared belief in the school's values and its distinctive approach to education. Admission preference is thoughtfully extended to siblings, children residing in close proximity to the school, and learners who demonstrate exceptional passion, promise, or excellence in any sphere.

The admission process commences with registration, following an interaction with the Admission Counsellor. Registration may be completed either online or offline. Upon completion of formalities, admission is considered through an informal, age-appropriate interaction with the child, allowing the school to understand readiness for learning, developmental milestones, and any specific needs that may require support.

Admissions across all classes are conducted through a fair and transparent process. Successful offers are communicated exclusively to parents or guardians via online notification and telephone. Fees must be remitted within the stipulated timeline mentioned in the offer; failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission. Upon confirmation, the child is allotted a class and section.

In view of limited seats, careful consideration is given to each child's scholastic and co-scholastic strengths. Scholarships are awarded to deserving and meritorious candidates, in alignment with the school's commitment to recognising excellence.





The age eligibility for the Foundation Years (Bal Vatika - II) Classes is as follows:

Bal Vatika - for students aged 2 years and above (on or before 31st July of the calendar year in which the admission is sought)

- Bal Vatika 1 - for students aged 3 years and above
- Bal Vatika 2 - for students aged 4 years and above
- Bal Vatika 3 - for students aged 5 years and above
- Class 1 - for students aged 6 years and above
- Class 2 - for students aged 7 years and above

List of the Mandatory documents required at the time of Registration & Interaction

- Self attested copy of Date of Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation/ equivalent up to class I
- Copy of the report of previous class
- 2 passport size photographs of student and 1 of each parent
- Copy of identification proof of Parent (Mother & Father both)
- Copy of address proof

Mandatory documents required at the beginning of the session:-

- Copy of Aadhar Card of both the Parent & Student
- Medical Fitness Certificate of Student
- Previous Class Report and duly signed TC before joining the classes.

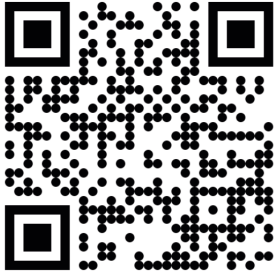
