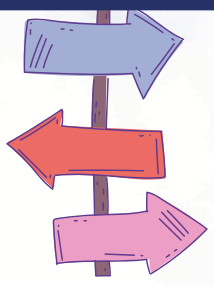

The group returned safely to the school premises, bringing the memorable outing to a successful conclusion.

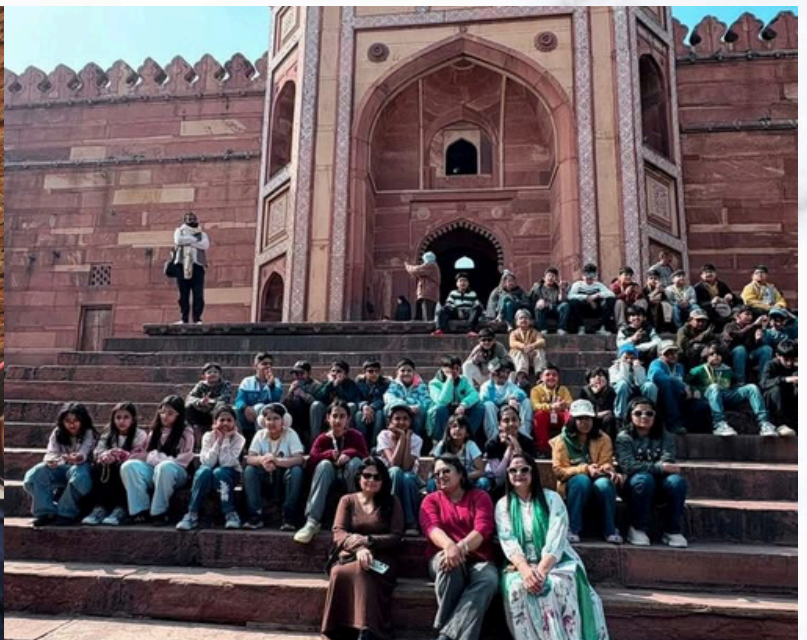
