

HOW ARE GRADE 2 CHILDREN LIKE?

- ▶ It is important to know your child well. This helps you understand and relate to him/her better. It also enables you to support his/her learning in the best way he/she can learn. Following are some of the traits Grade 2 children show:



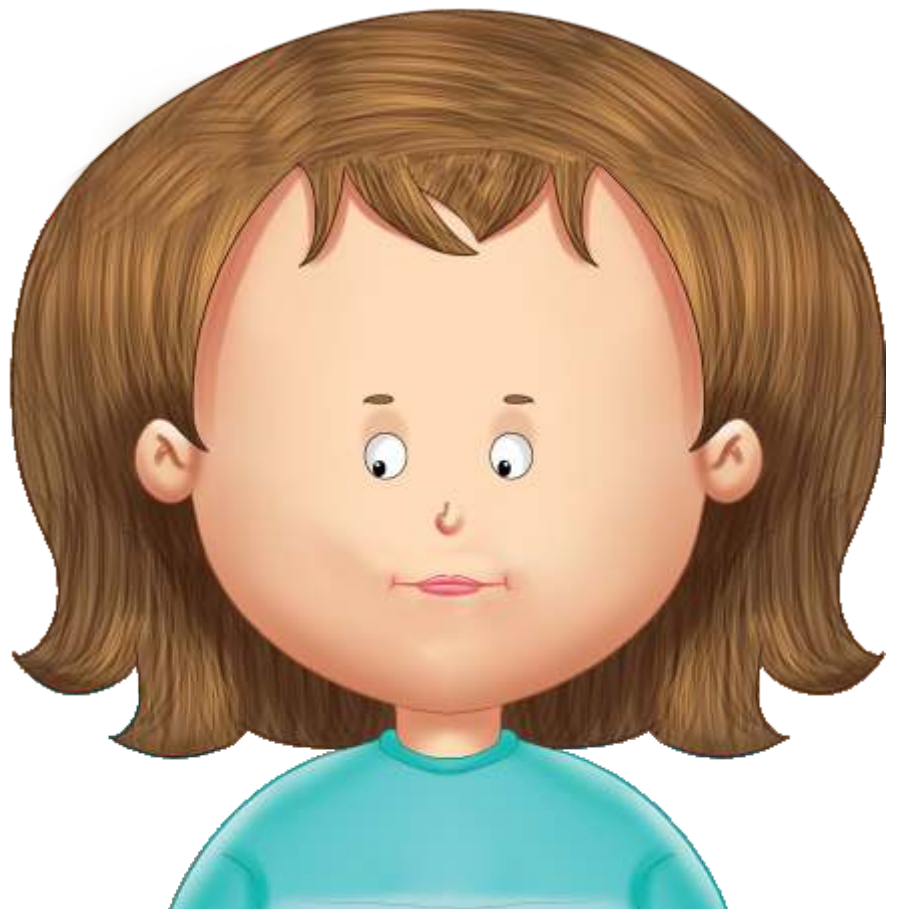
Learning from Experience - Second graders no longer rely solely on their life experiences to learn. Even so, they may have trouble imagining unfamiliar things. This means that a second grader who reads a story about a mountain can create a mental picture if he/she has seen a mountain in the past. But if he/she has no idea what a mountain looks like, he/she might have a difficult time figuring it out, even from a detailed written description.

Processing Information - Children at this age are better at processing information than they were just a year ago. They get riddles, puns and sarcasm. They can build on the things they know to understand more about them, and to make connections to new concepts. If they've been fascinated with spiders in the past, they can now study the details of a spider's anatomy, and then compare it to a praying mantis.

Worries and Pressures - Second graders now begin to care more about how other people see them. They are more likely to worry, be self-critical and show a lack of confidence in their abilities than they have in the past. The pressures of the peer group begin to take hold. Second graders enjoy being considered part of 'the group', and dislike being singled out. They may be embarrassed by either praise or criticism that calls attention to them, especially in front of their friends.

