MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION  
OF  
GATEWAY EDUCATION & CHARITABLE SOCIETY

1. NAME - The name of the society is GATEWAY EDUCATION & CHARITABLE SOCIETY, hereinafter referred to as the "Society".
2. REGISTERED OFFICE - The registered office of the Society is in Delhi (Present Address: Pocket A-1, Flat No. 59, F.F., Sector-11, Rohini, Delhi-110085.)
3. AIMS AND OBJECTS - The aims and objects for which the Society is established are:
  - a) To start establish run, take over and manage educational and vocational training institutions (schools, colleges, university and foundations) for imparting and advancement of general, medical, computer and technical education including vocational training e.g. dance, music, fine arts and other cultural activities either directly and/or in co-operation/collaboration with other Educational institutions *as per Govt policy.*
  - b) To establish libraries and build up collections of educational books, periodicals and papers for the advancement of knowledge in the educational field
  - c) To provide facilities for exchange of information and opinion on various subjects, practices and trends for stimulating thought and effort in developing solutions to problems through lectures, conferences, seminars and demonstrations
  - d) To arrange dramas, meetings and competitions etc. for the advancement of art and cultural knowledge of the citizens.
  - e) To co-operate with other educational societies/institutions in India and abroad with this intention of furthering the objectives of the Society and with this end in view to affiliate groups and bodies.

- f) To grant scholarships and studentships and to supply books free to deserving students.
- g) To undertake studies, research, surveys, projects and to arrange instruction for the advancement of knowledge.
- h) To establish and maintain aid centers for the relief of the poor, for provision of medical relief and advancement of any other object of general public utility.
- i) To Publish books, Charts, Illustrations, Journals, Magazines and periodicals and other publications in different languages for the propagation of above aims and objects.
- j) To arrange and organize the Social and Cultural programmes from time to time.
- k) To promote the interest in the general public of Indian Art, Culture and Music by arranging and organising, Stage Plays, Dramas, Fete, Operas and Features Radio & T.V. Programs, Community dinners, Get to Gathers, picnics and celebration of Festivals for Students. 2

- l) To start establish run, take over and manage Hospitals & Health care centers for the benefit of the general public. *as per Govt policy*
- m) To start establish run, take over and manage computer training centers for the general public directly or in Co-operation/collaboration with anybody in India or Abroad. *as per Govt policy.*



In furtherance of these objects, it shall

- i) construct, demolish or alter any buildings which may be necessary or convenient for its objects. *as per Govt policy.*
- ii) Provide hostels and residence, as may be needed, for such students, Staff Members and workers who belong to or work for it.
- iii) Sell, lease, mortgage, charge, surrender, let on hire, exchange, dispose off, or otherwise transfer for consideration or by way of gift all or any portion of its property, rights, assets, any liabilities to any other society having similar objects.

- iv) Transfer, mortgage and accept as a gift or otherwise acquire or deal in any movable or immovable property, or rights therein or privileges thereto attaching which may be necessary or convenient for its objects.
- v) Invest and deal with its funds and moneys in securities or property and to operate its accounts with any bank, bankers etc. upon such terms and conditions and in such manner as may from time to time be determined or deemed expedient.
- vi) Lend or otherwise employ moneys belonging to it, to borrow or raise money with or without security by mortgaging or debenture or charging the whole or any part of its property, assets or rights and on such terms and conditions, as may be determined from time to time.
- vii) Do all such other acts and things whether incidental to the powers aforesaid or not, as may be requisite in order to further its objects.
- viii) Engage, invest or enter into any contractual obligations for the purpose of promotion of sound and liberal education.
- ix) Take over, on such terms as may be determined, any existing school/college or hospital with its properties, movable and with or without its liabilities and to carry on the same as an educational institution/health institution or to amalgamate the same with any educational institution/health institution by the Society.
- x) Enter into any arrangement with Government for securing grants in aid of any school belonging to the Society.
- xi) Provide on welfare and on humanitarian grounds all necessary facilities for benefit of all the educational institutions of the Society.
- xii) Generally to do all such lawful things as are conducive or incidental to the attainment of the above objects.



