Make the Ten Minutes Count: Suggested Questions to Ask

- **Programme:** What does a typical day in your summer programme look like?
- **Eligibility:** Who is eligible, and are there any specific requirements?
- **Dates:** When does the programme begin and end, and what are the key application deadlines?
- **Cost:** What is the total cost? Are there any living expenses?
- **Application:** What does the application process involve, and what do you look for in applicants?
- **Outcome:** What do students typically take away – a certificate, a project, a skill or more?

Next Steps for Students

1. **Register in advance** - Secure your spot for each session using the links above. Capacity is limited.
2. **Follow up** - Note programmes you want to explore further. Visit their websites, check deadlines, and plan next steps.
3. **Log in on time** - Join 10 minutes early. Late entry may mean missing an institution's slot entirely.
4. **Engage Actively** - Ask your questions. Representatives are here **for you**. This is your chance to find the right fit for your summer.