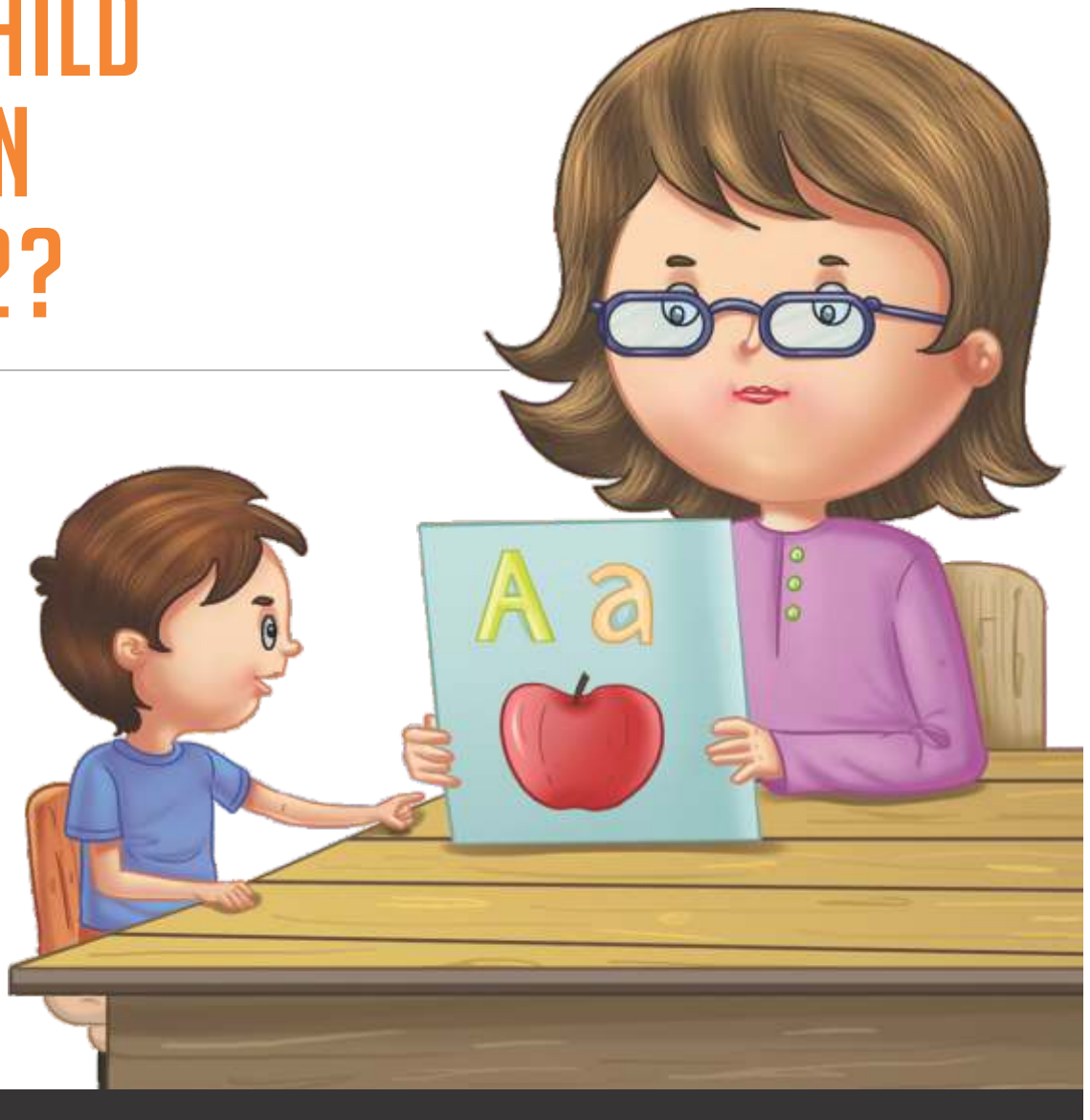

Parents are their children's first and most important teachers and play a central role in the lives of their children. When children are in Grade 2, parents and teachers form a partnership to support their learning at home and school, respectively. In Grade 2, the values and beliefs of the home are acknowledged, and the cultural diversity of families is used as a resource for learning.



WHAT DOES YOUR CHILD LEARN IN GRADE 2?

Each grade has a syllabus. This is what students learn in each subject area. Teachers use the curriculum to help your child learn.



ENGLISH ►

The curriculum provides students with ample opportunities to build and improve all the skills of language: listening, speaking, reading and writing. Students also learn to efficiently use the various skills that help them comprehend texts of different genres. These skills include recalling, locating details, extending texts, describing characters, making connections and relating to prior knowledge. They get multiple occasions to share feelings and present ideas, which not only improve their speaking and listening skills, but also boost their confidence. They also learn to use grammatical functions to make their speech and writing lucid.

