#### Participation in HBCSE Mathematical Olympiad (2026–27)

Dear Students and Parents,

We are pleased to inform you about the HBCSE Mathematical Olympiad Programme, conducted by the Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE), under TIFR. It is a prestigious national-level competition aimed at identifying and nurturing talented students in Mathematics and preparing them for the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO).

#### **Why is it Prestigious?**

- Government-recognized programme
- Identifies top mathematical talent in India
- Provides exposure at national and international levels
- Enhances analytical thinking and problem-solving skills

#### **Who Can Participate?**

All interested students of Classes IX to XII are encouraged to participate.

#### **Stages of Examination:**

**1. IOQM (Aug–Sept): Objective-type examination conducted in offline mode at designated centres across India.**

**2. RMO (Oct–Nov): Subjective, pen-and-paper examination conducted at regional centres.**

**3. INMO (January): Advanced subjective, proof-based national-level examination conducted at selected centres across India.**

4. IMOTC (April–May): Selection cum intensive training camp held at HBCSE, Mumbai.

5. IMO (July): International-level competition consisting of subjective proof-based problems, conducted in the host country.

#### **Level of Examination:**

Non-routine, concept-based, and beyond the CBSE curriculum

#### **Registration Process:**

- Registration is to be done through the Google Form link provided below
- A nominal fee is applicable
