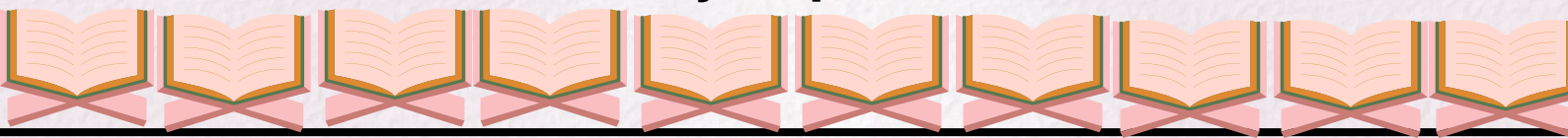
BASANT PANCHAMI

INTER-HOUSE SOLO DANCE COMPETITION

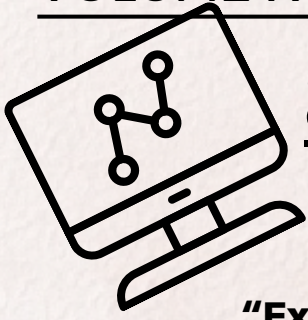


“Dance- A Dream of Your Feet”

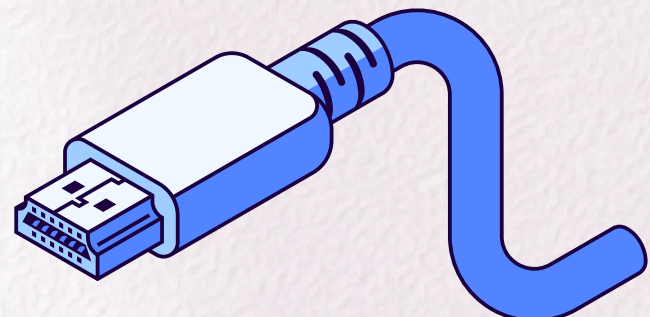
STEAM EXHIBITION

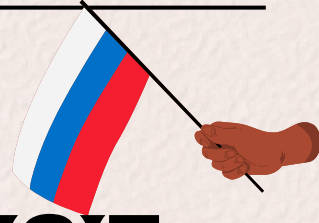
“Explore, Engage, Excel”

Overall, the visit was a memorable and enriching experience for both the guests and the school, strengthening international ties and promoting a spirit of global understanding and mutual respect.

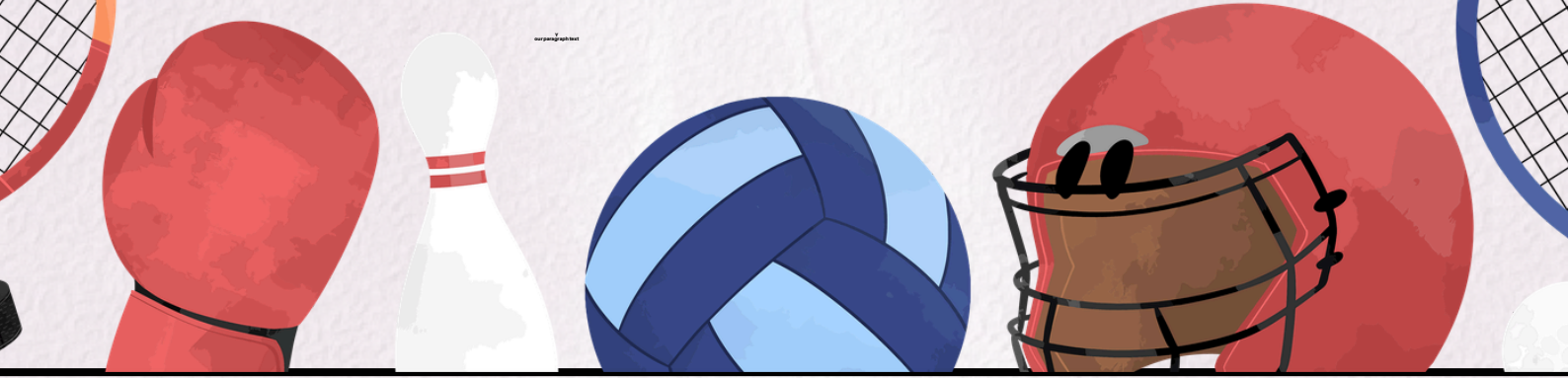


INTER-HOUSE SPORTS TOURNAMENT

ROCKSPORT – PICNIC DAY

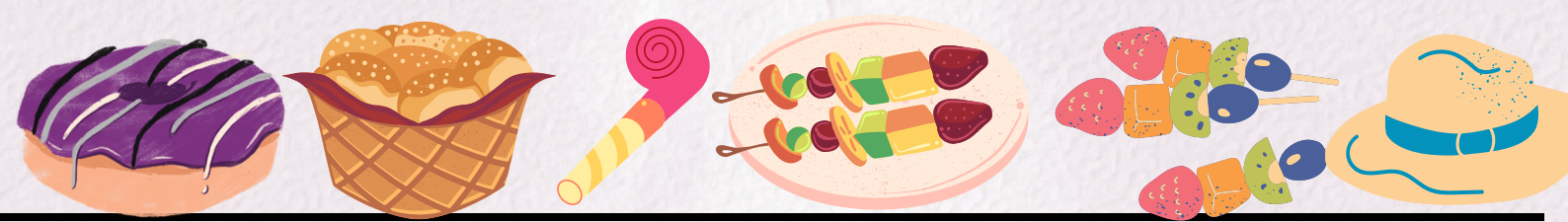
“Sports unify the body, mind and soul”

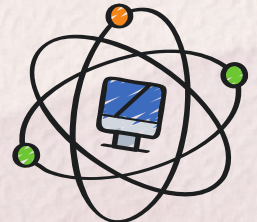