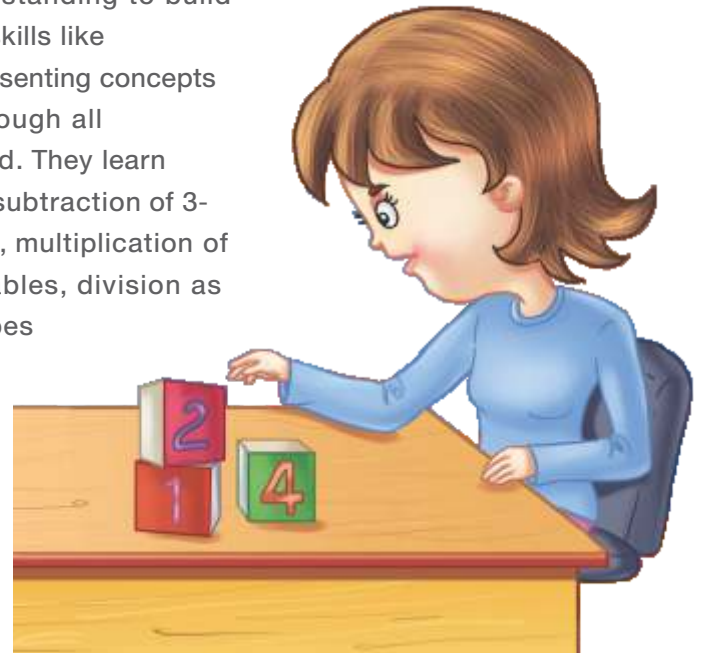

भाषा में शब्दावली के विकास हेतु वे विभिन्न अवधारणाओं को सीखते हैं जैसे—समान तुक वाले शब्द, संज्ञा, विलोम शब्द, काम वाले शब्द, एक—अनेक शब्द, लिंग शब्द, समानार्थी शब्द व अनेक शब्दों के लिए एक शब्द। वे इनका प्रयोग लेखन व अपनी बातचीत में करते हैं। बच्चे वर्तनी व लेखन में सहायक विभिन्न अवधारणाओं की समझ बनाते हैं, जैसे—द्वित्व व्यंजन, संयुक्ताक्षर व प्रश्नचिह्न आदि। वे पोस्टर लेखन, अनुभव लेखन और काल्पनिक लेखन करते हैं।

MATHEMATICS ▶

The curriculum provides various opportunities of learning concepts and skills using concrete materials, pictures and symbols (numbers). Students are encouraged to talk about their experiences and understanding to build mathematical language. A strong emphasis is given on skills like connection building, reasoning, problem solving and representing concepts using various modes. Exposure of estimation runs through all concepts and a foundation for mental arithmetic is laid. They learn numbers up to 999 and their place value, addition and subtraction of 3-digit numbers with regrouping (carry over and borrowing), multiplication of 2-digit numbers with 1-digit number, construction of tables, division as equal sharing, odd and even numbers, patterns in shapes and numbers, 2D and 3D shapes and their basic properties, measurement of length, weight and capacity in standard units, reading clock and calendar, transaction of amounts, collecting data in tables, and reading and representing data in pictographs. Contextual word problems related to the major concepts are also included in the curriculum.



PROJECT BASED LEARNING (PBL)▶

Project Based Learning uses projects which integrate concepts and skills from various subjects like EVS, Mathematics, English, Hindi, Visual Arts and TechField. These projects make learning relevant and useful to children by establishing connection to life outside the classroom. It helps them understand the world around them. These projects emerge from children's immediate surroundings and are organised considering their cognitive development and social needs. Projects included in this grade are I Love My Family, Water, Travel and Seasons.



TECHFIELD▶



Students learn about Input and Output Devices and categorise the different parts of computers accordingly. They explore Windows and understand desktop, icons, files and folders. They are introduced to MS Paint to further explore their creative skills. Later in the session, they learn a new word processing software – WordPad 2007 in which they learn to create a document by applying various font styles, font size and text color. They format text, insert pictures and use list styles in WordPad.

CONNECT TO THEIR WORLD

Take initiative to learn about what your child is currently learning at the school. Spend time making friends with your child, and becoming part of his/her world. It is not enough to know what the child is doing at school. As a parent, you need to know what the child thinks and feels about the experiences he/she is going through in the school. Celebrate and encourage your child's efforts.



TALK WITH CHILDREN

Was there anything new and interesting in the school today?

What did you learn today?

Can you teach that to me?

BE A RESOURCE

Students conduct first-hand research, may need to make observations when travelling on a family vacation, or 'interview' you or others on a certain topic. Act as a resource **ONLY** when your child needs one.

At this stage, facilitate a routine of reading, writing or doing any learning activity at a particular time during the day. Include eating and sleeping on time. Share what you read and encourage him/her to read. Help your child take decisions by offering reasonable choices. Include him/her in everyday activities and help him/her take responsibility of small tasks.



TRUST THE TEACHING

We are continuously learning from various new researches and practices from around the world so that the school can give your child the very best of learning environments.

BE IN TOUCH WITH WHAT IS HAPPENING IN SCHOOL
