

LEARNING RESPECT AND SAFE BOUNDARIES

EVENT: Counselling Workshop on Safe Touch and Respectful Behaviour

A counselling workshop was conducted for Class 5B on the theme “**Sensitization Towards Safe Touch and No Hitting**” with the aim of fostering respectful behaviour, personal safety awareness, and positive classroom interactions.

During the interactive session, students were guided through essential classroom practices that contribute to a safe and harmonious learning environment. Discussions focused on the importance of greeting teachers respectfully, moving safely within school premises, raising hands before speaking, and being attentive listeners. Special emphasis was placed on respecting personal boundaries, keeping hands to themselves, and understanding that hitting, pushing, or inappropriate touching is unacceptable.

Through age-appropriate discussions and examples, students learned the value of empathy, self-discipline, and mutual respect in their daily interactions. They actively participated in the session, sharing their thoughts and responding positively to the activities and discussions.

The workshop served as a meaningful platform to reinforce responsible behaviour, encourage healthy relationships, and create greater awareness about personal space and safety. It helped students understand that kindness, respect, and consideration for others are essential for building a positive and supportive classroom community.
