L U N C H B R E A K	CLAP, BOOM & SNATCH Children will play the Clap, Boom & Snatch game by listening carefully to the teacher's instructions and responding with the correct action. They will clap, say "Boom," or quickly snatch the given object at the right moment, making the session fun, engaging, and interactive.	FREE HAND DRAWING Children will draw a bright sun using simple shapes and lines. THURSDAY (03.07.26)	Free-Play (Settling Time)	Welcome	CIRCLE TIME The teacher will introduce the importance of cleanliness through a simple and interactive discussion. Teacher will talk about healthy habits such as washing hands, keeping their surroundings clean, and maintaining personal hygiene.	Scoops & Numbers Children will count the ice cream scoops on each cone and match them with the correct numeral. They will complete the activity by identifying the correct number and placing or circling the matching numeral.		PASSING THE BALL Children will sit in a row and pass the ball backward from one friend to another. The last child in the line will carefully collect the ball and drop it into the basket before the game begins again.	GROOMING KIT Children will make their own Grooming Kit by pasting or arranging pictures of personal hygiene items such as a comb, toothbrush, soap, towel, and handkerchief. They will decorate their kit and learn about the importance of using these items every day.
