They will identify different objects and count the things in the picture. This activity will help develop their observation skills, numeracy, and language skills.	Yoga Session Students will do monsoon- themed yoga poses like Frog Pose, Tree Pose, Butterfly Pose, and Cobra Pose. This activity will help improve their balance, flexibility, and body strength. 	Froggy Fun Craft Students will make a frog craft using coloured paper. They will fold, paste, and decorate the frog by following the teacher's instructions. This activity will improve their fine motor skills and creativity. 	Need or Want? Teacher will introduce the concept of Needs and Wants by showing pictures of items like water, milk, a school bag, a book, toys, and chocolate. The teacher will explain that needs are things we need every day, and wants are things we like but can live without. Student will look at each picture and say whether it is a need or a want.
