Dear Parent

We believe that when parents and educators work together, the possibilities for students are endless. We would like to reiterate the guidelines of the promotion policy for **classes V and VIII** for the academic session 2026-27 as per the Directorate of Education:

Attendance Criteria

- 75% actual attendance is mandatory for all students to appear in the **Annual Examination**.
- The attendance for the session will be marked as follows:

Attendance Range in Percentage	Marks
96-100	5
91-95	4
86-90	3
81-85	2
76-80	1
Up to 75	Nil

Promotion Policy

- In order to be declared **“Pass”** at the end of the session for promotion to the next higher class, a student must secure **at least 33% marks** in each subject studied by him/her during the session.
- **Re-examination** will be conducted if a student is not able to secure at least 33% marks in **any of the subject**.

If a student does not secure at least 25% marks in the subject in which he/she has taken the Re-examination and minimum of 33 out of 100 marks in that subject or does not appear in the Re-examination, he/ she will be placed in the category of **“Essential Repeat”** and will be held back in the same class during the next session.

The above stated policy is already mentioned in school almanac. For any further queries, please feel free to contact the class teacher on the day of the PTM.
