

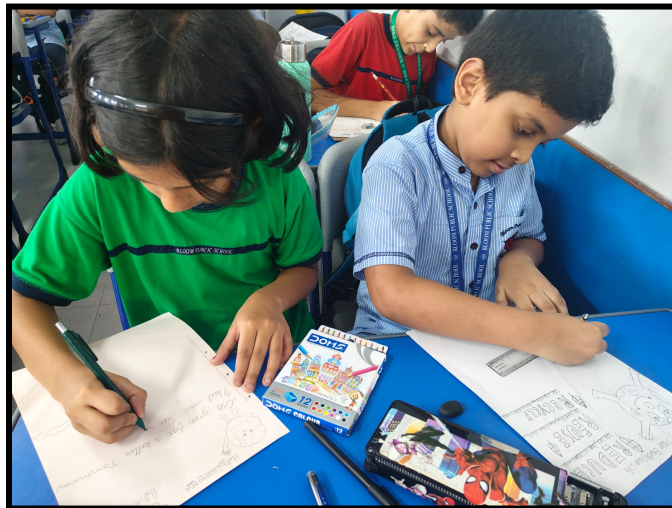
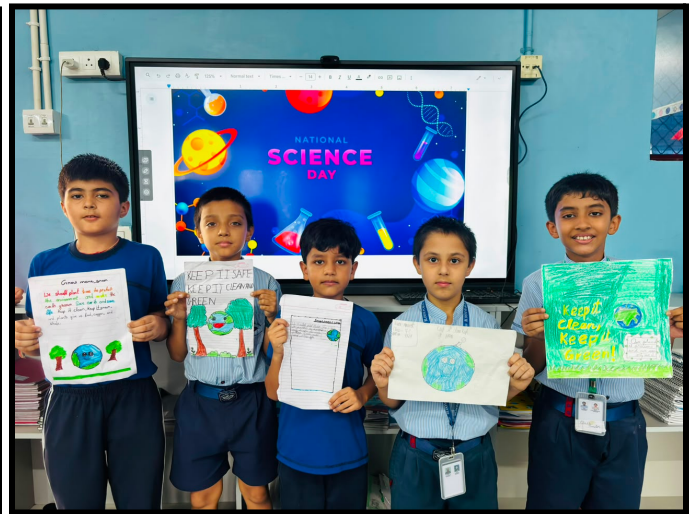
SCIENCE WEEK - DAY 2
