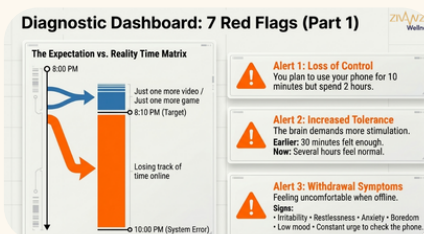
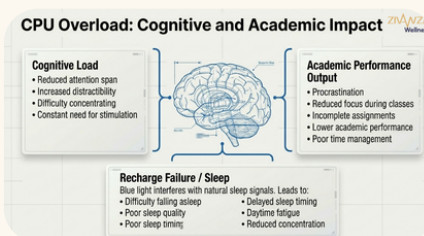
Digital Citizenship: Being a Safe, Respectful and Responsible Online User

● INTENT
