Assessment: Observe students' participation, confidence in reciting the rhyme, and their ability to demonstrate good manners during classroom activities.	MATH TALK Numbers 1-80 The students will be given mixed number cards from 1 to 80. With the teacher's guidance, they will arrange the cards in the correct order. After the activity, they will practise writing the numbers from 1 to 80 in their notebook. 		Rain Shield Adventure Students will participate in a fun Rainy Day Adventure Walk, carrying an umbrella as they cross different obstacles. Along the way, they will identify and sort rainy season essentials, such as an umbrella, raincoat, and gumboots, while learning how to choose the correct items to stay safe and dry during the rainy season. This activity will enhance their balance, coordination, observation, and decision-making skills. 	Sound Identification Activity The teacher and students will sit facing each other with a divider placed between them. The teacher will create a sound by tapping or shaking an object, and the students will listen carefully to identify the matching object from their own set. The teacher will encourage and guide the children throughout the activity. This activity will enhance listening skills, sound discrimination, concentration, and auditory memory.. 	Civic Sense Activity- Clean Up After Lunch The students will clean up their own space by keeping their lunch box and water bottle in the proper place. They will fold their apron neatly and keep it in its designated place. This daily habit will help them become responsible, independent, and develop good civic sense. 
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THURSDAY (30.07.26)			ENGLISH L1 Introduction of Letter ‘p’ Students will use clay dough to make the letter ‘p’ by rolling and shaping the dough with their hands. While making the letter, they will say the ‘p’ sound and identify objects that begin with ‘p’ such as (pen, pencil, parrot, potato and pineapple). Assessment: Students recognize the letter ‘p’ in a fun and engaging way while strengthening their finger muscles.	Coin Sorting Activity Students will sort different coins into the correct labelled cups according to their denominations (₹1, ₹2, ₹5, ₹10, and ₹20). They will identify each coin and place it in the matching cup while following the teacher's instructions. Assessment: Observe students' ability to identify and sort the coins correctly, follow instructions, and actively participate in the activity.		Hop and Swap Two students will participate in a relay at a time. They will hop through five hoops and then move the cups placed outside the hoops using either hand. The student who completes the task correctly in the shortest time will be the winner. This activity will improve balance, coordination, agility, hand-eye coordination, and the ability to follow instruction. Assessment: Observe students participation, balance, coordination, speed, accuracy, and ability to follow instructions.	Ice Break Experiment Students will participate in a fun sensory science experiment with the teacher by preparing a tray of coloured water and sprinkling a layer of white powder over it. They will gently touch the surface with their fingers and observe the crack-like patterns that appear. 	Story: The Magic Whistle One day, Aarav was playing in the school garden. Mystery Weight Basket The students will pick any two objects, such as a pencil, eraser (rubber), paper, book, cotton ball, sponge, toy, or plastic cup, clay and wooden blocks from the Jaadui Pitara. They will hold the objects in their hands, compare their weight, and identify which object is heavy and which is light. Assessment: Assess students' ability to compare objects using their hands and correctly identify heavy and light objects. 		Splash and Stretch Yoga Children will practise easy yoga movements inspired by nature, such as Tree Pose, Butterfly Pose, and Breathing Exercises, to feel refreshed and energetic during the rainy season. The teacher will also guide them on simple ways to stay healthy, including eating nutritious food, wearing clean clothes, and keeping themselves safe from seasonal illnesses. Assessment: Observe students' participation, coordination while performing yoga, and awareness of healthy habits during the monsoon.	Air Pressure Experiment Students will release air from an inflated balloon connected to a straw and observe the water flowing into a bowl. Assessment: Through this simple experiment, they will learn that moving air can push water and develop curiosity about basic science concepts through hands-on exploration. <u>Air Pressure Experiment</u> 	Weather of My Heart Worksheet Students will observe different weather pictures (such as sunny, cloudy, rainy, and windy) and choose the one that best matches how they are feeling. Assessment: Observe students' ability to identify and express their emotions, complete the worksheet correctly, and participate in the discussion. 
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