4. The Executive Committee of the Society shall be its Governing Body. The Names, Addresses and Occupations of the persons who are members of the society as also of the executive committee of the society and to whom the society entrusts the management of its affairs in accordance with its rules and regulations are as follows:

5 (a) The income and property of the Society, howsoever derived shall be applied towards the promotion of the objects thereof as set forth in the Memorandum of Association subject, nevertheless, in respect of expenditure of grants made by the Central or the State Government to such limitations as the government may, from time to time, impose. No portion of the income and property of the Society shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly, by way of dividends, bonus or otherwise, by way of profits to any person, who, at any time, is or has been a member of the Society. No interest on loan should be paid to any members of the Society.

b) All immovable property (land and building) purchased/built with the funds of the Society or the Institutions run by it shall vest in the Society and shall not be disposed off without the approval of the Governing Body of the Society.

6. If, on the winding up or dissolution of the Society, there remain, after the satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Society or any of them, but shall, in consistent with the objects of the Society, be dealt with in such manner as the Executive committee may determine, provided, however, the assets are used in such manner as to further, as nearly as possible, the objects for which the society is established.

7. DESIROUS PERSON:

We the undersigned are desirous of forming a Society named "GATEWAY EDUCATION & CHARITABLE SOCIETY" under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 in pursuance of this Memorandum of Association of the Society.

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. NAME OF SOCIETY: The name of society shall be **GATEWAY EDUCATION & CHARITABLE SOCIETY.**

2. MEMBERSHIP:

a) For the purpose of Registration of the society, It is declared to consist of 8 (Eight) Members (Four Founder Members And Four Ordinary Members) but it may when it thinks fit, register an increase of Ordinary members subject to the total membership not exceeding 21.

b) In case of death of any founder member only one of his/her legal heir shall be taken as founder member. For this no approval from any committee or remaining founder members is required.

c) The Ordinary membership of the society is open to any person who has attained the age of maturity and fulfills the terms and conditions of the society subject to the consent of 3/4<sup>th</sup> (Three Fourth) founder members.

d) Any person or persons of importance in education or Social Field can be nominated as members for a particular term with the consent of 1/4<sup>th</sup> of founder members.

3. ADMISSION FEE & SUBSCRIPTION :

The admission fee and the subscription shall be as under unless otherwise revised by the Governing Body of the society.

a) Admission fee Rs. 2,51,000/- at the time of admission for the founder members and Rs. 51,000/- for ordinary members.

b) There is no Annual Subscription.

4. TERMINATION & OR CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP :

The Governing Body of the society shall have the powers to expel/terminate only ordinary Members, from the membership of the above society, on the following grounds with the consent of 3/4<sup>th</sup> (Three Fourth) founder members.

a) On death

b) On written resignation

- c) If found to be involved in any anti-social activities.
- d) If adjudged by any court of law to be a criminal offender.
- e) If found guilty by means of anti propaganda of the Aims and objects of the society.
- f) If has not attended three consecutive meetings.
- g) If disregards Rules & Regulations or disobey the decisions of the Governing Body.
- h) The nominated members can be terminated by the Governing Body without assigning any reason.

5. GENERAL BODY :

- a) All the members of the society will constitute the General Body of the society.
- b) Meeting: General Body meeting shall be held once in every year regularly.
- c) Notice : Minium 7 days notice shall be given to the members, before the Date of General Body meeting, enclosing agenda specifying Date, Time, Place.

6. GOVERNING BODY :

- a) Strength : The strength of Governing body (including office bearers and executive members) shall not be less than 7 and not more than 21.
- b) Term : Term of every Governing body shall be three years.
- c) Notice : Minimum 7 days notice shall be required for every Governing body meeting of the society but urgent Governing body meeting can be called by 24 hour notice.
- d) Requisitioned Meeting : If one-third of the members want a special meeting to be called for consideration of any special question, they shall submit a written requisition stating therein the question to be discussed and the General Secretary/President shall have to call a meeting within one month of the receipt of such requisition.



In case the General Secretary/President fails to call such a duly requisitioned meeting without reasonable cause, the requisitionists shall have the right to call a meeting by giving seven days clear notice.

10. COMPOSITIONS OF GOVERNING BODY :

The composition of the Governing body shall be as under :

- a) President One
- b) Vice-President One
- c) General Secretary One
- d) Secretary One
- e) Treasurer One
- f) Executive members One from two to sixteen

11. POWERS & DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS :

A PRESIDENT :

- a) President shall preside over all the meetings of the society.
- b) President shall have the power to allow inclusion of any subject/matter in agenda for the discussion in the course of proceeding/meeting.

