## Cultivating Well-Being & Promoting Positive Growth



The school counselling team remains dedicated to fostering the emotional, academic, and behavioural well-being of students, thereby contributing to a positive and supportive school environment. In recent years, student mental health has emerged as an area of significant concern. Various factors affect their well-being, including academic pressure, peer influence, challenges in emotional and behavioural regulation, time management issues, concentration difficulties, family-

related concerns, excessive screen time, social media exposure, and career-related confusion.

To address these concerns, the counselling department conducts both group and individual sessions. Group counselling sessions focus on essential themes such as anger management, handling peer pressure, developing healthy digital habits, practising cyber etiquette and online safety, exploring career interests, promoting inclusion, and enhancing time management skills.

Individual counselling sessions are tailored to the specific needs of each student.



These sessions are conducted with sensitivity, confidentiality, and adherence to professional ethics, ensuring a safe and supportive space for students to express themselves freely.

Parents are also included as an integral part of the counselling process. Their concerns are addressed with empathy and respect, and they are guided on strategies to support their child's emotional and academic development. Parental guidance typically includes matters related to child development, emotional regulation, age-appropriate behaviour, and constructive communication.

Common concerns raised by parents involve excessive mobile usage, gaming, social media dependence, disobedience, anger outbursts, and issues related to discipline. In such cases, counsellors assist parents in setting healthy boundaries and nurturing a balanced and respectful home environment. They also guide parents in practising empathetic communication, maintaining consistent discipline, understanding their child's learning styles, and setting realistic expectations.

In addition to these sessions, the school also organizes a range of capacity building workshops and career counselling. These programmes further support students in developing essential life skills, building self-awareness, and making informed academic and career choices. These initiatives complement the counselling services and strengthen the school's commitment to nurturing well-rounded, confident, and emotionally resilient learners.

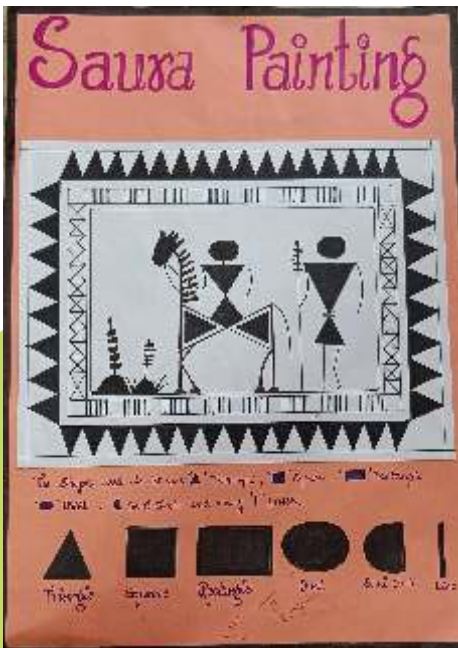

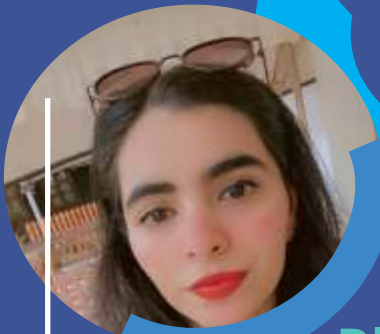

## Rising from the Ashes: The German and Japanese Economic Miracles

When World War II ended in 1945, Germany and Japan stood in ruins. Both nations had been bombed relentlessly, their cities reduced to rubble, and their economies shattered. Millions were homeless, factories lay in ashes, and people faced hunger, unemployment, and despair. Yet, in one of the most remarkable turnarounds in modern history, both countries rose from devastation to become two of the strongest economies in the world. This extraordinary transformation is known as the German “Wirtschaftswunder” and the Japanese “Keizai no

### **Kiseki”, meaning “Economic Miracle.” The German Wirtschaftswunder**

Germany’s situation after 1945 was grim. The country was divided into East and West, with West Germany under the influence of the Western Allies and East Germany controlled by the Soviet Union. While East Germany followed a communist system, West Germany took a different path — one that emphasised free markets, innovation, and cooperation between business and government. Under the leadership of Chancellor Konrad Adenauer and his finance minister Ludwig Erhard, West Germany adopted a social market economy, a model that combined capitalist freedom with social welfare. This meant that while individuals and companies could compete freely, the government would ensure social stability through fair wages, pensions, and public services. Another major factor behind Germany’s recovery was the Marshall Plan, launched by the United States in 1948. It provided around \$13 billion in aid (worth much more today) to help rebuild Europe, and a large share went to West Germany. The funds were used to rebuild industries, repair infrastructure, and restart production. With strong leadership, disciplined labor, and a culture that valued precision and hard work, Germany’s industrial output quickly recovered. By the 1950s, West Germany became known for its quality engineering and reliable products. Companies like Volkswagen, Siemens, and BASF became global names, and the Volkswagen Beetle turned into a symbol of Germany’s comeback. Unemployment dropped sharply, wages rose, and living standards improved dramatically. By the early 1960s, West Germany had transformed from a nation defeated in war to an economic powerhouse leading Western Europe. The Japanese Keizai no Kiseki

Japan’s story was equally extraordinary. After its surrender in 1945, Japan faced total devastation. The cities of Hiroshima and Nagasaki had been destroyed by atomic bombs, industries were crippled, and food was scarce. Yet within three decades, Japan became the world’s second-largest economy — a transformation so rapid that it was called the “Keizai no

Kiseki,” or Japanese Economic Miracle. The foundations for Japan’s recovery were laid during the American occupation led by General Douglas MacArthur. Under U.S. guidance,

Japan adopted a new democratic constitution in 1947, guaranteeing civil rights and renouncing war. Land reforms broke up large estates and distributed farmland to ordinary citizens, creating a more equal and productive society. Economic reforms soon followed. The

Dodge Plan of 1949, created by American economist Joseph Dodge, aimed to stabilise Japan’s currency, control inflation, and balance the budget. Though strict, these measures restored financial discipline.
