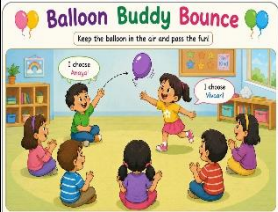

This helps them feel positive, confident, and ready to learn. Circle Time *What was your favourite thing you did in the summer vacation? *How do you stay cool when it's hot outside? * Where did you go during your summer vacation?	Picture talk In this picture talk activity, the teacher will show a summer-related picture with objects like mangoes, umbrellas, ice creams, etc. Children will observe the picture, count the objects, and speak about them (e.g., "There are 9 mangoes and 6 umbrellas" and 15 caps)   	L U N C H	Team Ball Express Children will sit in two straight lines, one behind the other. The first child will pick up a ball from the basket and pass it overhead using both hands to the next child. Each child will continue passing the ball until it reaches the last teammate, who will throw it into the basket without turning around. The relay continues until all the balls are transferred. The team that collects the maximum number of balls in the basket within the given time wins the game. The named child will run, keep the balloon from touching the ground, call another friend's name, and continue the game. The activity continues until every child gets a turn, with the goal of keeping the balloon floating throughout.	Children will draw and colour their favourite grooming kit item, such as a toothbrush, soap, comb, or towel, and share why they think it is the most important.	Teachers will conduct an engaging story session on grooming and personal hygiene , introducing the essential items in a grooming kit and explaining their importance in staying clean and healthy. Through the story, children will learn simple hygiene habits that help prevent illness and promote a happy, healthy lifestyle.