B. VICE-PRESIDENT : The Vice-President of the society shall enjoy all the powers of the President in his/her absence.

C. GENERAL SECRETARY :

- a) General Secretary will summon and attend the meetings of the Governing Body and General Body.
- b) General Secretary will prepare the Membership Register as well as the Proceeding Register to record the minutes of the proceedings of the Governing Body.

- c) The Society may sue or be sued in the name of the General Secretary who will be competent to employ lawyers and attorneys for the purpose of prosecution and

defence of suits and legal proceedings and to sign plaints, written statements, Vakalatnamas, affidavits and other papers in relation thereto as well as file or received back documents and moneys belonging to or meant for the Society.

D. **SECRETARY** : The Secretary shall enjoy all the powers of General Secretary in his/her absence.

D. **TREASURER** :

a) All funds of society shall remain under the care and management of Treasurer.

b) Treasurer shall maintain the accounts of all money which is received and/or paid by him/her on behalf of the society.

c) Treasurer shall make disbursement in accordance with the direction of Governing Body.

12. **QUORUM** :

a) **General Body** : One half of the members or Five whichever is less.

b) **Governing Body** : One half of the members with a minimum of Five.

c) **Board of Governors** : One third of the members or as provided in the Rules of the Education Department in the case of institutions recognised by it.

d) **Sub-Committees** : One third of the members or two whichever is more.

e) If at a General Body meeting, a quorum is not present within half an hour of the time of commencement of the meeting the same shall stand adjourned and will meet again after half an hour. At such meetings, the members present shall be competent to transact the business of the meeting whether a quorum is present or not. If in respect of a meeting convened on requisition, the quorum is not present within half an hour of the time of commencement thereof, the meeting shall stand dissolved; unless the President considers that the matter to be considered is of urgent and of special nature, he may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, direct that the meeting shall stand adjourned and will meet again after half an hour, when the meeting will be held even without any quorum.

13. FUNDS OF THE SOCIETY :

- a) The funds of the Society shall be deposited in banks or any other financial institutions or as permitted by section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act. The banking accounts of the Society shall be operated jointly by any two of the three persons nominated by the Executive Committee. Such funds of the Society as are not required for current expenses may be held and dealt with in such manner as permitted by section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act.
- b) The society can raise loan from banks/ financial institution/ finance company/ or any private person/firm.
- c) The Society can have any property any where in India for the purposes of the Society.
- d) Except for small bills amounting to less than Rs. 10,000/- all payments would be made by cheques and proper receipts taken except under exceptional circumstances with the permission of President/General Secretary.

14. FUNDS OF THE INSTITUTIONS RUN BY THE SOCIETY :

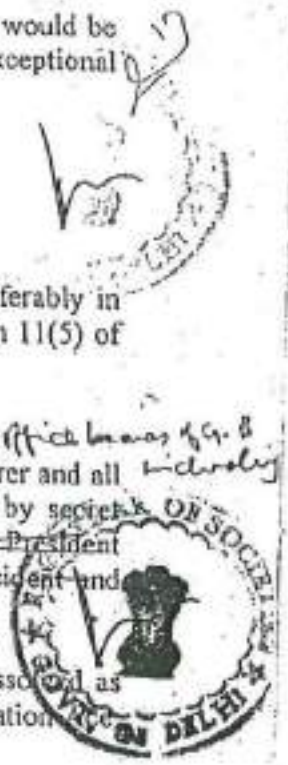
The funds of the institutions run by the society shall be deposited preferably in Banks/ Govt. Securities/Financial institutions or as permitted by section 11(5) of the Income Tax Act.

15. ELECTION : General Body in its Annual meeting will elect its Treasurer and all executive members of the Governing Body, after every three years by secret ballot papers or by show of hands as the election office may decide. *all its office bears of G. B. including*

16. DISSOLUTION : If the society needs to be dissolved, it shall be dissolved as per - Provisions laid down under the sec. 13 & 14 of Societies Registration Act 1860 as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi.

17. AMENDMENT : Any amendment in Memorandum, Rules and Regulations will be carried out in accordance with section 12 & 12-A of the Societies Registration Act 1860, as applicable to National Capital Territory of Delhi with the consent of the founder members.

18. AUDIT : The accounts of the society shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant appointed by the Society every year.
