International Programmes at Shiv Vani

As part of our efforts to nurture global citizenship and promoting meaningful international collaboration, the school organized “**Talk Over Cookies**”, an interactive cross-cultural exchange programme.

The first session was conducted with a partner school from Malawi, Africa, wherein students of Class XI participated in a discussion on the theme “**Daily Routine.**” They shared details about their school schedules, daily activities and food habits. The interaction helped them understand similarities and differences in lifestyles, fostering greater understanding and mutual respect.

The second session was held in collaboration with a school from Egypt on the theme “**Technology in Daily Life.**” Students discussed how technology is used in classrooms and at home. The exchange highlighted different approaches to digital learning and encouraged thoughtful conversations on responsible use of technology.

Both sessions provided students with a comfortable platform to interact, ask questions, and learn directly from their international peers. The programme strengthened communication skills, built confidence, and enhanced cultural awareness. It also further reinforced the school’s commitment to developing globally aware and responsible learners.

As part of the British Council’s Connecting Classrooms Programme, our students engaged in a vibrant cultural exchange with their friends from Decorah Middle School, USA. Students became pen pals by exchanging letters, sharing their thoughts on school life, hobbies, traditions, and aspirations.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

School Fee: We strive to give our students the best infrastructure and facilities by using the financial resources available to the school. As you are aware that, for every additional facility, up gradation and addition in infrastructure, financial resources are a must. Funds are also required to meet the daily recurring needs, rising prices, rising salaries, taxes, recruitment of new staff, scholarships and expenses for the under privileged etc. However, despite the ongoing upgradation and expansion of facilities, there will be no increase in the school fee for the academic session 2026-27.

Transport Fee: The transport fee will be Rs. 2250/- per month and will be charged for 11 months only.

Mode of Fee Payment: Parents are requested to deposit the school fee on monthly/quarterly basis on or before the due date. Monthly fee bills can be prepared on a written request from the parent. Fee payments can be made by Cheques or Bank Draft or Online through our website www.shivvani.in by credit/debit card or net banking. Fee in cash will not be accepted. School I.D./Bus pass (with lanyard) will be given to students in the class. Rs. 70/- for the same will be billed in the fee bill of first quarter/ April.

Withdrawals: Parent who wishes to withdraw his/her child from school should apply before March 31, 2026 (mentioned in school diary). All applications received thereafter will only be entertained with fees/dues for April, 2026. **Rs. 2000/- will be charged for cancellation of TC.** For office related enquiries please contact:
