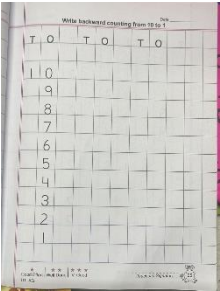
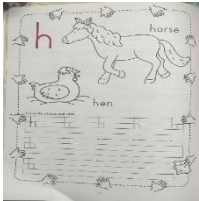


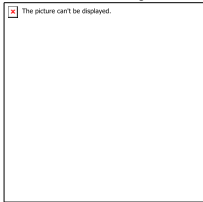

Children will walk carefully on the given track from one point to another while holding the umbrella. This activity will help to develop balance, coordination, and concentration. 	Rainy Season Object Show Description: Teacher will show real objects like an umbrella, raincoat, gumboots, and paper boat. Children will observe, touch, and talk about their use in rain.	How Do You Feel in Rain? Children will talk about their feelings in rainy weather (happy, excited, cold). This helps in emotional expression Children will learn and recite rhymes on Rainy sesason Rainy Day Rain, rain, come today, Wash the dust and heat away. Clouds are dark up in the sky, Birds are flying very high. Open umbrellas, wear boots tight, Jump in puddles with delight. Tip-tip drops fall all around.

WEDNESDAY (8.7.26)	Free-Play (Settling Time)	Welcome	Introduction of Letter h 	H Hunt and Count Teacher will hide pictures or objects starting with the letter h (like hat, hen, house, hand, honey, horse) in the classroom. Each object will have a number written on it. Children will search for the hidden objects, identify and say the word aloud, and then count the objects or match them with the correct number card. For example, 3 hats, 4 hens, 5 honey drops.		Rainy Treasure Hunt Teacher will hide rainy season objects like umbrella, raincoat, gumboots, and paper boat in different corners of the classroom or play area. Children will run, search, and collect the hidden objects one by one. After finding them, they will name the objects and place them in the rainy season basket.	Floating and Sinking Activity Teacher will fill a small tub or bucket with water and show rainy season objects like paper boat, leaf, and stick. One by one, children will put the objects into the water and observe what happens. They will identify and tell which objects float and which sink. The teacher will encourage discussion by asking simple questions like "What is floating?" and "What is sinking?"	My Rainy Day Drawing Children will draw what they like to do in the rain (umbrella, puddles, raincoat). After drawing, they will share their feelings about rainy days.
		Cleanliness Checkup	Children will learn about the letter h through simple words and sounds. They will identify the letter and say words like Hat, Hen, House. This activity will help them recognize the letter and its sound.

This helps children develop self-care.

Count the Paper Boats Children will count paper boats floating in a tub and tell the correct number.		Catch the Rain Teacher will throw blue paper balls (raindrops) in the air and place baskets at a short distance. Children will run, catch the raindrops, and collect them in the basket. Each child will get a turn to catch as many raindrops as possible within a given time. After the activity, children will count how many raindrops they collected.	Finger Painting Raindrops  Children will use blue colour to make raindrops with fingers. This will improve creativity and sensory learning.	Happy and Sad Cloud Craft Children will make two clouds one happy and one sad. They will talk about when rain makes them happy or scared.
